

Money

When Sheila and I first met we shared a 'ten shilling note' between us. With her five shillings (25p.) she bought toiletries and underwear but my five shillings (25p.) was frittered away, a magazine, some chocolate - I had nothing to show for it.

As a salesman and Manager my income dramatically increased. I splashed out in every area. Borrowing became a habit, an overdraft plus were the norm.

I was promoted to the position of Sales Manager, I had to borrow money to advertise for Sales Representatives, and buy equipment for training them and for them to take out and demonstrate to their prospective clients. This money was recovered if they did well but became a debt to me if they failed. Many of them failed and over the years my debts increased, being aggravated by more loans and a second mortgage on our home. So it was in 1979 I was in debt to thousands of pounds. How the Lord delivered me from the bondage of debt is a miracle of God's grace.

In those days we had a television set, but some time after I had accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as my Saviour we decided to dispose of it and took it to the 'tip' and threw it in. However, before we threw it away we had watched a programme of a Catholic priest who worked in India feeding 'Street Children.'

'The money that was given for this work is always sent directly to the Centre in India without any deductions. The sum that was donated was the sum that was sent! At

that time one Centre was feeding seven hundred children a day. We were moved by this work and made a joint decision not to buy or eat any biscuits and to send to India the £4.00 a month we would normally have spent on buying this luxury.

When the Lord called me to serve Him and Him only I resigned from my job as Sales Manager, cut up my credit cards and began to pay off a little each month.

We were led to start tithing to the Lord a tenth of our income under Biblical principles. (Malachi 3:8-10) We had read in God's Word not to owe any man anything (TEXT) and asked the Lord to get us free from debt. At that time there was a specific need in India and we received a special appeal to help meet that need. We had enough money to send a cheque for £50.00 - the largest amount we had ever given!

A few weeks later I received a letter giving us a receipt for the gift. There were other letters that day including one from a solicitor. I opened it and gasped with amazement when I read of a bequest left to me by a friend. She had left me £50.00 but the letter continued; her daughter, the main beneficiary, had increased the amount to £500.00 I stood breathless with the impact of this wonderful gift. God is no man's debtor! When I showed Sheila my letter she showed me hers. She too had been sent a cheque for £500,00! Amazing! Yes God is amazing.

Nineteen years later I thank God that I can testify that the Lord has set me free from debt and in all that time we have never borrowed money. Although we have had many testing times, we have never borrowed a penny.

17 The Testimony of Budernick

In North East Poland while on Mission, the present writer was staying with a pastor and Budernick was his father.

The preparations and outline plans for Mission India were constantly being revised as the cost soared.

The headaches continued as I arrived in Secunderbad where meetings and arrangements were badly planned and I was without a translator. However, in spite of all the havoc, the Lord blessed greatly in the slum areas. Many families remembered my previous visit of three years ago. There was a sudden deluge of rain and so we all huddled under a ramshackle shelter, while the poor people listened intently to the Word.

The Holy Spirit touched many hearts as they came weeping and calling on the Lord. Later that day I was asked to dedicate the home of Joseph and Mary. They, along with their son Johan and his wife Elizabeth, were extremely kind to me in Secunderbad. They drove me to many places and Mary even took two days off work to support the mission.

Due to a cyclone, the floods in both Visakhapatnam and Gunter district near Bapatla caused serious transport problems. Pastor Nathaniel said that twenty two persons had died in the village of Kodipunjavalasa, because of this cyclone. Trains were cancelled and there was chaos on the roads. Both Pastor Nathaniel and Pastor Jidigu struggled to catch the night buses in order to meet me in Hyderabad as I was contemplating returning to the UK. After having obtained detailed information, I was able to get a train to Duvvadi in the outskirts of Visak city. The journey was horrendous, lasting fourteen hours and I arrived almost exhausted at 1:00 AM to sleep in "The Madhu Residence", a place not to be recommended at 700 Rupees.

However, the Lord was gracious to bless the meetings in Visak. On the first day I visited the children in Peduyim. I taught them some new games and we had a joyful time. They are developing both physically and spiritually. They are disciplined, clean, loved, and well cared for in every respect. I gave a short message from God's Word before visiting the Peduyim land where I put my hand to a spade and helped dig out the

foundations. They have dug a well and located water, and the electricity is to be connected in due course. Please pray for them. I ate a meal here but was afflicted by severe stomach cramps, caused by dishes being washed in dirty water which nearly disabled me for the next four days.

After a few days, the Lord greatly helped me on a long drive to the prison where 24 accepted Christ as their Savior and Lord. Then we went to the next prison where another 18 responded to the spoken Word. Twenty Pastors gathered for a small one day conference. Some of them were deeply touched by God's Word. The Lord provided a competent young translator who was a blessing to all and was anointed of God. Following the second session the pastors invited me to return for a crusade and more teaching. The Lord kept us safe as I traveled to the tribal region to preach in a small village church.

Season the whole with a dash of good spirits, a sprinkle of fun, a pinch of play and a cup full of good humor.

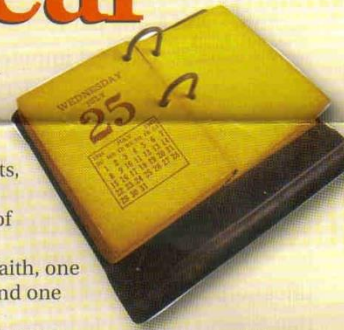
Pour all of this into a vessel of love.

people and pastors said that “Until now any missionary did not stay and visit and conducts conference in that village.

When we heard and wondered that Tony has vision from the Lord and he visited and also he is the first missionary in that Island.

Nearly 70 Pastors or evangelists were attended to the Pastors conference. Some of the Pastors came from other side of the river and some of the pastors came from villages in that Island. The amazing thing is some of the pastors came by walk from 10 KM.

The Holy Spirit anointed the word of God, the pastors and evangelists were edified and moved by the Spirit.

The pastors amazed by the testimony of our brother’s ministry. After the meeting the pastors gave feedback how they encouraged and how the messages touched their hearts. Some the pastors learned how to grow in prayerful life. Some of the pastors learned in faithful life and some of the pastors learned about spiritual gifts. In 1952, the missionary world lost Samuel Zwemer, a courageous pioneer. In the late 1800's, while in seminary, Zwemer and his buddy James Cantine received their call to the mission field. But, it wasn't just any calling, it was to a field avoided by merchants of the Gospel — the Arab nations.

Before his life was over, Zwemer had spread God's Good News to almost the entire Arab world, from Basra at the mouth of the Persian Gulf to Cairo, in the cradle of the Nile. He authored nearly 50 books, many articles, and founded the magazine, *The Muslim World*. His understanding of those with whom he lived caused him to plead, "The hour is late and the need is urgent."

Only with today's dark events of terrorism can we truly appreciate the battle Zwemer and other workers of the Arabian Mission endured for over a century. Some feel it is too late to reach Muslims, even though in North America they are often our next door neighbors.

Nonetheless, Jesus' command is still valid: *"Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? Behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest."* John 4:35

1972. We became Christians through June's witness and we were baptised (immersion) I was still ill.

1978. We were invited into a long stay hospital (All Saints in Eastbourne) to sing and give the Gospel message . Very hard for me.

1979. The Lord healed me. Amazing.

1979. Tony called to give up his lucrative job, house big car, all went.

Hospitals, Homes, prisons, opened up. All by invitation we both did tent making to support ourselves. No mortgage now, we bought the cheapest house. We did around 18 meetings a week, but soon had to do them fortnightly to fit in work. This continued for around twelve years overlapping with Tony preaching on the streets.

1989 Tony went off into Kent in an estate car, 5 days preaching in towns slept in car. At some stage we bought an old Bedford camper full of rust.

At this time we felt that the hospital work was about to end (it is still going with others, except where closures have occurred) The camper took Tony to Ireland (South) also Poland (catholic he was RC) before being saved.

1994-95. A small Chapple in Kent, 13 elderly members provided a Merlin Motor caravan £12,000. This came from my nursing of the father of the pastor's wife. One of those, no pay jobs, which was well paid in the end

1998. We sponsored a Pilipino boy through this church which led to Tony visit to the Philippines.

1998 India opened up through us singing at retreats with Joshua Daniels of L.E.F. Hugh meetings with many thousands. Tony knew he should go to the villages and Pastors. They meet to support each other. We hope the buffalo Farm will help when it is running well.

Our ministry is strictly non-denominational. This was helpful in Hospital our sponsors are from all denominations and none. We give every penny to Daily Bread Missions because some folks still give to us personally so it covers DBM administration and travel. If everything were written down a book wouldn't be sufficient!!!

“Faith House on A Higher Ground”

In June of 1992 of BanezVille II Fatima Village Tacloban City, Leyte, Philippines. God provided our family a wooden house through Gods' loving people of Bells Yew Green Chapel through Pastor Arthur and Sister Mary Rivers and other generous individuals like Peter and Jackie Goodes, Hettie a half blind old lady and other philanthropic people who have a hearts to share in order to meet our dire need for shelter. We thank God for this precious wooden house. We have been very comfortable in this house for five solid years. We were able to live this house for ten years.

A time came our neighbouring villages were developed into a housing subdivision. Those places were highly filled up with soil

and our village soon became lower and lower. During rainy season, the water all run down to our place and flooded all over the area.

It takes a month or more for the flood to dry up. All rubbish were stuck-up that caused mosquitoes, worms and even poisonous snakes to inhabit. This dirty environment caused us sickness and infections. The flood rose up to the lower hip level and covered our floor and bedrooms that caused our house to rotten. We trust God for our bad situation that He is willing and able to give us a new house.

We asked God for a better house and a flood free of our own. By faith we rejoiced and thanked God that our house was destroy by the flood for we know that all things worked together for good for those who loved Him and who are called to His purpose. God has a purpose in whatever things that happen in our life as children of God (Rom. 8v28).

One day in March 2001 God sent his servant from England in the person of Evangelist Tony Daly from England to help us accomplished the purpose God in evangelizing the Filipinos. Before he came he asked us to arrange his accommodation. We housed him at the Tacloban Plaza Hotel without any idea that beside the hotel there is a noisy Videoke Bar.

He was not able to sleep all night. In the morning he insisted to leave the hotel and he wanted to spend the other nights in our place which was very embarrassing situation to us. That night a very heavy rain fall and our place was flooded again.

As he looked around the place he said to himself “God sent me here for a purpose.” And he prayed “God! What can you do for the Lerions?”

God spoke to him to give his money, which was originally intended for his car repair, he instructed us to open an account in the bank for the Higher Ground Fund. That was the key for the blessings to flow. God was using people whom we do not know personally to make His promises into reality.

God spoke to us through His wonderful promises in His Word as confirmation that God has something better for us. We write the vision and waited upon God for the fulfilment of the vision of a new house (Habakkuk 2v2&3).

As we waited upon the Lord there came along side many trials and strong testing of our faith that lead us a prayer of committal like Habakkuk’s prayer in chapter 3 verse 17 and 18.

We determined in our hearts to anchor our joy in the God of our salvation. Wither or not God will provide a shelter for our family, still we are committed to serve the Lord faithfully and in Him we rejoiced. Instead, we are always encouraged by the word of God “The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine”, saith the Lord of Host. “The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former one...and in this place will I give peace saith the Lord of Host.”

(Haggai 2v8&9)

(My Spirit that is upon thee and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the Lord) "Arise shine for thy light is come and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. Thou shalt also suck the milk of the gentiles and suck the breast of Kings and thou shalt know that I the Lord am thy Savior and Redeemer, the Mighty one of Jacob.

We also trust God for the rendering of the inside and the outside walls, for the provision of the glass windows and for the gutters, and other needs to finish the house.

Unto Him be Glory in the church for Christ Jesus throughout all ages...(Eph. 3 v20) Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give the desire of your heart. God's provision. I thank the Lord for so many who gave so generously. Thus the Lord enabled me to distribute many sacks of rice to very poor and needy lepers, orphan children. One pastor said he could hardly bear to see the children with pain on their faces and not having any food for them that day.

Safety and security. The Lord wonderfully protected me from the chaos and horrendous traffic situations, a very real danger of physical attack and arduous journeys at night Please pray for the Christians. One pastor was brutally attacked and beaten in Nylore his wife is traumatised. Fanatical Hindus wielding machetes deliberately set upon another preacher. He and his family were badly wounded.

The situation is serious for many pastors in the outlying villages where I was told there are still humane sacrifices once a year.

One night in a tribal area we cancelled a meeting in a village because late at night it was too dangerous. Travelling back from the tribal region, several times a group of men blocking the road to stop your vehicle our drivers kept going only missing hitting them.

Health,

I had various problems through unsanitary conditions, dirty water, and dangerous food, despite rigorous precautions. I was stuffed full of anti malaria tablets, badly bitten by mosquitoes, attacked with throat and chest infection and diarrhoea following drinking water from a bottle labelled pure sparkling purified mineral water that had been refilled from the well..

Hyderabad slums area.

We set off in an auto rickshaw through clouds of sulphurous smoke and the chaotic traffic that is India. I was shocked at the slum conditions although having seen them many times.

Sister Davee asked me to pray for her sister who is due to have a tumour removed from her breast. The poor woman was fearful, with some good reason. A small room crammed with around 40 folks, plus many children and more folks crowding around the door and in the street, curious about the white man that had come.

The Lord enabled me to preach the Gospel and blessed with 30 or more responding to the message. After the meeting we walked through the dirt and slum district to the refuse tip.

Families lived in groups of 20/30, in makeshift hovels, actually in the middle of the tip. It is hard to describe the filth, sewage, stagnant water in ditches, mixed with the rubbish, no water, no electricity, cooking on open fires with small sacks of rice stored in branches of the one tree, out of reach of the rats. The congregation a few Christians, but mostly Hindu seemingly unaware of the flies or danger of disease.

Again another wonderful meeting of praise and an amazing response to the Word of God. The following day we congregated in another derelict home of a Christian with around 30/40 folk gathered to praise the Lord.

Praise God many more responding positively to the appeal. Later after some rest we boarded the night train at 7 PM due to arrive in Rajahmundry at 5 AM.

Rajahmundry I was taken to Pastor Joseph's home and met Sunitha his wife. for her as she is three months pregnant but has a problem with low blood count. The orphanage has 30 children, and with her baby this will make 31 children in the home plus 17 old folks all living eating and sleeping in one room. I found my hands badly bitten by mosquito in the night and my head spinning with tiredness.

Rock breakers.

Visaghapatnam. ...

After a nights sleep I boarded the train at 9 AM and arrived in Visahaspatnam at 12 45 to be met by Pastor Natnhaniel, the church elders who took me to a hotel.

Later at 6PM we drove along the coast road to Tagarapuualsa town and I gave out the Word in a Baptist church.

Several pastors from other churches came. I prayed for many folk including a woman with cancer, a man with skin disease and young teenager with sever sight problem.

The next day we travelled on the main Calcutta highway avoiding three head on crashes to a village. The meeting commenced with me being bedecked with a garland of flowers and huge quantities of petals thrown over me. Around 15 adults and twenty five children gathered to hear the Word.

Twenty folk responded to the Word. Then nearly all came for prayer, I had to tell some of them (before I could pray for them) to remove and destroy their occult fetishes, obtained from the witch doctors.

The Lord blessed and I was led to give money for a sack of rice for the villagers. I returned down coast road to Visaghatnam and again in the evening back to the Baptist Church in **Tagarapuualsa** for another meeting when around 30 came forward for prayer. Returned to Hotel at 11.15 PM.

Rahajmundruy tribal region

The next day I returned to Rajahmundry by train and in the early evening went out 60 klm to the tribal region. We travelled in the medical van, along the river bank where Pastor John has baptised hundreds of converts over the years. We bumped down endless rough tracks stopping at various places along the way to meet and pray with Pastors and families. One pastor I was told

received only ten and twenty rupees in the offerings I was led to give R500 to his wife..

We stopped at the first village where I preached and prayed for around 30 folks. Some hearing the Gospel and responding for the first time. Doctor Prakesh gave out medicines. Moving on to another village where I preached at 9 PM, again more prayers, more converts and more free medicines and then onto another village where I preached at 11PM. I think they woke up the village and called them to the meeting in a small church.

At the conclusion of my message a woman was moaning and crying hysterically. It seemed very weird. I wondered if it was a demon? The doctor gave his examinations and interviewed the long queue of folk seeking help .The Lord blessed. I cannot quantify what the Lord has done...

We returned to the van very tired but could not rest on the return journey as the van was lurching over very rough tracks.

Several times we were waved down by groups of men in the middle of the road but our experienced driver swerved and did not stop. As we entered the city in the early hours the van engine faltered was restarted and faltered again having run out of diesel. Amazingly we cruised down the main road turned into side roads and came to a stop outside the orphanage.

How we praised God. I stepped over some of the forty sleeping bodies in the orphanage and started to get ready for bed when the cook brought in a plate with three omelettes and chips with hot tea. I tumbled into bed at 2 AM grateful to God for an amazing day. How many souls had been saved maybe 60 ? Cannot tell but I do know it was amazing and wonderful

Nethervole Church.

We travelled along the riverbank and crossed over near Sir Arthur Cottons dam and canal. I preached "How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation". Pastor John Babu told me later a young man who had been absent from the church for a year had been present in the meeting and the Word had touched him. I prayed again for around 30 folk.

Leper Colony In the afternoon we proceeded to the leper colony situated in a rubbish tip the land being donated free by the Indian government. .Nearby a Hindu temple. The lepers mostly without fingers or toes, around 40 of them sat crossed legged and praised the Lord. I was appalled at the scene.

Pastor John Babu was trying to swot the hundreds of flies from my feet and from my water bottle. The worship time was impressive and powerful. I gave my message and prayed and left

a gift for a sack of rice...It was very moving and unforgettable experience...Pray for them..

Pastors conference.

Around 150 pastors gathered on the roof of the orphanage to hear the Word. We had two main meetings AM and PM .Pastor Joseph was thrilled as 100 of the pastors were from “Word in Action Outreach”, but another 50 were from other denominations in the City The word went forth with power and liberty. Many were touched by God...Invitations to return were plentiful.

Tribal region.

Tuesday 14th Jan . We set off at 9 am in the medical van with the Dr Prakesh and Pastor John and Joseph Babu. It was a long gruelling journey of 100 klm over rough jungle tracks. We stopped at the river town to negotiate the hire of a boat. R600 .

We chugged along as the boatman bailed out the water leaking in the front while I was reminded that there are crocodiles, bears and tigers in this region. One tiger had got so hungry he would swim out to passing boats and try to board them, once was successful and attacked the passengers. It was eventually shot.

Kachubusa. It was beautiful journey after an hour and ten minutes we arrived at the first village, climbing up the bank 60 ft to follow the trail. I was told in August all this land was all under

water. I was shown a cement hut built high on the hillside and this was the refuge built by the government, even this had been under water in the flood of 1987. As I entered the village was met with curious glances as the first white man in that village. The people quickly assembled and I gave my Gospel message to around 30 folk.

I thank the Lord for the wonderful response from these Hindu idol worshippers.. God is doing a great work among them in these last days.. After more prayers and free medicines had been distributed we had lunch well they ate there rice and I munched on dry biscuits and toast. We left at 4PM and took the boat back to another village

Crondura.

I gave the word in a village's squalid hut and was told later that five souls were saved. Two naked boys were covered in green I was told they had chicken pox. Pathetic scenes as the doctor gave medicines. I walked out to overlook the river and pray. We returned tired to the boat to go to the next village but this was cancelled as the Pastor said it was too dangerous.

I was told Hindus in this area still have a human sacrifice once a year and when night comes hit the bottle and have cock fighting gambling and drunken orgies... So we returned down the river in the moon light stopping only at the police boat to report our safe return. Apparently the pastor had informed the local police of our medical trip..

Orphans Home. 15th Jan. I was greeted on my birthday with the orphan children sing a happy birthday. I opened my birthday card from my case.

I had been to town on the back of Joseph's motorcycle to send emails at the internet café and buy t shirt for Joseph stock up with biscuits and grapes and some oranges. Joseph bought me a Indian suit and I wore it for the children's meeting. The Lord helped me to give the word 2 Chron 9 v 1-7 ..."Happy are these thy servants" and Mephibosheth invited to the Kings table....The Lord blessed the Word and Sunitha Pastor Joseph's wife wept...

Babatla.

John Sunitha Joseph and Sambo accompanied me to the station. The train was late by 50 minutes and I said my goodbyes. I arrived in the early hours 12 20 AM on an deserted platform to be met by Pastor Jidigu Rajatnam and the elders of his church.

They garlanded me with flowers and had carried a banner of welcome...A car took us to Bhvanana Residency a seedy run down hotel while Pastor Jidigu shared some of his testimony . I gratefully slept until 7 AM.

Woke up with the Hindu temple blasting out amplified music and wailing. Looked out the window to view more appalling poverty. I visited the orphanage where 17 children live in one room. The orphanage is 5 months behind in its rent and the pastor and his wife Sunitha struggle to feed them one meal a day.

There is nowhere for the children to play and the building is backed by a ditch filled with refuse and stagnant water. I sang to the children and told bible stories. In the brief time since coming home three children have been sponsored.

Ercola Village. In the afternoon we visited by car a village where Pastor Jidigu labours to win souls. He told me that most are still involved in idol worship but gradually they are hearing the gospel and responding. They showered me with flower petals before I spoke and afterwards all requested prayer. I had to tell some of them to remove their fetishes, which they have bought to bring good luck from the witch doctor..

In the evening we go to the outskirts of the town to a small church. The noise was almost unbearable and then the lord helped me to declare his Word. After a nights rests we set off to take the children to the beach. They were so thrilled. I walked up and down for an hour in prayer.

Chondole village. This was an open air village meeting where the folk sat on mats many listened with rapt attention to the Word Many responded in a sinner's prayer. Many came seeking healing I prayed for another 30 folk in great need.

Babpatla. The harbour and Church. We hired an old car for R600 the steering was suspect brakes bad, and set of 60 klm to the harbour district stopping on the way at the police inspectors house to ask for protection. On arrival safely we toured the fishing area and went to the fishermen's village. The smell of bad fish permeated everything. The conditions were primitive and squalid. Around 80 or more folk gathered around listening to the Word

Another amazing meeting with a wonderful anointing on "Toiled all night and caught nothing, "where 80 responded in praying a sinners prayer...Some women were sobbing. Leaving the

fishermen we drove into the town in total darkness there was a power cut and went to the local village church. The Lord enabled me to proclaim his word, seven fires of God then prayed with 30 or 40 folk.. After supper, I had cold potatoes and cabbage, returned thankfully and very tired, safely to Bapatla City.

Sunday Bapatla, Meeting in Orphans Home. I take my last meeting in Bapatla speaking to the children and say goodbye. The car arrives and is another dangerous car. The steering very bad and the driver has to pump the brakes to make them work. A long journey but arrive safely in Vijayawada to sit for two hours on the platform waiting for the train to Bangalore.

Bangalore The train arrived at 4 40 and we set off for a 14 hour journey arriving in the morning. I am offered a bottom bunk and retire at 8 PM to lurch through the night. The train arrives at Bangalore at 10 AM. There is no one to meet me. I telephone and wait a half an hour before a 4 wheeler comes to rescue me., While waiting I am threatened by a man who apparently is mad.

I call a nearby policeman who is not really interested. The traffic is horrendous and the exhaust fumes fill the air with blue smog. The cars are almost gridlocked but we fight our way through chased at one point by an angry traffic policeman. I arrive at Headquarters to meet Francis and then set off again to other side of town to my lodgings in a guest house. I met Mary Adams a writer who is compiling a book on the life of Pastor Francis Jackson. We go to the city shops and I buy some cornflakes'..

Bangalore 1st Church Tuesday | the Lord search the heart...

Around 80 folks singing with loud amplification and drums Preached at 8 10 PM The power failed half way through and we were plunged into darkness after a while I continued with the help of candles then my translator arrived and we swapped over.

The young man who had started translating had been his first time... One or two women came to thank me for the word. Two bible students came to request prayer and also the Pastor and his family.

2nd Church Wednesday

Arrived at 7 15 PM in a small church The Lord helped me give the message. "Our God is a consuming fire" Many were touched by God.

3rd Church Thursday

Pastor Jackson invited me to speak in his church. It was prayer meeting night. When I arrived another power cut and entered the prayer hall to find it lit by candles. Much fervent prayer and great attention to the Word.. I shared testimony and some lessons. Many were touched.. After the word many came for prayer. One woman with some mental complaint fell to the floor as I prayed for her. An American man named all prayed and prophesied over me..

Trial of return journey.

All was set for my return to England I had booked a flight from Bangalore to Madras at 8PM I had to arrive at the airport at 7 PM. I asked pastor Jackson to send transport. I spoke to the drivers during the day requesting that they arrive on time.. They were due at 6PM but did not arrive.. I waited until 6 15 PM

before taking my case and walking down the road to the local computer shop where I knew there was a telephone.

I had visited the internet café over the last four days and found them helpful and friendly. Earlier I had asked them to give me some telephone numbers of local taxi firms, which they had done. Now I asked could they please telephone for a taxi to the airport... Sadly when they got through the taxi could not come for another half an hour. Too late. They tried two or three others with the same result.. I walked away back to the guest house trailing my case and bag. I had hardly got one hundred yards before a motor bike pulled up beside me.

The computer man asked could he help me give me a lift to the main road where possibly I might get an auto rickshaw. I looked at the motorbike and looked at my case.. Was it possible? Well it was only for a few local streets. I accepted his offer and climbed onto the back of the motorbike and held the heavy bag in one hand and trailed the suitcase behind in the other..

Going slowly the suitcase ran on its little wheels and we made slow progress. What I had not planned for or expected was when we reached the main road the motor bike continued speeding up. I was shocked and amazed but unable to alter anything The case raced along well but it must have been an unusual sight., After a mile or so on the main road we spotted an auto rickshaw and after negotiating a price R60 transferred my luggage.

We set off the auto rickshaw was ancient and kept stalling in the thick traffic however I praised God we were making progress and

soon arrived at the airport departure lounge. It was exactly 7 PM. I had made it. Praise the Lord

50.000 Tracts I emailed John Harder of Evangelical Tract Distributers and requested 50.000 tracts for distribution in the delta region at Rajahmundry. Every 12 years around 12 million Hindus arrive to bathe in the river to wash away their sins. More than 150 pastors and their churches are planning to evangelise in December this year

"This is your flight" I was amazed. I had been sitting in the departure lounge expecting to board at 8.50 PM, within three minutes I was on the plane and shortly after we were airborne.. It was 8.05PM

I had assumed that the 8.50 was my flight. I could have missed it easily. What had made that woman ask me? Only the Lord knows!!!

The Philippines. Please pray as already I am involved in preparing for Mission Philippines. My dates are 22nd February until 12/13th March. I fly to Kuala Lumpur and then to Cebu City on Cebu Island to join John Valdavisio for a week in the prisons and local churches. Then ferry to Ormoc and a prison visit before travelling to Tacloban City. It will be a joy to see the Lerion's home on the higher ground. I guess there will be visits to Tacloban City jail, The hospital and local churches... DV I plan to return via Manila and Heathrow via Frankfurt.

A prisoner who describes himself as "Friend".

My family life was not great. I watched my Father beat my Mum and my Mum nag him to provoke the reaction in the first place, and I watched for 17 years. I could not handle this, my escape was in drugs, drinks and solvents. I stole to feed my habits; I did not care who I hurt in the process. I eventually blew one night, I erupted like a volcano and I took another persons life in a thoughtless manner.

I lay in prison within a prison After a few years it really hit home the pain, the hurt, there are no words to describe the taking of a life A part of your dies with that person. You cant dream, you cant love and everything everyday reminds you of what you did. Doctors gave me drugs, I could not live with what I had done and wanted to die. I thought if I take my life then in time it wont matter and maybe justice might be balanced.

I had a Bible in my cell I never went near it. I was about to end my life when I thought if I die where would I go? I cried out to God "I do not believe in you but if you are there forgive". A voice in me told me to read my Bible. I started to read Johns Gospel and then tears began to run down my face. I am not a hard man but I cried like a baby, the more I read the Bible the more I cried.

It's strange yet I felt if anything would keep me from God it was my murder, every pain , dirty deed that I had committed filled my head and I asked God to forgive them all. I fell asleep exhausted; to be honest what felt like minutes was actually hours.

I awake the next morning and I felt clean. The words went through my head. "Thank you Jesus Thank you Jesus ". I knew that Jesus I was able to believe in Him I had faith in someone who 24 hours previously I did not believe existed. Some time later I was introduced to a Christian who visits prisoners and he explained everything to me he told me of the Lords sufferings on the cross and taught me about justification praise be his name for ever.

It all made sense, I regret that it took such a horrible crime to bring me to God, yet it does show his love to me. God loves us so much and no price is too high in His eyes.

It is not going to church, choosing the right religion, and doing good deeds. This is where so many people who search get it wrong.

It is a personal relationship with Jesus, God's only begotten Son, who died for us. It is a personal relationship with him, repenting of our sins and accepting Jesus as Lord and Saviour.

Brothers and Sisters give up this world and grow in Christ, If I can help anyone then contact Martin Tuson through Set Free Prison Ministries Bangor, Northern Ireland .

Pastors Conference at Tribal region: - Lord has given a vision again to Tony to go Island called "VEDURUMONDI" which visited previous. That is nearly 200 KM from Bapatla and it is located the side of sea. If we have to go there we must cross the river by ferry and it takes half an hour journey. There are few villages and few pastors and evangelists in that Island.

Tony travelled to that Island by ferry. We arranged pastors' conference at another place in Island but no accommodation at least hut for Tony to stay on that night. Tony sat on roof of conference hall and reading bible meanwhile I am thinking and praying for accommodation for Tony that how can possible to arrange at least hut.

At that time is 9PM, suddenly a women came and saying to Tony that "just I **knew** your visit, please come to my house (hut) to stay, last time you stayed in my hut and you prayed for my problems. Now God solved my problems and blessed my family, and also God has given new cot (bed), refrigerator, etc. Please come and stay".

We wondered about that situation and Lord's great thing. Tony stayed in that hut (that roof of dry grass) and slept on the new cot even though lack facilities that water, good food, electricity power and toilets. This is Tony's second visit in that Island.

Nearly 40 Pastors attended at evening session and next day time 100 pastors attended for the Conference in that Island. Some of the Pastors came from 20 kilometers other side of the river by bicycles. The amazing thing is some of the pastors came by walk from 10 KM. Many pastors learned how to grow in obedience and faithful life. The messages touched pastors' hearts. We distributed new booklets to pastors.

Pastors Conference at Sheila's Home: - We arranged Pastors Conference at Sheila's home ground. 250 Pastors attended and 50 Pastors attended before evening session. Tony's revival messages touched and moved every pastor's heart.

We were invited by letter to go to India to sing and minister to the people. We prayed and asked the Lord to guide us. The answer was, "No go to Poland." One year later we were invited to India again and we asked the Lord. Again He answered with, "No, go to Ireland."

Another letter came from India but we were led of the Holy Spirit to go and preach the Gospel to a hundred English towns and cities. I was stunned, but amazingly the Lord led me to a hundred English towns and cities.

The years passed. Had I missed the chance? Had I unwittingly by-passed God's perfect will? I prayed, "Lord it is impossible, I cannot do this. I am not able." The Holy Spirit said, "Go and I will show you my glory." I will never forget the amazing blessing as I went from town to town and city to city declaring God's message of Salvation.

Several more years passed and one day while in prayer, I knew that God was now calling me to go to India. I didn't have to ask this time, I knew. I told no one, not even Sheila, I kept this secret hidden in my heart.

In due course I arrived at a place called Royapuram, south of Madras and spent time singing and preaching the Word of God. Afterwards I visited the Madras headquarters before traveling to Stuart Purram. Less than sixty years ago this place was a 'no go' area, for the police and the Indian army. Anyone who dared to venture there was in danger of being murdered! Brother Joe's father, Joshua Daniels dared to take the Gospel into that place. The hand of God was upon him. Not only did he have divine protection but he was allowed to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Many of the villains who had committed murder in the past were convicted of their sins and gave their hearts and lives to Christ. They too began to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. They introduced regular meetings with just a few people attending; but the number grew to about a hundred. Now thousands gather to hear God's Word. These people were mainly Hindus and Muslims, but many have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour.

After much prayer, the Lord opened the way for me to stand on the platform to sing and preach to a vast crowd. This was the fulfillment of the vision that God had given me all those years ago. He gave me such love and joy. When I returned home after receiving so many wonderful blessings in India, the Lord reminded me of His Word in Habakkuk 2:2 "And the Lord answered me and said, *"Write the vision and make it plain on the tables, that he may run that readeth me. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and lie not, though it may tarry, wait for it, because it will surely come. It will not tarry."*

Testimony

Anthony Daly 13th March 09

I was brought up as a Catholic, I went to Mass had confession, I attended a Catholic school St Anthony's in Woodford Wells, now London. UK but I was not saved. I had knowledge of Jesus Christ but I remained dead in my sins.

As a teenager I left off going to church and joined the British Merchant navy travelling in America and South America in Venezuela the Caribbean and Maracaibo lakes transporting crude oil from south to North America.

At the age of 33 I was told the gospel, that I was a sinner that Jesus Christ died for my sins and the sins of the whole world and that God was not willing that any should perish but all come to repentance and faith in Christ, as personal Lord and Saviour.

One day I fell on my knees and confessed my sins in true repentance and found the gospel to be true I was wonderfully saved filled with the Holy Spirit of God and anointed to serve him. All in a moment of time.

I was filled with the "Joy of the Lord" and found peace in my heart, knowing and believing that the Lord had saved me from sin and judgment to come. My life changed immediately because my old nature and desires were crucified, life suddenly was abundant with amazing spiritual and physical blessings.

I read the Bible avidly and spent much time in prayer in Ashburnham Christian centre sometimes praying all night. The Lord gave me a promise in Psalm 37 v 4 "Delight thyself also in the Lord and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart". I have found this to be true.

I had been a top salesman then a sales manager, selling fraternal life insurance; I had the big life style, a detached home luxurious car, and travelled widely in Europe the Mediterranean and Canada to sales conferences. I stayed in some of the top hotels and had all expenses paid, I had position, some power and was respected as a self made man.

Five years later the Lord called me to serve Him. At that time at the age of 39 He led me to sell my home, my car, throw away the television and cancel all my life insurance, (these things were my idols) in a way preparing me for a life of faith , which has continued 30 years to this day.

The Lord gave me 70 songs all about Jesus and I started to sing in Hospitals and home to the sick and the dying. A ministry opened up and developed and grew so soon. My wife and I were singing in around 23 hospitals and home preaching

a short gospel message. This was blessed of God and for many it was the last time they heard the name of Jesus on this earth.

This ministry continued as full time work for twelve years then the Lord called me to preach the Gospel in the market towns and cities all over the South of England, again for around 12 years.

Then the Lord called me to travel and preach in Ireland Poland The Philippine, and in 1992 a first visit to India with LEF the Laymen's Evangelical Fellowship. I sang and preached in some big meetings where the crowds were numbered in tens of thousands travelling to Rajamundry- Kakinada- Stuartpuram –Chennai- Visakhapatnam and many places in Andhra Pradesh in South India.

Then the Lord led me to preach the Word in prisons and in the tribal regions with the lepers the unloved and neglected poor, in the prisons, especially in the Philippines where thousands responded to the Gospel message. Many prisoners leaving prison to become pastors and evangelists.

Faith

Throughout all these years Sheila and I were trusting in the Lord for all our provision, initially we had accepted any physical work to support the mission but as we grew busier we found that the Lord was truly able to supply all our needs and we concentrated on spreading the Word.

We made an agreement that we would not appeal for money but take our needs to the Lord in prayer and we can testify that in over 30 years we have never had one debt unpaid nor have we borrowed any money and even now, as an established charity "Daily Bread Mission" we do not make any appeals for money.

Fruit. In my two recent visits to India Sheila accompanied me and we spent time visiting the pastors in their villages and were amazed at the fruit of the seed sown many years ago. In villages where I had preached the Word (many had never heard of Jesus Christ) Hindus, had been converted and saved and now churches had been established and souls were witnessing and testifying that the Lord had saved them and healed them. Many women testified that the Lord had given them children after they had sought the Lord in prayer.

When the Tsunami hit the Bay of Bengal the Lord enabled Daily Bread Missions to buy boats, for three villages, provide nets, food, clothing, medicine and gifts to repair huts in the poor regions on the coast.

The Villagers who received boats are still providing some fish regularly to the Orphans homes set up a few years ago. Sheila's Home has 35 children and Peduyim Home 26 orphans. Happy Homes established in Tacloban City in the Philippines is both a church and a feeding centre in Leyte Island.

You will notice that I have not mentioned any denomination or church. Being saved and "Born Again" does not mean you get religion.. Religion tries to change the man from the outside, Jesus Christ is the only one who can give you a new heart. Jesus promised life more abundantly, Joy peace. Yes there will be many test and persecutions tribulations but the Lord gives Grace to overcome all such trials for "We are more than conquers through Him who loved us. Romans 8 v 37

If you are one reading this testimony, remember God is only a prayer away. The only barrier between you and God is sin. When we repent truly of our sins He is faithful and just to forgive us and cleans us from all unrighteousness.

There is much more I could add to this testimony but it is written in a book and one day the full story will be told for God's glory.
