Over 1000 respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ . PTL.

There was every valid reason for not going to the Philippines the long journey confined to a small seat in an aircraft , my hip was painful, my blood pressure had soared due to anti inflammatory drugs, the mud slide, the political situation, the dangers, and at the time I booked my air fare there were no had been arrangements made, and no meetings had been booked.

Over the years this work has always been supported by much prayer but I have never experienced so many people enquiring and praying in Canada, India, Poland, UK, and in the Philippines. However having decided to cancel the mission I was left sitting in pain. I realised that there would be no souls saved, none touched by God. I knew I had to go pain or no pain so I booked my ticket..

How the Lord opened the doors is both amazing and marvellous. Glory to God Pastor Tim Tapang in Negros Occidental with Pastor Ruben and Pastor Marlon from Cebu had arranged meetings in the prisons is San Carlos City Jail, Calaond City Jail, and Gihulngan City Jail. They

brought with them boxes of Bibles for distribution to the new converts.

In the three prisons after the Word had been preached 267 prisoners had received bibles and more wanted them.. I was also invited to be guest speaker at a school where 300 children and some adults were celebrating their anniversary

On Leyte Island we visited Ormoc prison. 230 responded to the gospel call. The Lord had prepared their hearts. Pastor Lerion had managed to arrange for me to hire an air con van and after Ormoc we drove directly to Carigara to preach on the way to Tacloban City.

The prison here is situated beside the main road and the men left their huts to assemble in the compound. This meant that we had to speak to them through the high wired fence.

They listened intently and many were moved to tears. The Holy Spirit convicting them of their sins, many repenting and seeking the Lord. We distributed Gospels and tracts through the wire the men scrambled to obtain a copy and were not ashamed to read them immediately. Sadly we had to leave for our next meeting.

In Tacloban City jail around 200 or more prisoners sat as a secular group tuned up for a concert.. At that moment we arrived and Pastor Lerion told the Warden we wanted ¾ of an hour to an hour with no music. Amazingly the musicians packed up and switched off their equipment and were part of the 208 who responded to the Gospel message.

In Tacloban City I stayed in the local NFU university for P600 £6.00 a night while we visited Tacloban City Jail and Baseyon Samar Island where two more jails were visited.

Once more the Lord poured out His Spirit and I witnessed many more hundreds of prisoners repenting, believing and receiving Christ as their own personal Lord and Saviour. The Lord having graciously supplied money for Bibles we were able to distribute to the men who manifested a desire for the Word

The arrangements for Bicol Island fell through, I was not disappointed as the Lord had warned me before that this was a possibility and I had made provisional arrangements. The Lord led me to return to Cebu Island where Pastor Ruben and Pastor Marlon had more prison meetings scheduled. More amazing scenes with men in terrible and awful conditions listened intently to the word and responded 100%

The power of praise in the worship times and the evidence and witness of the Holy Spirit confirmed that the Lord had prepared the ground for the precious incorruptible seed. We visited Cebu City jail, Danau City Jail Lapu Lapu having visited the women's section there, the junior section and the main prisons where up to 200 or 300 men were confined.

I have been used to the squalor in the jails but was continually shocked at the filth, darkness, heat, overcrowding and in sanitary conditions. Sadly there is not much hope for these men outside the prison with no prospect of employment and a deep, deep poverty prevailing all around.

In all more than 1500 indicated they wanted to follow Jesus, men and women who have prayed a sinners prayer, some broken and deeply moved by the

message who indicated a real repentance and a desire to be saved. The Lord is building His church in a wonderful way in the prisons.

There were many difficulties, English food was scares, the heat, the bad roads, the accommodation (apart for my stay in Villa Ormoc Hotel in Ormoc City) I was bitten by mosquitoes, bitten by ants, my Case fell out of the luggage rack in the coach breaking my Computer keyboard.

My nights were disturbed so I was constantly tired, some days I preach four times added to the long journeys over rough broken roads, but the Lord strengthened me.. At times I forgot all about my hip It was anesthetized by God until I returned to London to foolishly run up the stairs at Victoria Station rushing for a train.

I had a meeting in Pastor Lerion's Home with 30 Children. Bob Lerion had organized a viewing of the Jesus Film in the LNU University where 60/70 young students viewed the film I was asked to speak to them before the film began. So with the Lord helping I preached the Gospel.

Belly Pastors Praise the Lord

Pastor Elisha asked me to take a meeting in a slum area around 30 folks 15 18 young men newly converted. Later he testified the Lord had touched their hearts.

Around 40 pastor gathered as Pastor Raja had eliminated the covetous pastors and what they called the (Belly Pastors)

These attend all the pastors conferences seeking gifts a free meal and it occupies the time during the week

In Puna Pastor Raju and his family. Solomon Samuel all working as a team. I was invited to Pastor Solomons Orphan Home where 10 children were gathered. A beautiful children message including Elixer of Life. The Lord had 3 young men two aged 16 one aged 17 who drank in the word

Before leaving in the car I gave each a Jeremiah 1 v 7 envelope with some rupees. We will see what they can do with a small seed. They had exams the next morning but came to later stages of the Pastor conference

The men were all gathered at 10 AM and the Lord anointed the Word . When I stopped for a break Pastor Raja showed me his cell phone and told me that i preached for 2 hours 32 minutes. Then I returned to preach for another hour. I could have continued but more and more were falling asleep having got up very early and most not at all used to long messages however powerful. Later they came to see me in my room but Raja protected me other wise I would be praying without an anointing

Disappointed as I had prepared a strong message for young men, The Lord helped me and I gave my best for the children and women. Gospel was there and Valli came along too.

Markenpur 27th Oct 2016

Sheila and I were holding a Gospel meeting in All Saints hospital in Eastbourne when we met Giles. He had been visiting the hospital at the same time.

We met and talked. It quickly became apparent that we all loved the Lord Jesus. We discussed the open air Gospel meeting I was planning to hold on the following Wednesday in Hailsham. Giles wanted to join me and decided to meet me at our house a for coffee before we set off.

He arrived in good time, we had a short time of prayer, then ventured out. Walking through the narrow twittens leading to the town it took only a short time to reach the town centre. As we walked we distributed a few tracts to those dear folks who were passing by. I have always believed in 'sowing as you go.' (travel)

When we arrived I was appalled to find the town was virtually empty, it looked and was deserted. I was partly embarrassed because Giles had made the effort to come out with me and partly ashamed of my 'pygmy' prayers. Could I not touch the heart of God?

In silence and desperation I asked the Lord, 'What shall we do? Lord help.'

Giles and I got separated somehow. I continued to pray. 'Lord help.'

Then it happened. The Lord prompted me to preach the Word. There were just two people sitting on the seat waiting for a bus.

'Now, preach now.'

I looked at the two people and hesitated.

The Holy Spirit prompted me again, 'Preach now.'

I had to obey. Standing on the edge of the pavement by the bus stop I lifted my voice and started to preach Christ and Him crucified. The two folk sat and listened. Bless them! I was grateful for their presence.

Many people get up and walk away when you start to preach the Gospel. They don't realise that the Gospel is life-changing, not only by offering them Salvation but also by giving their lives a richness and wholeness it never had before..

I was fully into the Gospel when I spotted a gang of approximately twelve or more youths running from the Health Centre. They looked as though they were about fourteen years old. Remarkably, they sat on the available seats and the rest squatted cross-legged on the ground.

I felt it was a great privilege to preach. I had freedom to speak and was filled with the love of God. The Words of Life flowed from me. I preached on many subjects including:

Moses lifting up the serpent in the wilderness, (Numbers 21:5-9)

Abraham's offering of Isaac, (Genesis 25:1-14) The two blind men, (Matthew 9:27-31)

The parable of the good Samaritan, (Luke 10:30-36)

The birth of Jesus Christ. (Matthew 1:18-25)
The life of Jesus Christ. (The Gospels of Matthew,
Mark, Luke and John)

The death and resurrection (Matthew 27:11-Matthew 28::20

Mark15:21-Mark16:16; Luke 22:66-Luke 24:53; John19:16-John 25:25)

The youths showed great interest and paid attention all the time I was preaching.

I finally made an appeal for any of them to give their life to Jesus Christ. To make it difficult for them I said, 'I can offer you a Gospel to read, on one condition. I challenge you to read a chapter every day for a month and see how God speaks to you through His Word.'

When I offered John's Gospel, "Love is the Bridge," I was thrilled when they swarmed around me all wanting a copy of God's precious Word.

Giles had returned eventually and we talked with the group for some time. Giles gave his testimony and I shared mine with them. They seemed hungry for more.

Later as the group began to split up and separate I found myself speaking to a young woman. She confessed she had been drinking the blood of a goat at a 'satan (? satanic) sacrifice in the nearby Arlington woods. I was very aghast.

'How old are you?' I asked.

'Fourteen,' she replied.

'You are in great danger. If I were you, I would get on my knees, truly repent and ask God to forgive you.'

There were many other things Giles and I told her in that long counselling session. We urged her to read the Gospel of John and ask Jesus to come into her life by and with His saving grace. We had helped her as much as we could. With prayer in our hearts we left the rest to the Lord and returned home.

Once again, God had turned water into wine, (John 2:1-11 made a blessing out of what appeared to be nothing. How He loves to get honour to Himself by using the weak things of the world to confound the mighty and the foolish things to confound the wise and the base

things which are despised hath God chosen. Yea, the things that are not, to bring to things that are naught that are.

(1 Cor. 1:27-28) KJV

Excerpt from Journal Tribal region
It was an erie scene with small pools of yellow light
in the darkness of the village.. Slowly the people
gathered and I commenced my Word.

I got under way but there was a disturbance and some folk were talking. I rebuked them and got their attention again. I preached on the "Midnight Cry" When I see the Blood I will Passover was at midnight. Oil. The foolish virgins were caught without oil at Midnight and Joy. Paul and Silas were in jail and sang praise to God at midnight. The Lord helped me greatly. At 9 PM we were heavily engaged in prayer and then the doctor gave out medicines after a cursory examination. Around 10 PM we set off again and arrived in another village. I was asked to giver a word in a hut. The lessons of Amalek Galation 5 v 16 If we walk in the Spirit we shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.. "Thou shalt hear | word behind thee saying this is the way walk ye in it".

Later as I prayed with the folk at the end of the meeting a woman started to moan. It sounded demonic to me. This increased in intensity until she was in a hysterical state. No one seemed to think this at all extraordinary. When I prayed for her she fell uncontrollably to the floor unconscious. I told the shocked folk to give her some water. As we had to leave for a two hour journey back to Rajamundry. Arrived safely 2 AM

On the train to Markapur two aggressive Hindu men questioned pastor Raja

Daily Bread Missions - For Prayer Praise and Thanksgiving:

The Mission was soon labelled "Mission Impossible" both physically and spiritually. Covering 5 states and nearly 3000 miles internally, reaching over 1200 pastors in the tribal regions; including 12 pastors meetings, 8 village meetings and 10 Gospel meetings in Sheila's Home. Followed by a pastors meeting in a church in Yanam and a pastors meeting in Kakinada and family meetings in Hyderabad. Only through the many hundreds of pastors in India and the many faithful Christians praying in UK did the Lord turn it to "Mission Accomplished."

I have been ministering in India since 1998 but the spiritual struggle on this trip was intense. I was shocked as the deeper we went into the tribal regions the more horrible the paganism and idol worship and the more poverty. The theme was Warning, Jer 1 v 7-8 Ezekiel 3 v 17 -23 Ezekiel 33 v 3 -8 Testimony Psalm 118 v17 Jer 30 v 17 /Teaching on a Life prayer/Obedience/Faith/ Sacrifice/ Then Challenge. Isaiah 6 v 8 -Ezekiel 22 v 30 - Acts 21 v 13. Spirit Led Evangelism Act 8 v 29 Acts 16 v 6-7.

Booklets - We distributed the "Discipleship Booklets" in 5 languages as we travelled. In Hyderabad Joseph and Mary presented me with the "Discipleship Booklet." They explained it took three translators and one printers' editing to complete the translation in Malayalam for the state of Kerala, and they had paid for the printing themselves and sent 1000mn copies to Sheila's home for distribution. Pastor Elijah told me he has contacts in

other states and will distribute the booklets to key pastors.

Pastors Meetings - These pastors are key men in the battle for souls in India. In Piduguralla pastors walked 10-15 miles starting at 05:00 to arrive on time 10:00. In Pune the Word was anointed and the Spirit of the Lord moved in power. At the time for the challenge and appeal many pastors were deeply moved.

Blessings - Many Hindus listened outside the meeting at the windows and doors as the Word went forth.

Discipline - Pastors were invited for "Fasting Prayer" an hour before each meeting. Cell phones were banned and late comers had to wait before joining the meeting.

Sujan - Who translated for me in Guntur was anointed by the Holy Spirit with fire and stayed as my translator for 14 more meetings including Yanam and Kakinada. Many times "Glory to God," the Spirit moved among the men. A woman who knows Sujan well, remarked on the change in his ministry, she said that she had never heard him preach like that. That is with assurance confidence and with some fire. PTL

Pune - I was shocked at extreme poverty in tribal regions. The pastors struggle with poverty. My translator was deeply moved, weeping, many other pastors touched by God.

Villages - In the Historical village a Muslim girl prayed a sinners prayer came forward for prayer. I prayed for blessings at the site of the building of the new church. In Delhi in a slum village, many young men after the message on faith, were weeping.

Sheila's Home - Ratna Kumari returned with husband Suresh and a baby; the children are required by law to attend school 7 days a week. The children meet every night for Gospel and Worship.

Opposition - Since President Modi threatened publically that there would be "No Christians or Muslims in India by 2020," this has given encouragement to Militant Hindus to attack Christians. I was guarded leaving meetings and car doors were always locked. Pastors attending meeting in Delhi were questioned; "Why have you come?" and "What village do you come from?" On the train to Markapur two aggressive Hindu men questioned pastor Raja about me. "Who is this man? Why has he come? Is he attending a conference?" We had to move seats and I was thankful to God when I got off the train safely.

Travel/ Prayer/ Food - The Lord kept me safe on many rough roads and long train journeys some 12-18 hours. I was awake at 05:00 most mornings and most meetings were 4-5 Hours. I also spent many hours on the roof of my accommodation snatching some cool air early mornings and late afternoon while I prayed Pastor. Raja, Valli, Beulah and Mary all providing English food. I am sorry this report is so brief but only a small book would give a full account of the many amazing blessings; the Lord kept Sheila safe. Lives were changed God was Glorified and I trust that the Lord Jesus was Magnified; Tony

Also distributing booklets of "Discipleship Course" in Oriya language also Endure Hardness as a Good soldier of Jesus Christ and my Bible study "Our God is a Consuming Fire" Pastor Raja will be conducting a follow up meeting with tribal pastors in Edhurumondi again under the banner of PTPF. Pastor Raja has already set up this new pastor fellowship for mutual support prayer and bible study again also distributing Booklet translated in Telugu Tamil and Hindi. The Pastors are thrilled for these booklets in their own language.

Pastor Raja has already contacted pastors in Tamil Nadu and also Maharashtra State with a plan to arrange pastor's conferences there. He plans to distribute the recently translated and printed discipleship booklets to pastors in Hindi and Tamil languages and he feels it would be beneficial and a blessing for me to be there.

I will let you know as soon as the Lord makes it clear.

Yesterday I had my first Word from the Lord for India. Very specific and challenging. So I am encouraged.

For Prayer Praise and Thanksgiving Prison Ministry Philippines April 26th May 4th 2007

There are no words to describe the blessings in the prisons in Negros Island Philippines. Thank you all for praying the Lord certainly answered with an abundance of blessing

Physically I found the trip exhausting, the heat up around 35 degrees and daily long distances over rough mountainous roads were only made possible with the

Lord's help. Pastor Tapaang and his wife Nida had travelled all over the island two weeks previously to visit each prison and make the arrangement. This was a colossal task as the small van (the Bone shaker) had a transmission problem which reduced the slow speed on rough roads to a snail's pace, sometimes only 5 or ten miles per hour crawl. Please pray as Pastor Tapaang has arranged with each prison to conduct regular follow up meetings once as month with the local pastors visiting the prisoners once a week.

Its was amazing to see the hunger for the Word of God, the attention the prisoners paid as they listened and the almost 100% response to the messages. A few prisoners in each jail already had a Bible and followed the Scriptures as I preached. The prison wardens and rehabilitation staff are enthusiastic and very grateful for our ministry as they see the effect changed attitudes and changed lives have on the daily routine in the prison.

Pastor Tim Tapang explained and introduced a regular Bible study with a booklet on the basis of Salvation and discipleship. The prisoners were given a New Testament and on the successful completion of this study booklet, will be given a second book, when this is completed they will be presented with a diploma and are given Bible in the dialect of their choice

I found this trip most amazing and wonderful. Pastor Tapaang has a vision to visit all the prison on the island next year we only accomplished half. I cannot possibly quantify how many souls were saved but I can testify that the Lord touched many hundreds of hearts and that around 750-800 prisoners received New Testaments and

literature with the Prison Wardens Governors (some Christians) were joyfully requesting and receiving Bibles.

To witness so many men and women devouring the Word of God has left a deep impression and I rejoice and thank the Lord for the privilege of seeing the Lord's mighty hand at work. Jeremiah 33 v 3 was answered in a marvellous way, may the Lord receive all the Glory.

The Lord kept Sheila safe and my new hip passed the gruelling test of 10 days of almost continuous travel, cramped up in the restricted space. Once again the Lord had provided for every need by His riches in Glory by Chris

The prison ministry is in capable hands and is on a sound footing with excellent follow up; Tony feels this door is now closed. DVD is available on request of Prison ministry,

It was Hindu festival off farmers. The Hindus were lighting fires in the streets and Tony was told that they expected spirits to visit at night.

For three days the city was filled with the aroma of burning wood. The medical bus stopped to pick up Dr Prakesh before they headed out of the city.

Setting off in the Medicare bus they headed out of the city towards the tribal region. The road steadily becoming rougher as they proceeded off the main road to a track Holding on as the bus jolted swerved veered and descended into river crossings before winding its way relentlessly onward. Passing through villages scattering the chickens and stopping without warning as slow moving cattle blocked the road... The journey was uneventful and after some three hours we alighted with stiff legs in a small town by the river bank. Apparently Pastor was to hire a boat for pour journey up river...

It was 11pm and Tony commenced to preach. Around twenty rather sleepy people sat crossed legged on the floor. During the praise time Tony was shocked when a woman started to wail. It sounded eerie. Later when he prayed for her she fell unconscious to the floor. The Christians were shocked and ran to assist. Tony believed that she was demonized he told them she will be all right and as they had to leave requested that that they give her some water,.

As it was late they bundled gratefully into the van and set of in the dark. The road was a cement construction winding through the jungle dropping down suddenly to cross the dry river beds and lurching all the time. It was impossible to sit comfortably as the van was like a boat rocking and swaying. Passing through villages there were groups of men who were standing around fires waiting for the spirits to come on several occasion they would gesticulate as the van approached run into the road with the intention of stopping its progress. This was more dangerous than Tony had at first realized because they would have been a prime target for attack. They were in the tribal region with no police no army no authority and at the mercy of some of these dangerous men. Tony was told that when darkness came the villagers would often turn to drink and drugs and cock fighting and even on occasion human sacrifices.

Fortunately the driver was wise to the danger slowed down on approaching the men and then swerved to avoid then speeding up at the same time scattering them in every direction driving on into the night.

This particular night as they eventually drew near to the outskirts of the city a red warning light came on with a warning bleep indicating that the fuel was low. The driver stopped once or twice and they discussed what to do. As it was early now in the morning they decided to press on as far as they could. They stopped to drop off Dr Prakesh at his home and started again. The engine faltered several times and eventually cut out. What happened next was a miracle as the van continued at a reasonable pace cruising along the main road. It was so unusually silent as suddenly the driver turned off the main road and rolled down a side street. The wonder continued as turning into several side streets and the van eventually turned into the road where the orphanage was situated and rolled to a stop outside the door.

It had been amazing home safely where they all climbed wearily out and entered the darkened home to step over the bodies of the sleeping children huddled on the floor.

Pastor John Babu writes regarding the ministry at Hyderabad and Nadadavole in East and West Godavi, On the 25th Oct 2004 brother Tony Daly came to Hyderabad. We all gave our brother a hearty welcome. Firstly we went to a slum area called Ambedkar Nagar where Sister P. Devaki has been doing the Lord's ministry. Our brother Tony gave a spirit filled message there and all were filled with the Holy Spirit and much blessed. After the preaching 75 Kgs of rice distributed

to the poor and needy. They all expressed their hearty thanks for the free rice distributed.

On the same day evening we went to a slum area to a narrow street. There Pastor Moses is ministering among slum area people. There our team of Pastors prayed, bible women sang songs and prayed. Then our brother gave another message and prayed for a young man who had been suffering since two days without a voice from his mouth. Then he immediately healed and talked clearly. The name of that young man is Mr Screenu. He expressed his hearty thanks to God. He praised the Lord

So also two women who were possessed of evil forces, they both were healed after continuous prayers. They were delivered from evil forces. They gave their testimony. 75 kgs of rice were freely distributed for them. On 26th October 2004 we went to another slum area rocky place called Ram Nagar there our team pastors and Bible women sang and another spirit filled message given by our brother. They all moved and thanked the Lord.

On the 3rd November Brother Tony came to Nadadavole from Bapatla.

On the same day evening we went to the village church at Katakoesswarm for gospel preaching. On 4th November nearly 60 pastors attended the pastor's conference. Two prayer meetings with teaching from the Bible were given by Brother Tony. We have received good response from both from attended pastors and bible women and others from outside the area. We were all much blessed in these two meetings.

On the 5th November we went to the rice fields for chicken Buffalo for milk project for self supporting income for the pastors fund. On Sunday 7th we went to Thimmarajupalem village to preach among the leper brothers and sisters. A heart opened and eye opening thrilling message given to the lepers by the leading of the \Holy Spirit with Pastors John and Joseph Babu translating into Telugu.

On Sunday 7th by 1. 00 noon time we went to the sub jail, superintendent gave permission at Kovvor a small Taluk headquarter. On 8th of November the team and brother Tony visited and prayed among the slum area people. Some were healed through continuous prayers. We are all praying for all our brothers and sister in the UK. First Meeting at All Saints=

Have you any time to spare. Can you play a musical instrument? Could you spend some time talking to the patients? Please telephone sister Meyer at All Saints Hospital. The postcard in the shop had been typewritten.

Sheila had spotted it in Seaside road out side w newspaper shop. She had called Tony back and pointed out this card. They took the details.

When Tony got home he prayed about it and felt that he should contact the Hospital. The Lord had given him over 70 songs all about Jesus and the love of God he knew he must sing them somewhere. In the telephone box he prayed "Lord if this is not right please close the door, stop me from getting through, he then dialled the number, after a pause a woman answered it was Sister Meyer

Tony explained that he had seen the card and that he could play the guitar, she had asked him what sort of music. There was a silence as Tony considered what to say, should he tell her that he was a Born Again Christian and wanted to sing his Gospel songs, he decided to bite the bullet, "Its all about Jesus". There was a silence at the other end and then, Yes that's OK, when can you come? The question was unexpected, Tony thought quickly, tomorrow Tony said tentatively. They arranged a time 3PM in Northbourne Ward..

The next day in Northbourne ward Tony was shocked at the sight. The small day room was occupied by twelve elderly men in wheelchairs. They were a sad spectacle with heads bowed eyes vacant and some asleep. Sheila and Tony had said hello but there had been a minimal response so they had begun to sing. Not being used to being in public

Tony found it difficult to continue as the patients were not responding at all, just sitting there dozing. Were they in a coma Tony wondered? It was awful,

sweat trickled down his face as they continued to sing half frightened of stopping. A group of visitors had congregated at the door gazing in at the sight. Tony's pride was being dealt with Did God really want him to do this? Surely not.

At the end of the singing which lasted around forty minutes they stooped put the guitar away and went to say goodbye to the patients. As they took their hands there was a wonderful response. Some had tears in their eyes; they were so grateful and could not thank us enough. Tony and Sheila left the hospital knowing that God had blessed them and that a new chapter had begun in their Christian experience which was to lead them to minister around the World

In the following weeks other Christians came to help with the work, some elderly ladies promised to bring some hymn book and Dalybread were given 60 well worn Golden Bells hymn books. Other Christians offered to play the piano in the foyer while some offered to help wheel the patients from the wards to the foyer, Tony and Sheila decided to call themselves the "Dalybread, A Ministry of Love in Song", this was so that the group as a whole could be recognized not constantly Tony and Sheila.

One amusing incident happened in those first few weeks at Northbourne

Ward. A nurse had whispered "Would they mind having the doors shut as they wanted to remove a corpse from the ward without upsetting the patients".

Tony agreed but it was while they were singing behind locked doors that this elderly man got up from his chair and walked unsteadily over to them He stood very close to Tony almost face to face and said in a very loud voice, Will you stop singing"!!!!

The answer then as it is today 50 years later

No never . "While I have breath I will Praise the Lord"

Her special gift was to care for the sick and dying so she cared many a dear saint as they left this world and were promoted to Glory. Many times leaving home to move in to care for the dying. As you did it unto the least of these my brethren you

I would mention that as we trusted the Lord for our needs we also put our hand to the plough and did tent making. For me gardening jobs decorating, taxi service, For Sheila this added to her ministry as she fitted in the shopping cooking and house duties with a heavy list of meetings and when I was away from home this meant she had to cope with many crisis.

48 Years ago the Lord wonderfully saved me and the Holy Spirit indeed put a song in my mouth. Actually 70 Songs The Lord opened the door of All Saints Hospital Princess Alice hospital and Sheila and I commenced ministry serving the Lord and trusting Him for all our needs Living by Faith. We never had an unpaid bill but the more we were obedient the more blessings the Lord showered upon us.

There were many testing times but being guided by the Lord and trusting in His promises we travelled the "Narrow Way" Psalm 40 v 3 reaching sharing out testimonies and witnessing, preaching for town to town "They went everywhere preaching the Word. Acts 8 v 4

I would thank the Lord for those who faithfully prayed and those who supported Daily Bread Missions over the years. Who worked tirelessly and professionally in compiling backing tracks for many of the songs. I used his backing tracks in Rajahmundry when I was invited to sing and preach in an LEF meeting of 25,000 in India Gerry Page

There were many folks the Lord raised up in Elim Church where we worshipped the Lord for over 26 years the Free Church in Hailsham where we were baptised in the early days of our walk with the Lord. I testified in India that many churches in UK the Philippines and in India would follow us in prayer some rising at 5 Am in UK while I preached in India.

It was the Lord's blessing and my privilege for me to work with many Godly Pastors

In Poland Pastor Marek in Lublin Pastor Adam, Pastor Richard in Olesko , Pastor Stephan in Bialystok

In the Philippines

Pastor Lerion in Tacloban City. William and Vianey had a permit from the president to teach moral and spiritual values, this opened the doors to many prisons and barangays where we had complete freedom to preach the Gospel Pastor Swan Pastor Augustow Pastor Tim Tapang Pastor Ruebin and Pastor Roly, Pastor Fat and Pastor Joel

In India Bro Joe LEF, Pastor Raja Bapatla Pastor Nathaniel in Visag Pastor Ernest in Oriisa, Pastor Anada Rao, Evangelist Sujan and precious support and help from Joseph and Mary in Hyderabad who introduced me to Sister Sharon working in the slum areas. Later I met Pastor Joseph in Rajahmundry who arranged meetings in the ribal regiou where the pastors travelled by walk across rivers and mountains to reach the location of the Pastors conferences

Pastor Joseph worked alongside his Father Pastor John arranged meetings for me to preach the Gospel in the "Rock breakers" the owner of the business was a converted Christian so the workers could stop for an hour to hear the Word of God.

I was very privileged to be invited to speak to the patients in the Leprosy colony and was amazingly

shocked at their exuberance and overflowing joy in "praising the Lord. I was shocked because of the location of the leprosy colony the Land which had bee provided by the India government it was located in a rubbish dump and as they praised the Lord their affected limbs were covered in flies.

I was not able to touch my water bottle for the same reason. Later sadly an elder came to beg.

Rahajmundruy tribal region The next day I returned to Rajahmundry by train and in the early evening went out 60 klm to the tribal region. We travelled in the medical van, along the river bank where Pastor John has baptised hundreds of converts over the years. We bumped down endless rough tracks stopping at various places along the way to meet and pray with Pastors and families. One pastor I was told received only ten and twenty rupees in the offerings I was led to give R500 to his wife...

We stopped at the first village where I preached and prayed for around 30 folks. Some hearing the Gospel and responding for the first time. Doctor Prakesh gave out medicines. Moving on to another village where I preached at 9 PM, again more prayers, more converts and more free medicines and then onto another village where I preached at 11PM.

I think they woke up the village and called them to the meeting in a small church. At the conclusion of my message a woman was moaning and crying hysterically. It seemed very weird. I wondered if it was a demon? The doctor gave his examinations and interviewed the long queue of folk seeking help .The Lord blessed. I cannot quantify what the Lord has done...

We returned to the van very tired but could not rest on the return journey as the van was lurching over very rough tracks. Several times we were waved down by groups of men in the middle of the road but our experienced driver swerved and did not stop. As we entered the city in the early hours the van engine faltered was restarted and faltered again having run out of diesel.

Amazingly we cruised down the main road turned into side roads and came to a stop outside the orphanage. How we praised God. I stepped over some of the forty sleeping bodies in the orphanage and started to get ready for bed when the cook brought in a plate with three omelettes and chips with hot tea.

I tumbled into bed at 2 AM grateful to God for an amazing day. How many souls had been saved maybe 60? Cannot tell but I do know it was amazing and wonderful.

For Praise Prayer and Thanksgiving. Acts 8.v 29/30 Hyderabad slum area. A small room crammed with around 40 folks, plus many children and more folks crowding around the door and in the street, curious about the white man that had come. The Lord enabled

me to preach the Gospel and blessed with 30 or more responding to the message.

After the meeting we walked through the dirt and derelict district to the refuse tip. Families lived in groups of 20/30, makeshift hovels, actually in the middle of the tip. It is hard to describe the filth, sewage and stagnant water in ditches mixed with the rubbish, no water, no electricity, cooking on open fires with small sacks of rice stored in branches of the one tree, out of reach of the rats. The following day we congregated in the derelict home of a Christian with around 30/40 folk gathered to praise the Lord.

Praise God for some 30 or more responding positively to the appeal. Later after some rest we boarded the night train at 7 PM due to arrive in Rajahmundry at 5 AM.

Rajahmundry I was taken to Pastor Joseph's home and met Sunitha his wife. Please pray for her as she is three months pregnant but has a problem with low blood count. The orphanage has 30 children, 17 old folks all living eating and sleeping in one room. I found my hands badly bitten by mosquito in the night and my head spinning with tiredness. Rock breakers..

I was amazed when we drove into the middle of their work place and they left their work to gather around me. Maybe 70 or more folk. They listened intently to the Word and many, maybe 60 or more responded to the message.

Praise God. I shook hands with them all and prayed for their children, who also come to help with the labour.

Free medicines. Later after rest I prayed with the children before leaving for the evening meeting in a slum area. The folk were attentive and around twenty responded to the appeal. I then prayed as the doctor gave out free medicine to the thronging people..

Visaghapatnam. At 6PM we drove along the coast road to Tagarapuualsa town and I gave out the Word in a Baptist church. Several pastors from other churches came. Prayed for many folk including a woman with cancer a man with skin disease and a young teenager with sever sight problem.

Village meeting. Travelled on the main Calcutta highway narrowly avoiding three head on crashes to a village. The meeting commenced with me being bedecked with a garland of flowers and huge quantities of petals thrown over me. Around 15 adults and twenty five children gathered to hear the Word. Twenty folk responded to the Word. Then nearly all came for prayer, I had to tell some of them (before I could pray for them) to remove and destroy their occult fetishes, obtained from the witch doctors.

Visaghapatnam Another evening meeting in the Baptist Church in Tagarapuualsa when around 30 came forward for prayer. Returned to Hotel at 11.15 PM.

Rahajmundruy tribal region The next day I returned to Rajahmundry by train and in the early evening went out 60 klm to the tribal region. We stopped at the first village where I preached and prayed for around 30 folks. Some hearing the Gospel and responding for the first time. Doctor Prakesh gave out medicines.

Moving on to another village where I preached at 9 PM, again more prayers, more converts and more free

medicines and then onto another village where I preached at 11PM. We returned to the van very tired but could not rest on the return journey as the van was lurching over very rough tracks. Several times we were waved down by groups of men in the middle of the road (robbers) but our experienced driver swerved and did not stop. I tumbled into bed at 2 AM grateful to God for an amazing day.

Nethervole Church. "How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation". Pastor John Babu told me later a young man who had been absent from the church for a year had been present in the meeting and the Word had touched him. I prayed again for around 30 folk.

Leper Colony. In the afternoon we proceeded to the leper colony situated in a rubbish tip the land being donated free by the Indian government. Nearby a Hindu temple. The lepers mostly without fingers or toes, around 40 of them sat crossed legged and praised the Lord.

I was appalled at the scene. Pastor John Babu was trying to swot the hundreds of flies from my feet and from my water bottle. The worship time was impressive and powerful.

I gave my message and prayed and left a gift for a sack of rice...It was very moving and unforgettable experience...Please pray for them..

Pastors conference. Around 150 pastors gathered on the roof of the orphanage to hear the Word. We had two main meetings Pastor Joseph was thrilled as 100 of the pastors were from "Word in Action Outreach", but another 50 were from other denominations in the City The word went forth with power and liberty. Many were touched by God...Invitations to return were plentiful.

Tribal region. Tuesday 14th Jan . We set off at 9 am in the medical van with the Dr Prakesh and Pastor John and Joseph Babu. It was a long gruelling journey of 100 klm over rough jungle tracks. We stopped at the river town to negotiate the hire of a boat. R600 . We chugged along as the boatman bailed out the water leaking in the front while I was reminded that there are crocodiles, bears and tigers in this region.

One tiger had got so hungry he would swim out to passing boats and try to board them, once he was successful and attacked the passengers. It was eventually shot.

Kachubusa. It was beautiful journey after an hour and ten minutes we arrived at the first village, climbing up the bank 60 ft to follow the trail. The people quickly assembled and I gave m_y Gospel message to around 30 folk.

Crondura. I gave the word in a village's squalid hut and was told later that five souls were saved. Two naked boys were covered in green I was told they had chicken pox. Pathetic scenes as the doctor gave medicines. I walked out to overlook the river and pray.

We returned tired to the boat to go to the next village but this was cancelled as the Pastor said it was too dangerous. I was told Hindus in this area still have a

human sacrifice once a year and when night comes hit the bottle and have cock fighting gambling and drunken orgies... So we returned down the river in the moon light stopping only at the police boat to report our safe return. Apparently the pastor had informed the local police of out medical trip..

Orphans Home. 15th Jan. I was greeted on my birthday with the orphan children sing a happy birthday. I opened my birthday card from my case. I had been to town on the back of Pastor Joseph's motorcycle to send emails at the internet café and buy t shirt for Joseph our grandson, stock up with biscuits, grapes and some oranges. Pastor Joseph bought me a Indian suit and I wore it for the children's meeting. The Lord helped me to give the word, 2 Chron 9 v 1-7 ..."Happy are these thy servants" and Mephibosheth invited to the kings table....The Lord blessed the Word and Sunitha, Pastor Joseph's wife wept...train at 5PM

Babaptla. I arrived in the early hours to be met by Pastor Rajaptnam and the elders of his church. They garlanded me with flowers and had carried a banner of welcome...A car took us to Bhvanana Residency . I visited the orphanage where 17 children live in one room. The orphanage is 5 months behind in its rent and the pastor and his wife Sunitha struggle to feed them one meal a day. There is no where for the children to play and the building is backed by a ditch filled with refuse and stagnant water.

Chondole village. An open air village meeting where the folk sat on mats. They listened with rapt attention to the Word. Many responded to a sinner's prayer. Many came seeking healing I prayed for another 30 folk in great need.

Bapatla. The harbour and Church.. The conditions were primitive and squalid. Around 80 or more folk gathered around listening to the Word Another amazing meeting with a wonderful anointing on "Toiled all night and caught nothing," all 80 responded in praying a sinners prayer...Some women were sobbing. Leaving the fishermen we drove into the town in total darkness there was a power cut and went to the local village. The Lord enabled me to proclaim his word, then prayed with 30 or 40 more folk..

Orphans Home. I take my last meeting in Bapatla speaking to the children and say goodbye. The car arrives the steering is very bad and the driver has to pump the brakes to make them work. A long dangerous, journey but we arrive safely in Vijahawadda to sit for two hours on the platform waiting for the night train to Bangalore. We set off at 4.40 PM for the 14 hour journey. I am offered a bottom bunk and retire at 8 PM to lurch through the night arriving tired at 10 AM. There is no one to meet me!

Bangalore . Ist Church Around 80 folks singing with loud amplification and drums. I preached at 8 PM The power failed half way through and we were plunged into darkness after a while I continued with the help of candles. I was unable to pray for the folk as I was nearly exhausted.

2nd Church Arrived at 7 15 PM in a small church The Lord helped me give the message. "Our God is a consuming fire" Many were touched by God.

3rd Church I shared testimony and some lessons. Many were touched.. After the word many came for prayer. One woman with some mental complaint fell to the floor as I prayed for her. An American man named Al prayed and prophesied over me.. My return to England was traumatic! Only God kept me safe.

I thank the Lord for your faithful prayers, for keeping Sheila safe. I cannot quantify what God has done but I know "He has done great and mighty things" Jer 33 v 3.. Please pray as I prepare for Mission Philippines leaving on the 22nd February March 13th . DV Tony and Sheila saved by Grace...
