Journal Mission Philippines

November 13th December 3rd 2010 <u>Iloiolo- Passey Jail-Mambusa Prison-Victoriana's-</u> <u>San Carlos Prison-SagaI City- Church-</u>

I sent a letter to Pastor Tapang reminding him of the prisons in Iloilo Island. I had lost his email address and I had had no reply to my previous email and letter,. So I was surprised to receive his email indicating that he was willing to go and spy out the land. He emailed to say that he would do a costing of the Island while arranging the meeting in the prisons.

I was shocked to receive his blatant request for money but on reflection soon realized that this was unfair. I was also shocked when I considered my health at this time, what with high blood pressure and more especially my back hurting so much and my waterworks. After prayer I felt a deep peace as I knew many folk would be praying and he Lord would surely strengthen me. I guess the whole trip would come out at £2.000,

However my heart is strangely warmed as the prospect of going into prison to preach the gospel is exhilarating. He that winneth souls is wise . **Proverbs 11 v 30**



24th August

Last night I phoned Lionel and shared my news. He was moved by the dreadful conditions in the prisons. He is very involved and will pray. This morning I prepared various 'Words" for the prisons. Sheila and I talked about possible dates for the mission. She is not happy about my going but will not hinder me. Today I am with Joseph and we are learning about missions.

Thursday 26th August

I sent an email to Pastor Tim telling him that we do not use 'Daily Bread Mission' charity money for my missions but use our own money. Also for him to look out

for local help from local pastors. So I hope this helps prevent any miss - understandings.

Saturday 28th

Bob telephoned He is planning to come on Tuesday Arrive 10.30 DV. Went online to download application form

Friday 3rd September

Booked my air fair today. What a lot of hassle. They said no direct flight from Dubai to Cebu so its a stop over in Manila. Ugggh

Also the price has doubled to over $\pounds 1,000$, However the Lord provides and He is not shocked.

Monday 12th Dover Castle wonderful day. Back At 3 30 pm After dinner Joseph asked a question I gave him our testimony of living by faith ,giving money - tithing and Sheila testified of her healing.

-Journal Monday 8th November

Walked to bank to pay debit card and transfer £150 to Joseph and Mary for our flight Sent emails to Sendwise and Sujan Heard the Lord has touched hearts. PTL

13th November

Awake 4AM Enjoyed breakfast Peter Joan and dog came a 9AM. Lovely easy drive to Gatwick arrived 9.50AM I was shocked to find my case only to Manila. Oh dear. The woman was helpful telephoned to find that there was another flight that evening at 8.30PM. and that I had booked on a through ticket. So thy could put me on the next flight DV Lord please help

Lord please help.

Now 11 AM.

Thank you Lord for the first stage completed .Hallelujah Praise the Lord

Had message . Behold the hand of the Lord is not shortened that it cannot save ,nor His ear heavy that He cannot hear but your iniquities have separated you from you and your God and your sins have hid his face from you Sin the barrier - imputed righteousness. Abraham staggered not Romans 4.v3,---v 20--- v 24

8,45PM descending now to Dubai .Local time 23,50 Thank you Lord. Having coffee €6,00 Some facts for Joseph 445 miles=1hr 05 minutes Bengalari=Bangalore Kolkald =Calcutter Landed in Dubaiit took 25 minutes to taxi to a stop and another 15 minutes on the bus from the plane to terminal My gate is 228-Leaving at 4. 20AM DV Thank you Lord for stage one. Thank you for the kind Emirates check in clerk who gave me seat number 11. Amazing and wonderful Went to refresh and clean my teeth. Sadly no toothpaste in the tube. Plans of mice and men. Apparently I am the only white man on this flight Correction .6 white men I am not alone. 3,23AM . I am in departure lounge. I guess they have to allow time for the coaches to pick up. PTL on board 4,10AM Sincing charges Truct in him. I'm so happy now Lwelk with Lasys. Why did he

Singing choruses Trust in him .I'm so happy now I walk with Jesus, Why did he care. Wonderful wonderful Jesus is to me An hour to go. What will happen I trust I will be in Cebu tonight Hallelujah anyway Glory to God

Flight was bumpy but just a hour Jason and Omega were waiting booked into ACE and prayed with them I gave them £40,gift and excused them from taking me to the airport tomorrow, I will get a taxi.

I read the family card and read Sheila's card with Isaiah 40 v 38-40 Those who wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength. which seems entirely suitable. Now to bed to at least rest my body Thank you Lord I caught that plane. Never again.

Monday 15th

After being awake and tidying my room at 1AM I settled down to sleep Awake.8.3AM Feeling refreshed.. Thunder and rain in the night now sunny: Lord lead and guide. Must send email buy food, Walked across to shopping mall .Bought cornflakes. milk juice and water. sent emails changed money £100=P6700 Praise the Lord.

Found shop that sells T shirts bought 2 each for Joseph and Matthew.

Week One . I am in Cubu domestic

The system is antiquated and yet based on fleecing the passenger of every last Peso. A large family eight of them took ages .We all had to be weighed .I paid p240 for excess weight not me, but the luggage. Another P 200 for airport tax

and so it goes on. Hallelujah 1.25PM I am waiting in gate 8 lounge I think we catch a bus out to the plane. Thank you Lord Later.1.40PM on board seat 16C

A small propeller plane. Its so hot sticky. On landing we walked across the tarmac to baggage where my case soon appeared. Outside there was no one waiting because Pastor Tim and pastor Jewel on the way to the airport had to change a wheel. I was introduced to Pastor Jewel who had found a college willing to let us use rooms for a week. New Lucina college. The rooms are small have air con but no hot water. This will be our base or the coming week.

After we unloaded our cases we went out searching for food. I found place and obtained some milk -biscuits-coffee. On our return Pastor Tim and Jewel went off to have the puncture repaired while sorted out. We have use of a fridge and we are trying to get use of a kettle.

Now 5.45,I was just sorting out the room actually I was doing some washing in the bathroom when a brown out occurred. Now sitting in the dark the Pastors are having the puncture repaired. Later; They returned with torches and we sat out on the balcony telling and sharing our testimonies

Pastor Jewel suggested more meetings .He can invite a few pastors to come and Pastor Tim asked if we could talk to the students I gave pastor Jewel two disks of our ministry singing in hospital he can transfer to computer. Later pastor Tim knocked, I gave him the money £700 and we talked and prayed. He is very tired as he was up with his friend in Bacolod Hospital who had a emergency operation to remove tumor. We prayed for his recovery.

Later I made some coffee, ate to boiled eggs and two banana's read my Bible and now ready for bed. First prison tomorrow DV

Monday.16th November

I was up in the night. I read Sheila's message number 2 .S of S Then the Lord gave me some messages. Wonderful. A word for pastors-I seemed to have been awake all night. Up 6 AM. Hot water to shave and wash. Breakfast cornflakes boiled egg. Washing is dry. Tidy room. We go at 8AM DV Already hot and sticky Lord thy will be doneLast night I learned that pastor Layagan's daughter Sheila drowned a year ago.

Later; Iloilo city

Amazing .Glory to God. A church in prison. The city jail holds 500 men. Many men were occupied in making things with folded paper. The meeting room held around 80 men and they were ably led by Arlan Francisco who was serving a life sentence for drugs. Another man played the guitar and they sang two songs. The Lord helped me to give my message and testimony. The response was heart warming with around 60 or more responding positively Praise God

San-ta Barbara

In the afternoon we arrived early for the women's prison and sat in a dirty cafe while drinking coffee.

Around 65 women laid deep attention to the words. There were many smiles Amens and other positive responses. Pastor Tim prayed with them as he asked them to stand as a step indicating a commitment to the Lord. Amazing Wonderful A flood of warmth as I shook their hands and said God bless.

We stopped at a shopping mall to obtain cheese slices -lettuce-tomatoes- more cornflakes-and some soft rolls

I also bought a mug and gave p50 as half of a water heater. Back at our rooms I found my shirts had dried and quickly prepared 4 cheese and tomatoes rolls. They were good so I ate two and left two for tomorrow.

I was not prepared when pastor Tammy knocked on the door to ask if we would visit Pastor Jewel. I had lots to do but agreed so we walked around the side .Pastor had prepared rice and fish so I sat with his wife and shared my photos. She makes uniforms for the trainee nurses also they make their own candles. As we have an early start we left at 8 30 PM and walked back Pastor Tim was struggling with painful cramp so we stopped and waited for him. I am now waiting for some hot water to wash before bed and needful sleep.

Awake and up at 1,20AM

Wednesday 17th November

Startled by the alarm at 5.35AM .We are heading for the ferry to go to Guianaas Island

Lord lead guard guide us and keep us safe in Jesus mighty name Later off 6,30 AM. reached the ferry at 7.30 Wonderful timing last on first off. got good shots of Bamboat.

San Miguel

Safely across 8 AM heading for San Miguell Amazing help from the Lord.

Men in cells around listened attentively many prayed sinners prayer. Around 60 were listening and I witnessed a spirit of joy and warmth o many faces. Pastor Jewel was a good translator and I noticed that he deeply moved. Later we gave literature and Pastor Tim prayed with a man who was weeping;

We returned to Jordan port to wait for our return ferry the pastors enjoying a meal in a cafe.

We are expecting a return ferry at 12.30 but now we have to wait until 3 o'clock. Lord thy will be done

We are trying to get a Bamboat across and be picked up by Pastor Felix. It worked. The Bamboat was lovely it only took ten minutes Pastor Felix drove us to the rehab centre, it was hazardous as he constantly used his cell phone. However we arrived safely and we led to the meeting room where 25 youngish men were waiting

Pastor Felix sang for me to live is Christ to die is gain, while playing with the mike system which was dreadful. Why do they do it?

I gave the Word and testified and did some straight talking. I prayed for the men asking the Lord to change their lives to save them and sat down. Pastor Tim prayed and then I talked with one or two. The journey home was so quick I was amazed to watch pastor Felix while driving sitting in front giving Pastor Tim phone numbers Later I took a photo of the infected men all ignoring me while each was pressing buttons

I am sitting outside on the porch while the evening traffic noisily passes by. Pastor Tim is still texting but I am blessed by a cool breeze. I asked for two things an internet connection and hot water for a shower. There was a brown out so we sat out on the veranda talking Pastor Tim gave his testimony.

The Pastors wanted to go out for their meal so I accompanied them. There was no water and we planned to obtain some and find an internet cafe. I was introduced to the musical director and we may meet him tomorrow atone of the meetings. When the power was restored we found an internet cafe and I managed to send an email to Karen and Sheila before it switched off. Returning with more water to eat tidy and then miracle gave a hot bath with minimal water. Hallelujah. Now to bed Thank you Lord

Friday 19th November

Awake 5 30AM Pastor Jewel brought hot water for bath

Barotoc Viejo

The prison was in a tribal region up a rough track

I was shocked inside at the scene that mt my eyes, The prison a square divided into 6-8 sections with 10-15 men in each section.

Some sections with 25 men a total of 166 men and 5 women. The prison layout was difficult for a preacher. What to do. We stood together and prayed. I was led to preach a short message. The men listened intently and the response was very moving and precious. The Lords presence was apparent.

I noticed that the guard was watching and listening to each message as we moved from section to section. The response never varied but following an appeal and challenge a sinners prayer all men well at least 95 per cent accepted Jesus Christ. I am sure the angels in heaven were rejoicing. Glory to God. We shook hands with .he men Pastor Jewel and pastor Tammy had distributed gospel tracts so we thanked the guards and drove to a place where the pastors had a meal

Later we drove back to the city and I re arranged my return flight from Cebu to an earlier time. Praise the Lord. Then we drove to the shopping mall and I sent e mails with the day's news

We arrived quickly back at the rooms where I found the tomato had gone off also the lettuce and tragically the bread rolls were now crawling with ants Ah well. I did make a cup of coffee boil water to wash my clothes and charged my camera batteries. I sat outside for a while and edited my photos some were pure rubbish. I left two shirts to be ironed by one of the students, hope I get them back in time

Saturday 19th November

Passey Jail

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Talked with pastor Tammy over breakfast, He preaches in the street. I promised to ask for tracts for him. .We set off Passi Jail. The Word was blessed of God, Around 69 men committed themselves to God praying a sinners prayer. .The next jail contained 40 prisoners Again an amazing response. One man asked if there was a resurrection Pastor Tapang spoke with him,. Pastor Tammy asked could give his testimony. Glory to God

We stopped at the provincial jail but it was the prisoners day of recreation so we dove into the city to eat then get some shopping.

Pastor Tim wanted to change the oil ,we found a garage but had to wait while some other car had a service. Pastor is asleep beside me while we wait. In the shopping mall Pastor Jewel talked with woman seeking to arrange another meeting tonight at 7 o'clock with some abused women in a gov establishment. I am not sure about this Lord please guide thy will be done. After an interminable wait We then got lost in the city traffic. Pastor Tammy was talking and this led to him driving slowly so we arrived home at 5.35 PM and I was tired,

Pastor Jewel mentioned the evening meeting so I told him I did not think I had anything to say and that I needed time to sort out things. I then gave him my 6 eggs to boil. So then I found the new water had been used up perhaps other guest had thought it was part of the service. We only bought it yesterday. I enquired about two shirts for ironing apparently Pastor Tim is also waiting for some. Tomorrow we go to Guimbal on the south on the coast

Week Two

Saturday 20th November

Last night I talked with Tammy. shared, and testified. He said he was blessed by my energy and preaching. PTL .Glory to God, Lessons learnt in Spirit led evangelism.; my vision for India and the value of a prayer life. The young girl came to give me my shirts back nicely ironed. PTL I have partly packed and prepared two egg rolls for tomorrow. Pastor Tim returned and he talked. He shared about the NPA terrorist. Now time for bed.

Guimbel

Slept well up 5 AM pastor Tim not about yet I packed my things and tidied my room. Had bath and all now ready we go to Guimbl and San Jose. Lord lead and guide.

7,40 AM Still waiting I guess Tim is on the cell-phone. Lord lead and guide. Arrived in Guimal A very nice Warden welcomed us and arranged things. The Lord blessed the message. There were 57 prisoners who prayed a sinners prayer pastor Tim sang, God is so good to me

San Jose

We arrived in San Jose just before 12 midday. Stopped in policeman's house to eat my egg rolls coke an coffee. He trained as a pastor but joined the prison service later. He has three children The home is very basic cement walls wooden plywood walls. Rather like a building plot you can smell the cement.

We are due at the prison at 2 PM and we have to look for accommodation. At the moment two pastors are fast asleep, its hot and sticky Lord lead and guide. The prison holds 167 men I guess around 67 or more were listening. It rained very heavy while I was speaking making it hard to speak but the Lord helped me The men crowded together o escape the rain which was a great blessing. You could read their faces easily.

The Lord blessed I reckon 67 responded sincerely to the word preached Amalak must be destroyed Pastor Tim prayed and we all sang in English. Thank you Lord for saving my soul. Pastor Jewel then talked and distributed tracts and Gospels

After showing my family photo to prisoners and shaking them by the hand. Thank you Lord. All Glory to your name.

We drove to a Jollibee bought toilet tissue and In -so- mah -dah, sugary pastries.. Met Pastor Rommel and his wife. After talk we followed them to a hotel where we negotiated two rooms think Tim was shocked at the price. I have a beautiful room air con double bed and hot water Pastor choose to share with Pastor Tammy. The manager brought me hot water for my parsley tea. An amazing start to my second week

Sunday 21st November

San Jose 7 25 AM

I slept well. Up 6AM to enjoy hot shower followed by cornflakes. While in the shower I heard knocking and Pastor Tim had brought me a flask with some hot water. Read promises from Isaiah and Psalms. Thank you Lord for a clean room and hot water. Going to have a talk with pastor to review the plans for the coming week, to ask Pastor Tammy not to use cell phone while driving me to find out arrangements for the day.

Baptist Church

Later

Pastor Tim knocked and we talked I was able to explain t Tammy how dangerous it was to be using the cell phone while driving, He accepted the rebuke. We set of for the Baptist church and got lost as Pastor Rommel had not put up a sign It was dreadful here was nor spirit of prayer and the few people who did come wanted only to talk. After a few hymns Pastor Tim asked me to say something I shared a short testimony then Pastor Tammy gave an overlong testimony before Tim spoke on lessons from Job. We returned to Rommel's house to meet Jeremiah and partake of mashed potatoes and tomato omelet.

Amazing and wonderful.

I talked to Rommel about prayer and church discipline. He asked me to pray for him

Before we left Pastor Tim was teaching Now back at hotel 2 20 PM. Heavy violent downpour Wow.

Monday 22nd

Awake 5 AM up at 5,15 o prepare all ready by 6AM

Now 6,35 Lord commit this day to you. Lead guide guard direct, Thy will be done

Save souls for thy Glory Later I went around and knocked on Tim's door Tammy told me pastor Tim had suffered an asthma attack. ? !!!

Last night Tammy had been to the pharmacy and he had advice seeing a doctor and using a defoliator was shocked and came to my room to pray. Lord what to do.

Culius

Later

Tim turned up and I prayed for him. We checked out at 7.10 AM and set off for Culius The guards called the men, The word went forth with Tammy translating ,The Lord helping us. On appeal nearly 50 men responded and accepted the Lord Jesus as their Savior, PTL.

It was nearly12 Midday when we arrived in a barangay called Zansibar. Pastor Tim had been told he could have a Bamboat free as the Chinese's owner had been defrauded in business and wanted Tim to have. As it was it turned out to be a wreck, It was very hot so as Tim talked I took off my shoes and had a paddle. so we returned to the car.

We arrived in Kalibo city at 1 30PM.Its very hot Looks like an open air meeting. Then a small hut was pointed out. The prison holds 140 men and 15 women Again Tammy translated and 40 responded to the word. PTL

Tim had decided to press on to Roxas city the capital of the province of Capiz,.He started to drive as if possessed. So fast and made some basic errors. I had to speak with him ad asked him to slow down. Pastor Tim took over but was assailed by fits of coughing. His asthma retuning. Strangely enough his driving was unusually poor and we had one or two near misses.

We eventually arrived in the city. We had stopped to ask the ay and before starting off again I set lets pray. I asked for a resting place and hp for Pastor Tim. Within minutes' we had stopped outside a hotel and I had a room then Tim enquired where is a hospital and was told just down the road.

So I am booked in and they have gone to hospital Lord wisdom Later I go up to see i anyone has come back, Pastor Tammy is t the desk We talk He tells me that pastor Tim is OK but has been admitted to hospital for the night. DV we will continue I the morning I tell him how awful my room is so the hotel decide to change it. So we re pack my unpacking and I am installed in room 322,, Tammy takes me to an internet cafe where I send urgent prayer request for prayer for pastor Tim. I then visit him in hospital and pray for him. I return to my room and have a shower. Its now 9,30 I need to rest Good night Praise God 690.have responded to the Gospel Hallelujah.

Tuesday 23rd Awake 3AM

dozed until 6AM After cornflakes repacked sorted case. Wondering what the day will bring .

1/ Abort the mission take Pastor Tim back to San Carlos

2/ If Pastor Tim is to stay in hospital then Pastor Tammy and I will visit local jail

3/ Preferred option Pastor Tim is well we continue our schedule later, Lord thy will be done

Mambsusa Prison Back to Top

7.25AM Tammy arrived at 8am 8.30 we go to Mambusa Prison to preach Pasort Tim hopes to be discharged from hospital at 11 AM DV we then preach in San Hosea, Roxas city and proceed to catch a ferry to Bacolod City back on Negros Island DV we will then go as scheduled from prison to prison and work our way to San Carlos Thank you Lord. Pastor Tammy estimate that .the Lord will save a1000 souls.

Roxas City

Drove back to Roxas City passing the hotel Thick traffic high fumes. Found Pastor Tim still connected up to tubes. He is due to be discharged at 2PM We rushed back to hotel to check out P1.200 Now in Jollibee Lord mercy. Hallelujah. All glory to God

This impossible with menial things are possible with God. 690 Saved each one precious to the Lord;

Mambusio Prison.34 Amazing and wonderful Guards open hospitality

We returned to find pastor Tim was still hooked up He said to come back at 2 PM. We had to race to the hotel before 12 to check out then we found a Jollibee did some shopping sent an email and returned at 1. 35to find Pastor Tim

He was off the drip tubes but waiting for the bill. It had been delayed so we were sent off to conduct a meeting at San Hosea jail. Around 70,or more prisoners gathered plus others in the ladies section. and yet more listening inside.

The response was overwhelming amazing.. The guards told me when I was leaving this message aught to be told in every prison. Hallelujah Glory to God.

Now Lord please guard us and guide us safely to Bacolod this evening Pastor Tim said he had phenomena one lung very weak. We go to Bacolod tonight but tomorrow to San Carlos as Pastor Tim is weak. Lord wisdom. 4.05 PM just filled with petrol and setting off. 690 Souls plus,132=822, All glory to God.

Damangus

Just arrived in the port of Damangus. Its 6.50PM .The ferry is due to depart at 8.PM it has taken nearly three hours. Praise God or safety

7. 45 PM Safely aboard. PTL I saw the crew trying to catch or kill a rat stamping on it

Pastor Tim bought 3 boiled egg I had to bread rolls and a banana. So I have had a good supper.

I talked with Pastor Tim His medical ill was P8.000 promised him the change from my £50 if there is any left.

He said he would arrange a pastors conference and a meeting with students, DV Two prisons tomorrow.

Pastor Tim will rest .Tammy will be my translator.

So Lord thank you for the precious ministry on Panay Island. Glory to God. Pastor Tim said I will be staying at his home in San Carlos apparently he has a guest room which used to be Bethels his daughters. He also said tonight we go to pastor's place. You have a big room and I will sleep on the floor. I will rest on Saturday DV as Pastor will be away

Bacolod.

Arrived 9. 25 PM a smooth crossing we drove to a rooming house, it took ages. You could immediately tell it was a dump. They did not have hot water and the rooms began a p250 I was disgusted and told pastor so. All this so he can save the money I gave him. They then drove across the town and brought me to this dreadful place. Its tatty and filthy dirty Oh God please help me.

Wednesday 25th

A rotten night I was awake almost every hour. I slept in my clothes. Urgg this place is an insult. Got up 5.15 tried to wash I managed to shave an wash with a hot flannel before the water failed completely. No sleep, no water.

Re packed and all now ready I went downstairs to find Tammy sitting there. Pastor Tim said he w going home and that Tammy was to be my translator. I prayed a blessing on Pastor Tim We gathered my cases and set out for the prison. I asked Tammy to stop and we talked over events and Jeremiah 9 Re Covetous Pastors from the least to the greatest the prophet to the priest We then proceeded to the prison.

At first it looked as though the door was shut. The assistant warden talked of activities already scheduled. His plans to retire in two years and prayers to start prison evangelism

Gradually he warmed to us and we were offered coffee. We met the Warden and were polite.

Victoriana's Prison <u>Back to Top</u>

Then the door was opened, An amazing sight The prison holds 520 men and around 150 -200 men -hard to say responded On to Baptist church where i met several pastors some from Luzerne..The senior pastor wife cooked me omelet and mashed potatoes. Pastor Ricky took my www as others

Bacalod Prison

Relaxed before heading for Bacolod city jail where 80 responded to the ord. There was real deep warmth from most all as I shook them by the hand. Wonderful sensitive Warden, We talked with him had coffee while we waited for the men to gather. Another wonderful meeting .820 plus 150=970 plus 80=1030, Glory to God

Thank you Lord 2,40 PM

Now at Tammy's house. He showed me his church and I met Eden his wife and Gideon his 19 year old son

The Barangay is very very poor. We waited as his wife Eden packed his clothes. I took a photo off them together with son Gideon.

San Carlos City <u>Back to Top</u>

We then set off to San Carlos across the mountains They are both exhilarating and spectacular. Arrived safely after a lovely drive at 5,50, Pastor Tim was waiting and was warm towards me. He has booked me a wonderful room Thank you Lord we are making progress. Hallelujah.'

I had a hot shower organized parsley tea changed into clean clothes and almost fell asleep on the bed.

Tim came at 6,50 and I met Nida and ate supper of mashed potato and cold omelet. It was very nicely flavored. Returned early as I nearly fell asleep on the bed. How wonderful my room. What contrast with yesterday. I think my warning to Pastor Tim has had some effect.

Thursday 26th.November

Pick up at 7.45AM for breakfast.

Slept well rejoicing and thanking the Lord for my clean room. Rejoicing for all the Lord has done saving souls. Keeping us safe; providing blessing; His Word. There are no, words to describe .amazing and wonderful response of these hundreds of prisoners.

Some thoughts about supporting pastor Tammy. I was deeply affected when I visited his home and Brangay. He is active in street preaching as well as pasturing his church.

Now Lord grant me wisdom as I enter this third week. Keep me safe strengthen and heal my heart and guide me safely home to my family; in Jesus name breakfast at 8 AM.I wonder what it will be?

Escalante

Going to Escalante dropping off Nida at pastors conference and then on to two prisons. DV Slight diarrhea this morning so I took tablet and asked Nida for my plate to be washed in boiling water and cutlery

Escalante Prison

A teacher gave up his lesson time so that we could preach .I had emphasized how important it was to get the book ;read it; believe it; obey it; and then God would bless When we concluded and after prayer. a man came and asked me if he could have the Bible that was on the table I called Tammy who immediately gave his Bible to the man .We promised we would obtain bibles and Tammy would return to take a bible study.

Sagai City Jail

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As were very near to Sagai City we drove the 9 km quickly we arrived at 11.25 AM thinking to start the meeting before the men had their dinner. The guard was a Christian and readily agreed for us to have our meeting. The Lord blessed His word and once more the response was overwhelming with 80 saved. Accepting Jesus as their Lord and personal Savior, Glory to God 1083+80=1163

We found place to have lunch and took Nida and another family back to their home.

I arrived in my room after 3 30 to take a hot shower and dozed on the bed. Another wonderful day. Tammy will come to pick me up at 6,30PM I had requested egg and chips Lord.

Later

I went out to find some coffee strips I was just returning when Tammy bibbed the car horn. Had egg and chips and sent email; Rather shocked when I observed Pastor Tim's house. Mostly plywood and rather crudely constructed. Very much in the Hucklberry Finn style. I invited Tammy to my place to talk.

I believe the Lord will use him in prison ministry. I was prompted to give him $\pounds 100 \ p6700$. He was deeply moved near to tears. He told me his daughter Jemmima had needed p5600 for her college fees next Wednesday. So the Lord had prompted ne aright

We discussed him coming under the banner of Daily Bread Mission Philippines. For Prison Evangelism He is to buy bibles for two prisons p160 and an internet connector p1.000 so he can send emails. Lord I commit this work to you in Jesus name. Use Pastor Tammy mightily for saving of souls, DV Tomorrow we go to three prisons. Pastor Tim is joining us in the first and Nida will come with us to the other two Tammy will return to Bocalod by Ceres Liner. Lord thank you for him bless him and give him a harvest of souls.

Friday 27th November

A better night. troubled by an irritating cough last evening fought it with Tyrosett.A little better this morning . Hot shower clean clothes; Cornflakes; Down to ask for boiling water ;made Parsley tea DV This time next week I will be on my way home.

Three prisons today. Lord thy will be done Pastor came at 835 we were quickly at the prison I was amazed at the cleanliness. Beautiful.

The warden gathered all 137 inmates and brought them before the chapel They listened and responded to a man. It was amazing to see the men rushing struggling to obtain a Bible

Polisimosa Jail

Later

We returned to Tim's home and obtained more Bibles. before setting off for Polimosa City Jail The drive up and around the mountains was breathtaking the best of the journey. I remember this prison from last year . A wonderful response from the 24 plus prisoners amazing Bibles were distributed. Into eager hands The warden was well pleased said come again.

Polissimo Prison 2

Then on to prison where there were 67 prisoners Again they listened carefully and after the message took bibles Glory to God 1163+137+24+67=1391

We found a place to eat sitting at a table with a wobbly leg It was cool because of the high altitude then cruised down the mountains which were beautiful.' I am going for supper at 7pm Potatoes tomatoes and eggs I have no idea what is planned after a day of rest tomorrow. Brother Tammy came early. Apparently my food was hot. Actually time I got there it was cold. I sent Karen an email Pastor Tim said we go on Monday to two jails and perhaps two jails on Tuesday

Saturday 27th November

I rested in bed till after 7AM Hot shower cornflakes then reviewed, Word for tomorrow Prayer-Obedience-Faith- Sacrifice Thy will be done Later

I occupied myself with tidying my things making the bed and sorting my case. Around 9,30M I walked to Nida's home. It was already hot . She set the fan blowing and we talked. Suddenly she was in tears as her daughter Bethel is now married and living in Florida and her son Kim is now in Toronto..

She is missing them and what with Tim being ill and the situation with home she is under a lot of pressure.

Later I sent a lot of Praise and thanks giving emails and then went downstairs to witness the children being fed. Around 30 slum children after memory verses and lessons enjoy a meal. Apparently many of them are neglected by their parents. Upstairs good things are happening.

A smell of frying potatoes and yes English style fried eggs. Marie puts some tomatoes lettuce and cucumber so I enjoy my best meal. Thank you Lord. Pastor Dominick comes in and I share testimony of India and revival meetings. Marie has washed my clothes and cooked I think I will give her a gift Must talk with Pastor Tim tonight as tomorrows meeting might be difficult Lord thy ill be done Thank you Lord an interesting profitable morning as Nida talked and I gleaned a lot

1.PM now to rest

Later I went out to buy some pastries and oranges. Pastor Tim came at 6 30 and I was shocked when I saw the old Rosko van . We jolted down to the home for dinner I managed to give Marizah p100 for doing my washing.

Pastor Tim suggested we go to some local meetings on Monday. He mentioned the police. So praise the Lord.

The meeting starts at 10 AM and finishes around 11,45 I have a Word on Prayer Obedience and Faith plus sacrificial life. Thank you Lord Sunday 28th November

Church in San Carlos <u>Back to Top</u>

Word Parable of the fig tree Rise up with wings as eagles Umbilical chord must be cut Pastor Tim phoned He will come 9.45 AM later. Arrived at church while Sunday School was finalized. The music group were a blessing .The Lord helped me with the word and several came for prayer and dedicated themselves afresh to the Lord

I was asked to pray for a man who had suffered a stroke.

The folk gathered for a meal I offered to accompany him to the funeral but he declined. I enjoyed my lunch egg and chips plus cake.

Back to hotel where I was transferred to another room 304,I think I will be here until Wednesday morning DV

Tomorrow DV Pastor Tim arranged a meeting with

the police in the morning and a visit to a local jail in the afternoon. Lord what is the message???

Room 304 is on the roof and there is a slight breeze. Also it is good to walk out in the evening to watch life going by. Pastor Tim phoned at 6,30 He was not allowed to preach at the 7th day Adventist church funeral. I asked about tomorrows meeting and he said he has not telephoned the chief of police Lord please do something. I decided not to go for a meal as the lunch was so great so I ate my two rolls for my supper I walked then sat on the roof in the cool of the evening. Walked as the sun set on mount caralola and as the darkness deepened It came on to rain. I felt very home sick and had a bad night'

This morning I found my alarm clock had stopped and that it was 6.10AM.

Police Headquarters San Carlos

Pastor Tim phoned at 7.30 AM to tell me we are due at the police headquarters to preach for 15 minutes .We sat in the chief of police office while the men went on parade Then the chief of police took us to the parade ground where we stood as the flag raising ceremony was conducted with all discipline and respect.

The Lord greatly helped me to preach from Luke 9 v 23-27 What if a man should gain the whole world and lose his own soul.

The men stood at attention while I spoke. Amazing.

The Chief thanked me and said the spiritual food would bless them for a long time. He is a born again Christian then we shook hands and left.

Calatrava Jail.

Back at Pastor Tim's home we picked up Pastor Silas and his wife and child and set off for Calatrava jail dropping his wife and child off at their home. The small jail was new and clean The policemen gathered the current five inmates and sat also to hear the message.

As I spoke I noticed that they were responding as were the prisoners. When I challenged them to pray the officers all stood to pray and also requested Bible.

One asked for a Bible in English. PTL So we returned to San Carlos City where I bought cake and oranges for supper and tomorrow. Pastor Tim the drove out of the hot city to a quiet place where we ordered drinks We talked over the mission and Pastor Tim spent a long time explaining and testifying of his experiences over the last 38 year..

We returned to his home where my meal was being prepared. Wow carrotsbeans- they were very hard- then tomatoes- lettuce mashed potatoes- and a beautiful omelet. Pastor suggested we might swim tomorrow the mission was completed. Then Vida talked she's very immature but likeable with it Again the subject turned to money and all they needed and what a struggle it wisdom dear. Will they ever learn faith?

Later Tim called the internet was ready. I answered two emails while Tim and Nida were watching the Peduyim Home video

Tuesday 30th November. (I decide on action)

A long night. Up at 6AM

I found a money exchange the rate was 65.p so I changed £140 then returned to hotel and checked out. The reception kindly telephoned the ACE pension and booked a room for two night. Then I gave him Pastors blanket and called for a motorbike to take me to the fast ferry which leaves at 11,30AM and takes just 45 minutes' Then a fast cab to Cebu and taxi to ACE pension. Lord lead and guide. I am in the departure lounge air on waiting for the ferry. Its very small but the sea is calm

Now 11 25 and no sign of a ferry Lord

11.40 onboard Its smells of fumes and the TV s up maximum.. dreadful Only P160 Nearly 12 midday I am still at sea. I guess I got on the wrong boat. Ah well I am on my way home. Hallelujah

1,20PM Cebu is in sight

Very slow ferry but a nice restful afternoon. Now Lord safely to Cebu city and Quezon Highway I am thing of jolly b for chips,

Arrived safely at 2 PM its boiling hot. The ferry had a problem in docking so we had to climb on a stanchion ad jump it was quite high and I was grateful to the four men who hauled me up. A porter came and tied to hustle me into an air con taxi for P1000 when everyone knows the real cist is P100, However I handled him, refusing, and took hold of my case. They soon changed their tune and I was offered seat in a good yellow taxi air con for P150 which I gratefully accepted.

The taxi had three of us in the back but as comfortable and speedy. When we arrived in Cebu Terminal the driver offered o take me on to Macton Island on the meter so it worked out at P 400 for the trip. I was so happy to be back under my own steam I quickly settled my room ,

I had a shower and put on fresh clothes went across the road to re stock with water and Dunky Doughnuts 'the first 'and returned to the hotel. Pastor Tim phoned but I put the phone down and told the desk I am not taking calls. I went upstairs to enjoy American breakfast at 5PM. They were kind enough to turn off the noisy radio ad switch on the huge fan, also to give me hot water for my Parsley tea. Tomorrow I plan to use the internet cafe and prepare a prayer and thanksgiving letter

Lord lead and guide.

Wednesday 1s December

6,30AM.Last night I took a tablet and went to bed early just after 8PM as I was so tired. No hot water this AM.

DV Tomorrow I go home.. Its been an amazing-wonderful-fantastic time in he prisons but physically otherwise very very hard.

But Praise God mission impossible is now Mission Accomplished. <u>Back to Top</u>

Went up for breakfast at 7AM Enjoyed eggs on toast and bacon. Changed my room as no hot water. Went across to shops bought two labels one each for the boys and an origami book plus a book for Matthew.

Looked over the store..email from Karen some flights to Gatwick were diverted Returned to get boiling water for Parsley tea.

I packed and repacked my things made the bed . I went up to the cafe and ordered an omelet and chips mediocre

I decided to send my thoughts to Tim Tapang I do not think he will change an old dog too set in his ways. Anyway I made thee attempt. Up to the roof to walk then o shop to get sugar frosties for supper and breakfast: The traffic stops for no man, I saw many planes land and take off. The noise is terrible boom boom non stop. The air is warm and damp like a warm bath Several ships slip by their lights reflecting on the water. The pedestrians risk their lives try/g to cross but often they are halfway across and are narrowly missed as they stand stranded. I have been walking up and down praying thanking the Lord for all He has done

but I have to yield as the noise is too much for me. Now 7PM. This time tomorrow DV I will be in Manila

Thursday 2nd December

A long night but praise the Lord I will begin my journey home Hallelujah. Yesterday I changed rooms because my water never got hot. Today the water heater failed. Why don't they get things fixed Dreadful place. Its raining heavy and very overcast. Lord I commit my journey to you.

Emirates open at 8 30 I am told Information was (as usual] lacking in any help The Emirates office is outside so I chickened out.I will try to obtain a departure form if I can. Thank you Lord I am ready for stage two of my journey home later

Found a toilet obtained a departure form and spied a sign at Emirates saying skywards members so looked up my number and I will try it later. 7,45PM. I am going home. I sat for a while but several Filipino re sneezing around me so thought it prudent to move. I saw a man in the skywards queue well he was first so I joined him A porter said it was the queue for ;Skywards so here I am Lord. The next queue is on line check in

Later I was second hostess came to ask me was I gold or silver confessed my mistake because when they illuminated the signs. It clearly stated gold or silver of which I had none However the check in girl was kind and checked me in.

Some flights have been diverted to Heathrow and some to Manchester Apparently they expect Gatwick to open at 6 not sure if this is AM or PM Anyway Praise God the Lord answered prayer and I am checked in Hallelujah I was first through security and first through embarkation. What a wonderful answer to prayer

Stage two nearly complete On board at last . Praise God

12,15 AM Lord that I may sleep.

Dozed feel ok. Just passed over Rajahmundry and Hyderabad. Its 6.10,nd 9,45 PM in UK

Safely down at 5.40. Straight through security to enquire at information desk Go to lift down one floor speak to security an Emirates Transfer desk. I struggled against the hundreds surging towards security nearly got trampled and after risking my life when I got there a fine sight met my eyes A hugh counter with five desks and not a soul in sight. This meant that I had to return to security and yes go through again. I found the man who had indicated to go through but he just shrugged his shoulders. I said I would complain but what can you do with stupid people. Came to find gate 225 for Gatwick .It is posted but

no delayed or cancelled notice so w will see. Lord its better to trust in you. Please get me to Gatwick on time to meet my Sheila. In Jesus name.

7,45 AM Just boarded. Still no flight

8,45AM.A half an hour delay due to gridlocked traffic. The captain said flight is to Gatwick so Lord lead and guide

9.40 GMT over Bucharest Altitude 38,000 feet Ground speed 463mph Time to London 2.25

Wonderful Praise the Lord I wonder if anyone will meet me.50 #minutes' We are due to land at Gatwick 12 20 PM .Its 5 degrees below. Wow. Hope someone has brought my winter coat.

The passengers went very quiet as we approached Gatwick and started to descend. Some had the camera on below the plane and I could see the snow white fields and countryside. However soon both the forward camera and below became just white as we entered low cloud and then white fog. We descended lower and lower. I was deep in prayer as I realized how dangerous this was. Suddenly and within just a few hundred yards of the runway the runway appeared and we landed with a precision that just leads to admiration. A perfect landing on instruments.

Praise the Lord

It took a long while before we were at the unloading bay We trundled into baggage and began our wait for the luggage. I telephoned home and Gary informed me that on the internet they said there was a train leaving Victoria every half an hour but not going to Polegate but on to Lewes. Apparently there was a link from Brighton to Polegate.

My case appeared and I opened it to take out another shirt and my towel which I thought would make a sort of scarf. Praise God there were no customs men in sight and I found myself waiting in the freezing cold for the overhead rail link to South Terminal and the station. Only one rail link was working and I saw three or four men chipping away at the frozen rail as we arrived in the South Terminal Finding my way to the station t he ticket clerk

I trundled my case down to platform three and joined the forlorn group of cold travelers waiting. It was very very cold After some time I entered a waiting room where there was a little heat. The folk had been waiting for over an hour and the indicator board kept adjusting the expected time to another longer delaty. Eventually a train arrived brim full Many passengers had to disembark before others deep in the train could alight.

The journey to Brighton was interesting as we were jammed together like sardines. At every stop folk had to get off and allow others to get off before we all re boarded and then even more folk got on.. At Brighton there was a mad scramble for the Polegate train the only other train in the station and the doors were repeatedly opened to allow more folks to cram on.

The guard coming to chivied us up. Move down the carriage... Arriving at last at Polegate Gary met me and the boys waiting in the car were thrilled to see me. We arrived home around four o'clock thus taking nearly four hours to complete an hour journey

Praise the Lord for souls saved!!!

Peduyim 6th December 2010

Journal for Mission India 16th February 2015

The last few weeks have been amazing as I have witnessed God healing, providing and amazing answers to prayers My measly and only £3.00 which I put into the Lords envelope has been translated in £3,000 actually nearer £4,500 today as we had another £50 then another £300 from CAF anonymously. PTL The wonderful answer to prayer health wise with the good report from Doctor Watson and the Reassurance for Sheila that I was going to be Ok The two wonderful promises from the Lord Psalm 118 v 17 and Jeremiah 30 v 17 which the Lord gave me faith for have proved an amazing blessing

Then the Word which has been flooding into my spirit from God's Spirit. Every night every morning afternoon and evening. My table is filled, overflowing with the Word.

All Glory to God.

Wednesday 25th February 2015

Arrived safely in Airport lounge.10 45 AM.

Read Japth'tha and Barem Japth'har was son of a prostitute used on God to fight. Barek again was chosen by Deborah and again used mightily of God ,,Add David's three "Mightiest" All in Gods army.

My flight is 2 45 AM to Chennai

They sat boarding is at 2 am but I am in the Emirates lounge and B8 is not far away. So Lord thank you. Pastors to pray for Pastor Boaz translator Pastor Emanuel Bapatla Pastor Emanuel. Chennai Pastor M Jayarao. Arrived safely in Chennai

I was shocked on leaving the plane how decrepit and tired looking neglected and almost slum looking the airport was and after loading the cases into the car set off in them melee that is India. The city traffic was horrendous. After an hour and a half we parked up while they prepared the room. I was shocked at first but the air con works the heater so I have hot water and Raja has thought of most things.

Munnaiah has got married to Beulah who left the home two years ago. Amazing. Had a long talk with Raja and testified of the three pounds and the Lords dealings and how I am in India.

Sorted out the gifts for the translators. Raja suggested £10 £1,000 Rupees I suggested £20 then we agreed on £30 and there are three in Chennai and two in Bhugazpalli 1500 rupees£150..

5 25 PM; Raja came to photo copy my passport he invited me to the meeting tonight at thy Salvation Hall. So rather than being imprisoned in my room I agreed to give a |Word. **"They overcame him (Satan) by the Blood of the Lamb the word of their/ testimony and they loved not their lives unto death** We are going to put up the map of India and get prayer as we go from place to place.

The meeting starts at 10 AM DV in the Salvation Army church Chennai. Amazing how the Lord opens doors!!! Raja showed me the booklets in Hindi. Wonderful. So will take a short rest and later give my testimony

Later

Walked through traffic ridden streets only just preserved from impact then down a back road to the Salvation Army |church, There was praise and worship coming through the open windows

I gave a Word; They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb the word of their testimony and they loved not their lives unto death. Leading on to warnings of judgment.

It was hard going as the young translator was struggling to translate. He missed the last part of the message as I has advised them the go home and pray.

Perhaps it was asking too much but nevertheless the Lords Word went forth with Power and I believe in due course it will produce a harvest. Praise God

The |the noise levels were atrocious with constant shouting and slamming of doors. It must have been 3 AM before they quietened down then started up again at 5 AM

Raja came at 6 45 with coffee and they have breakfast at 8 AM then will return. Strangely enough it all quiet on the western front. So after prayer we prepare for the journey into the tribal regions

This is apparently what Raja had planned originally so there will be about 30 pastors in a very small hut and it will be India. So Lord be glorified.

Friday 27th February

Up at six AM; Prepared Word and prayers

Raja came and Muniah at 7 AM Coffee; Left at 9 30 AM Chennai very distressing. Took back streets to miss the traffic very poor areas. Found the place which was upstairs to small hut . Met young man Riki Kumar my translator. Raja gave a short word on he discipleship booklets and then I was asked to speak Gave word re some Churches problems. Testimonies of Ashingdon. Tracting in Hailsham. Playing the Piano in Gordon Hall. Then the one legged table **Prayer - Faith- Obedience - Sacrifice-** We then had a break and Raja asked for more so I gave the challenge but before told the boys last tract Philip Keillor's dog and the Prison stories short testimonies about how the Lord opened the door to India. Vision.

The testimonies of the Philippine Prisons. Tacloban city. Rough road to Leyte . After closing the meeting in prayer I went around to say goodbye and God bless. They were all smiles and very warm towards me and I knew they had been blessed of God. So had I. Thank you Lord. And All Glory to God.

As it was hot and the driver had disappeared we walked to Pastor Emanuel home where I met his wife and child Emanuel's father was there and I was led into the darker regions where I sat on a bed and took this photo of the mother and child.

Apparently the pastors stayed for a meal and then the booklets were distributed. The area was in extreme poverty and I was shocked but blessed to be there.

Had coffee and slept on bed exhausted for an hour. Now waiting for Raja to return with vegetables' at 5 PM My train is at 8 AM tomorrow. PTL off to Orissa Later 6 10 pm

Just been praying for pastor Raja to return. I suddenly realised that if he has had an accident I have no train ticket no money. Anyway he was upstairs all the time and Emanuel was cooking my dinner and had to transport it through the traffic.

Good reports from the meeting this AM. Apparently here were 4 Pastors from the Bible school and they thought the messages were good. It turns out that my translator had to leave at 2 PM as he was on TV preaching Out of the 75 pastors present 62 were given a bag and their various booklets in it.

Pastor Emanuel and pastor Emanuel came to talk. Raja is very pleased and both Pastors agreed with me when I rebuked a sister. 200 booklets were distributed and an exchange will take placed at one station so Nathaniel will swap over booklets so that we have them in Orissa

Gospel has been sending text about me Have you fed him, is he alright ? How were the meetings?

Well I think will turn in now I hope it will be a quite night. Please Lord

SATURDAY 27th February 2015

On the train, Saturday 27th February 2015

Awake at 5 after a sleepless night . Raja arrived at 5 40 while I was `searching for my watch which was on my arm.

The taxi driver kept knocking on the door and when we set off he was in a hurry it was terrifying so I did not look. We arrived early and sat with the teeming millions that is India

They were sitting lying and squatting Raja as is his want kept disappearing so I sat with Muniah and kept watch over the cases.

We boarded early and left on time. Raja immediately made up the bed and I slept until 12 Midday. We are too stop in Punnor and yes Sujan came with food. Our arrival time is 4 30 AM and at 4 Pm

We arrive at Bhuhpalli and Pastor Francis is waiting with Pastor David, Soon we are in the car park I was about to ask for prayer where they found the door of the little van is stuck so I pray Lord please open this door. We get in the other side and load up, As we drive out I am amazed as the roads are amazingly good. Where am I? We stop to get some coffee.

Then leaving the main road we divert to the slum area and stop outside Pastor Ernest home. I am shown my room which I suspect is Pastor Ernest room. I share a little of my testimony while Raja and David sort out tables and my things .David finds a mouse We discuss the possibility of making some homemade soup. (not with the mouse) and getting some hot water for my shower. For 7 AM Later they have a church meeting in the home usually in my room but today on the roof.

When I start this net book the curser works perfectly well, Praise the Lord

So now I will try and sort out my stuff. It's difficult as there are no tables.

Sunday 1st June 2015.

Orisa Burhbaniwsar. (Bow Baa Nay Swar) I was shown to my room, Pastor Ernest home is on three stories My room is ground floor at the back a nice bed a fan no tables so cases are on the bed and the room a jumble but I am happy. Pastor Ernest came and I gave a small part of my testimony. He later asked if I would take the main message at 11 AM so I agreed.

The Lord showed me testimony, gather church together and Mark 5 v 19 Go home and tell them what great things God has done.

Meanwhile Raja tried to get a connection for the email connection and failed. It might work in Visak. Later we both went up at 11 AM and I gave a short Word. This was the first time the gospel has been preached on the roof top in Orissa. The Lord greatly blessed and touched hearts. **Dangers of hidden sin**

After the meeting Pastor Raja helped me peel potatoes and vegetables and we made our first vegetable soup.

Lovely. Must try to get an email to Karen perhaps later.... Raja asked if I wanted to go to a village to preach I said I wanted to keep my strength for the pastors meetings which is on Tuesday 3rd February. Raja has gone out to send an email I had a little rest I think I slept dozed but there were workmen right outside my window knocking a wall down cementing I think

Its now 4 PM Sunday first of June.

Pastor Ernest came with David and Raja I gave more testimony and then asked Pastor Ernest for his. He told of leaving Hyderabad and how they had to fight the good fight of faith. The struggles the testing times the attacks of the enemy and the final joy of seeing their son go to Bible College in Kerala.

After sharing they suggested that I go up onto the roof as it was cool there. I applied the Tee tree oil and yes for an hour it was good a lovely breeze. Looking at the sky I saw One big star shinning bright in the east. Came to eat the rest of my soup and to flick through the Word looking for an army of 200 million from the east. Struggled with the toilet again how do you keep your clothes dry ?

Raja has gone out to send email and buy stuff.

I have decided not to visit the villages and to conserve my strength for Tuesday's Pastor's Conference.

Getting very tired now I think I will put up a yellow sticker for Pastor Raja and crash into bed. Just then Raja arrived with cake banana and fruit juice. He had sent an email to Karen PTL

Goodnight Monday 2nd March 2015

The Lord woke me at 1 AM and I had the Word. Praise the Lord it was a specific Word for then pastors in Orissa.

It was that fear was present that the answer as to how best witness and teach and proclaim Jesus Christ is to be wise as serpents and harmless as doves. The lessons in Gideon as to the reason Why has all this happened unto us was that sin that Israel had done evil and that the Lord sent an angel to Gideon who was hiding from the Midienites and the Amalekites

The beautiful lessons in the reduction by 22,000 who were afraid and then reducing the 10,000 to 300 by those lapping at the water. Then the command do what I do. The surrounding of the enemy in the night, the placing the light in jars, the trumpets were to sound when the jars were broken and the light shone. The enemy were completely defeated. Then the lesson of the moving of the mulberry leaves.

The variety of ways leads us to Spirit led evangelism. The tactics of just appearing preaching and then disappearing in England. This depends entirely on waiting in the presence of the LORD and only moving when The Spirit moved.

Is Orissa a wilderness spiritually? Israel were led by the Lord in the wilderness When the cloud moved by day and fire by night Israel moved. The weapons of our warfare Anyway I had the Word and slept soundly until 7 AM when Pastor Ernest came with coffee, I asked him to have the pastors pray for an hour or a half an hour he agreed to arrange this and for no cell phones

Later David and Raja came.. They stood with me to pray. I have been working on the Word.

9 15AM Monday 2nd March

Later: Studied the Word. Pastor Ernest brought in a newspaper and more coffee. Raja and David came in for prayers. At 10 AM I went up onto roof to pray, shared more testimony with David and then time alone with the Lord. Getting too hot so returned to room and studied more Word. The time is now 1 PM no sign of food so I guess they are preparing the room for the meeting tomorrow. Thank you Lord for health and strength to preach and teach. Think I may have a rest as my eyes are swimming. Later

Pastor Ernest came with Raja they had been shopping and bought a toilet stool to help me. More fruit. He told me of the plans for the evening to go to the hall and arrange things for tomorrow as in the morning they would leave at 6 AM and set up a registration of pastors. 60 to receive two tokens one for a meal later and another to receive a bag with the booklets in.

I find this all very strange however maybe more than 60 pastors will turn up I am praying more will do... Please Lord. Later when they went I went up to the roof and sat in the cool of the evening A little boy came to offer biscuits and later I took some photos

In between I was searching the Word. "Love must speak and Behold I do a new thing now it shall spring forth".

Find it very difficult waiting so I am glad today is over. Tomorrow after the meeting Pastor Ernest wants me to go and pray for some land they have purchased for a prayer hall. So Lord it is all in your hands. They will be done I have been listening to my gospel songs which has been a help. 9.25 PM.

Pastors Conference Tuesday 3rd March 2015

I waited as they were late and eventually turned up. Again I was amazed at the quality of the roads until we drove off into the side roads. The meeting was in a Pentecostal church. And around 60 pastors and I was told later another ten youths plus some women were assembled.

We prayed for my translator who was blessed of God and I started with my testimony and I was asked to stop on time. The second session was the four fundamentals of Prayer Obedience Faith and Sacrifice with the end the Challenge; Who will go for me and whom shall I send from Isaiah 6.

The Lord anointed the Word and many hearts were touched. There were some "thank you" speeches but after a short break some hot Raja soup and tea. I went to distribute the booklets and shake hands It was amazing so many who were warm and blessed. Praise the Lord.

There was one man who asked for prayer who later said he was going into a dark place to preach, He was appreciative of my prayers. The pastor of the Pentecostal church asked for prayer and the Lord touched him.

One young man, a musician gave me a tape another pastor gave me a book and yet another thrust an envelope into my hands

I was asked to present a booklet and a bag to the translator which I did and had the presence of mind to give him a gift of R2,000

The translator was brilliant and had a big smile later he told me he was so thrilled when I mentioned in my message Bro Joe Daniels as he was one of his translators. How amazing is that, Praise the Lord

So we set off to find the piece of land that Pastor Ernest had bought and I prayed. Later it teemed with rain as we returned. Pastor Ernest and Raja sat with me and they were both evidently blessed

By the mission and the reaction coming from the pastors. Later I went up to the roof and talked with Raja about my home call and possibilities He talked about more conferences and I kept quiet. We go to Sambalpur at midday tomorrow

And Raja and David return to Bapatla on a 15 hour train via Visakhapatnam. So Lord thank you for keeping me safe thank you for the rich blessings today and the amazing strength you gave me . All Glory to God...

'Wednesday 4th March 2015

The Lord woke me in the night with more words fresh from the Spirit of God and for my messages in Sanbalpur. DV It is now 8 AM and I have had my bath coffee and cake and visits from Raja and Pastor Ernest. He wanted me to come again with my spiritual messages and he said that two pastors had contacted him to say how greatly the Lord blessed them and found my ministry a comfort.

That they were in Orissa in the forefront of a spiritual battle and there was no one to help them or encourage them. That he found Raja from the first day to be such a help that he had organised everything and given practical advise. That now I should understand that in Orissa there is no fear that I could come without fear. Pastor Ernest shared with me the Word the Lord gave him in January about spiritual warfare; Not flesh and blood but principalities and powers and spiritual wickedness on high places. That he had taught his church to put on the whole amour of God A daily event that they operated every day the weapons of praise and worship thus setting free so many who were in bondage to Satan.

Any way I am greatly blessed for my messages in Sanbalpur and the other place. Lord do a great and mighty work so there will be changed lives. Who will go for Us? Whom shall I send? "Who is willing this day to consecrate his service to the Lord ".

Did the Lord show me any man wi8lling? ? I think perhaps the man who asked for prayer, A thin man dark features and who said that he had to go somewhere dangerous with his message"

He certainly is a possible. Lord please show me. **If it was him or should I (like** Samuel) Look for another "Son of Jesse" I have found David the son of Jesse a man after Gods own heart. Acts 13 v 22

Just had a time with Pastor Ernest his wife Glory and his daughter Grace and His son in Kerala, Samuel. known as Sam. We discussed their situation (Evil Spirits) as described in their Words. Glory Testified. She was quiet broken bless her Interrupted by a phone call apparently a pastor wanted ten more booklets .Praise God. Pastor Ernest shared the need for a meeting place for a conference center; I said by this time next year. Also a replacement for a motorbike as the three of them travel together on an 13 years old bike'.

. Thank you Lord for Raja. You will bless him richly.So I am packed and ready

Had a Word God is looking for a man. David a man after Gods own heart.

A man with a broken spirit Psalm 51 v 17

A man with the Spirit of prophecy A man with a love for souls A willing to give give give A man willing Anything Anywhere Anytime A man with vision A man of prayer A man of Obedience A man of Faith A man willing to sacrifice all All on the altar I lay.

Samuel The seven sons of Jessie.1 Samuel 16 v 7 Look not on his countenance nor on the height of his stature because I have refused him for the Lord seeketh not as man seeketh for a man looks on the outward appearance but the Lord looks upon the heart

Many talks with Ernest and glory

The journey was horrendous one of the taxis that want to frighten you to death however because of prayers I arrived safely at the station. Then we established the train we wanted was on platform three and we had to wait until 1 .45 PM. We duly waited and saw many trains coming and going. On one there was nearly a fight over a hugh number trying to get aboard and another load of folks trying to get off. The women were shouting almost to physical, fist flying.

I saw another horrible thing with a woman who obviously had dropped something down onto the tracks. She had her lad with her around 8 years I guess. They looked and a man looked down but I was so shocked when the load went to retrieve it and came up with his body between the platform had the train moved he would surely have been torn in two and died.

I prayer an emergency prayer and he was back on the platform safely. Anyway time passed and no train eventually I said, "Why don't we pray"? Seems a simple thing Raja went of and returned to say the train had in fact been cancelled but no one had been informed.

The choice was 5 hours on the road or another train at 5 PM. I said there was no way I was going to be on the road for 45 hours as I had already had three accidents in India on the roads'' So off they went to get some more tickets It was about 3 PM by this time and then as I continued to pray they returned and said there was another train at 3 15 PM as they spoke it was coming into the station So we quickly boarded and I found myself in the cattle truck or as they call it the general bogie. Fortunately it was empty and we sat quite relaxed until at the next station pandemonium broke loose a madding crowd fighting shouting screaming and jostling tried to fight their way on board. Actually if they had all waited there was plenty of room

Later Raja obtained a bunk in the 3 tiered boogie following on and I was able to doze as he watched over me. Arrived in Sanbalpur at 9 30 PM; Praise God met by Nathaniel Annand and Raju the music man Praise the Lord.

What a day. It was sad to say goodbye to Raja and David they hung around a half an hour to catch their 15 hour train home after goodbyes set off in a small car owned by pastor Ananad Rao (Joy) the traffic was light and as we tuned into our road there was a big fire burning but we passed by without incident.

Arriving at the prayer hall I was walked across the road to my room which was a guest room for the church. It is palatial and Pastor Nathaniel had obviously worked hard to obtain a desk light, a mosquito net, buns and cheese and of course chocolate cake. Sadly there is no hot water. However I am safely hidden away from all and sundry and it is better than a hotel so I praise the Lord

Apparently I have a day off resting tomorrow so we will see the church and set up the light and everything ready for the meetings on Friday- Saturday- Sunday all DV. So up to date; They are due to return with hot water tomorrow at 7 AM with two boiled eggs and coffee. Good night

A terrible night so hot and sticky with the fan set to low the air did not reach and with the fan set to high to noisy to sleep . I ended up dragging the bed out from under so that I could at least feel the slight breeze.

Anyway I was up at 6 AM but had no hot water . No kettle to boil water so I just stayed in my pajamas. At 7 10 AM Nathaniel and Raju came and I gave them back the bread rolls and requested tomatoes bananas my list tomatoes fruit juice and margarine. I also requested a table so they borrowed the one from the Church hall. PTL .

I don't think I need to go through the Word again but it does keep me occupied and focused. I asked them to be my Aaron and Hur to hold up arms while I am preaching.

I have opened the shutters and there is a fresh morning breeze. It is very nice here quite, there are some villagers around but I am upstairs so am not easily available. Later I will have a look around and have a look at the church meeting room . Its now ten o clock, Raju shared with me his wife is dying of cancer.

How amazing that he is here? His wife was sent home they said there is nothing they can do. I am amazed he is here with me. Apparently his family are looking after her,. I walked across to visit the meeting room and have a look, Its up on the and roof. Annand Rao is a business man who had bought the land built the church and visiting pastors stay there also he rent out apartments to help with the upkeep (I Guess) The room is very suitable and will not suffer if the power goes off . Pastor Boaz is my translator. Anyway I shared with pastor Nathaniel and Annand Rao and Raju the music man, a little of my message.

Later.

That I was a dying man that the Lord has revived to give this message. That I was now neither and evangelist certainly not a pastor but that I had one great benefit from the Lord. I was available and I was immersed in His Word while in retirement (maybe three times I have thought or tried to retire) But like and army commander the general Captain of out salvation uses SAS specially trained troops for difficult messages or situations. Those who have signed the pledge **Anything Anytime Anywhere.**

"I am ready not only to be bound but to die"

Paul Acts 21 v 13

Christianity seem to have lost this soldiers quality? Ready to fight ready to die for the Cause

I came into type up my journal and keep busy I pray that I will have a good nights sleep They have to move the table and lights and set things up also I will meet, with Pastor Boaz who is my translator for tomorrow then Gararth and then in his church on Sunday

Then we travel to Visak DV

Friday 6th March "Sambalat Pastors Conference

10 Am Session. Testimony The man

11 30 Session. Man of Prayer Obedience Faith sacrifice And The Challenge. Whom shall I send who will go for us...

Spent time on the roof. The villagers lit fires and soon the whole atmosphere was smoky with the dying embers of the sun,

Re arranged the bed and around 9 Pm I was tired rested on the3 bed with fan blowing at full strength. Later and early in the morning I turned it off.

Pastor Nathaniel brought the booklet "Endure Hardness as a good soldier of Jesus Christ". Wonderful. Also we are going to present three bicycles today to poor pastors. The power has gone off so I will use my battery lamp which is superb.

I read from Matthew 11. this AM rather the Lord reminded me **"That from the days of John the Baptist until now heaven suffers violence".** Pastor Boaz comes at 9 AM. Its now just 7 40 AM

Later

Pastor Boaz came a nice young man with a missionary wife from North Korea. We talked and shared and prayed. I went over at 10 AM to find about 40 people later more came. The Lord greatly helped me as the Word went forth. Pastor Boaz doing well to keep up. Stopped for a break at the appointed time and then resumed. There was some disturbance when a phone ran but this pastor had not been warned. Then later again several women came in with some children, typical Indian thing. Anyway I pressed on and did, **Prayer- Obedience -Faith and Sacrifice.** Plus my Challenge the Lord helping me.

I believe the Lord certainly touched many hearts. We distributed the booklets and later still three bikes were given chosen by AnnadaRao. Later also Jacob who had translated the booklet came for prayer

Raju came in to pray before the meeting and was greatly blessed. His face is always shining and he beams with appreciation and thanksgiving

We heard this morning that his wife was able to take some liquids after the prayer for her. Please Lord touch her.

There was a little New Zealand girl bouncing her ball she spoke to me in English. On the way out we passed Annandro door and he invited us in. Apparently he has been supporting pastors for 35 years. He is the eldest of a family with six sons and he is the only one who is saved.

He expressed his great joy at my messages and listed the table with four legs

So after arranging for an ice cream I have returned to type this up Later Bargarth, Saturday the 7th March 2015

7 AM. Awake in the night with more thoughts rather a reminder of what the Lord has given me in the past

One special thing for the church tomorrow; A love letter from Sheila, written before my journey began' A reminder of the Letter book that God has written before the journey of our life, His Love His thoughts are gentle. His graciousness. His tenderness .Yes His warnings given in love
Jesus said, As many as I love I rebuke. Without chastisement ye are not sons.

Later

Set out in car. The journey was relaxed and first we visited St Paul School which was gifted to Pastor Boaz. We waited for him and an elderly man came with a question about religion and religions I replied about religion being a list of man's rules seeking to change the man from the outside. But only Jesus could give a new heart.

Pastor Boaz came with his wife on a motorbike and we set along the newly constructed and partly constructed N5 for Bargarth.

On arrival I was introduced to various pastors and shown into the church hall already prepared for the meeting

At 15 minutes to ten I started prayers and maybe 8 pastors were there,,

Amazingly Pastor Raju started to praise the Lord and the Spirit of the Lord took control. I began my message at 10 AM exactly. I began my message and before I knew it the hall was full to overflowing 60 pastors' ten wives. The Spirit of the Lord enabled me to develop my message without out using notes..

I stopped at exactly 11.30 and after a break we assembled together. This time I asked for prayer and the place erupted with heartfelt cries to the Lord. Again the Holy Spirit enabled me to preach and teach. I was deeply moved at the end. **The message had touched so many hearts.** All Glory to God.

I had challenged those pastor with the potential harvest in India. "(Whom shall I send ? Who will go for me? Here I am Lord send me) Later we distributed the discipleship booklets and I took some photos and prayed with some pastors. We had lunch, I refused boiled eggs but later accepted some bananas and coffee.

So Lord please help me to be the Tony Daly of Love that you want me to be. Jesus reached out to touch the widow of Nairns bier and speak to the dead boy 8 40 PM Good Night

8th March 2015

Pastor Boaz has been my translator and Praise God he has been all I needed; So today I go to his church to speak. Then lunch with his family returning for an evening meeting at 5.30 PM

Last night the Lord woke me at 2 30 AM and I had new words and thoughts from God. This morning the Lord reminded me of **the Man of God and the old Prophet**

who followed after the man of God and persuaded him to return home for a meal. He lied to the man of God and (however it happened) the man of God was disobedient to the Word of God and was killed by a lion.

So I knew that the Lord was saying "No" to the proposed meeting tonight 5 at 5,30 PM . When Nathaniel came I told him to pass on to Annand Rao.

I had cleared up a bit and have sorted out my cases so have little to do in way of preparation.

So this AM meeting I have Naaman the leper.

The yachts in Ramsgate representing the pastors wonderful ministry. But they are joined in mud. Nothing moves the Spirit of God's blessings come in and out li8ke the tide but the yachts remain chained. The Lord is doing a new thing

7 45 AM I have been up on the roof and now am sitting in the doorway as the power has gone off so there is a gentle breeze Its quiet. So Lord I thank you for helping me in Sanbalpur Bow-bo-nes war Chennai and Bargarth. Lord lead and guide guard in Visakhapatrnam and Bapatla

So Lord over to you and I ask for discernment and wisdom to know what to do. Please help in Jesus name.

Later Arrival in Peduyim Home 9th March 20

We trail our luggage behinds aware that we are being watched and find the place to stand. Where the red blinking sign says B2, Actually I know what is to happen not some spiritual gift only this is India and this happens every time you board a train.

B2 is not the place to stand so as the train screeches to a halt we begins a helter skelter run up the platform. Pastor Nathaniel's face is showing visible signs of shock. He stops suddenly looks back a look of fear hysteria and blankness appears. This way? No this way?

We run up platform further, some poor people are in the way and are jostled aside. Suddenly we stop backtrack a few steps to a guard who looks blankly at the ticket thrust into his hand. Slowly very slowly he puts his hand into his pocket and produces a pair of spectacles. Scrutinizing the ticket blandly declares B2. Slowly comprehension fills Nathaniel's face and we all run again madly down to B2 which has been standing there all the time

People are trying to dismount with their luggage and we are definitely trying to get on Raju is the worst loaded of us all. He has a back pack and two large

shopping bags, one with a pillow wrapped in plastic, my main case and a bottle of water which keeps falling out of his hand onto the floor. He thrusts all before him, forcing himself up the steps jabbing the unsuspecting Pastor Nathaniel in the ribs and the luggage into a woman's face. The problem is that Raju does not know how to open the door, his hands are full so pushing with all his might he is forcing it to close.

How we get into the carriage remains a mystery as we cannot find bunks 8 and 9, I hear Nathaniel enquire from the inert figures lying asleep then suddenly they are gone rushing in the opposite direction

Wednesday. 7 30 PM

Just given a Word to the children, about a letter from someone who loves you; About body Spirit and Soul about my father and mother My father sowing seed and |Grandfather sowing seed

Sujan translated, I took more photos.

Raja came in to kill mosquitoes The room was full of hundreds of them. His electric gun is terrific; Talked over with Nathaniel the situation in Peduyim . Talked through meetings which begin next Monday. Pastors coming over night we will have an evening meeting and then the ferry comes at 8 AM. For a 9 AM meeting.

Having a meeting in Pastor Coffees home with his family visit the Historical village. Rest relax.

Thursday.12th March 2015

I had a word from the Lord re **spiritual battles ; Battles won Battles lost. And about Spiritual wickedness. Covetous pastors and devious pastors** A lying **spirit.** So I have a few days to regroup to refresh and re arm ready for Monday in the tribal region.

The power came back on and I am sitting in the air con it's wonderful. Praise God

Sunday 15th March 2015

Eruhmundry

6. 20 PM Arrived at the ferry at 5 PM. I had rested on the bed at home and Raja called There were several pastors praying at the gate as I left. My four by four was very comfortable but the journey was hairy to say the least. In my car were several pastors one who will be my translator for the night. Sujan will be

driving others over and all the luggage. There are several pastors who are new so it should be interesting. The place is above a prayer hall and is a large as downstairs My bed is set up and Raja and Sujan will sleep here as guards. The toilet is downstairs and outside. There is a solitary fan blowing but it is so hot here I am not sure that I will sleep at all but the Lord will help me

The first meeting will start at 7 PM and then again tomorrow at 9 AM.I am not sure what the layout is like downstairs do they have lights Is there a pulpit. ? Soon find out? I think I will sleep in my clothes tonight and change fresh in the morning. How do you wash? Strip wash with hot flannel perhaps. This time next week I will soon be on my way to the airport. 6 35 PM

Later. I sat in the chair on the veranda as it was so hot in the hall. Saw a frog took a photo for Matthew

Meeting at 7 30 but Sujan came at 7. 15 PM so I went down./ I was amazed as there were around 35 pastors and some 15 women. I testified and gave the Word but I could see they were tired so I did not stay overlong. Raja said of course this is a Sunday so they have all been preaching in their churches. Others are coming at 10 PM ferry and more 7 AM 9 AM ferries.

We will see? It's a little cooler in the hall but I will sit outside for a while to cool off

They have set up a tent for the pastors cooking and its really amazing how this show gets on the road It is a hugh thing. So thank you Lord for your help and anointing Raja said they were thrilled with the message.

So Lord I ask you for the night. Please let me have some sleep .In Jesus name

Monday. No the same night I had some cornflakes and was wondering how I was to manage when I was invited to speak to a woman and her family outside who I recognised from last year. Her husband John had left for meeting so she offered me this room the same one I had last year only this year it had a new bed in it. God is amazing. Thank you Lord, Raju is next door and I am on my own Praise the Lord

Now Monday awake at 2 AM then 5 30 AM

Started on the Word Coffee came at 6 15 Sat outside. Tried to walk but too hot Raja went up at 8 30 AM and I followed at 9 AM. The hall was full and the Lord greatly assisted me with Sujan as my translator. Later the second session

was more crowded. Again the Word went forth with power and love, There was a real deep response from the pastors.

I am sure the Lord has touched many hearts and the harvest will be great. All Glory to God

I gave out the booklets and they ran out the pastors want the seven Bible truths booklets Sujan bought a juice for me and Raja is preparing a soup. Johnsons wife came to greet me before they retuned .

Last days at Bapatla,

Tuesday

It's now 1 15 PM and I am sitting under the fan in a very hot room. Outside is worse and you have everybody talking to you

Raja came at 3 Pm and we packed up saying goodbye to the woman's family It was hot the journey home was fine at times terrifying but Praise God we arrived safely.

I was exhausted. Managed to hang on for a supper at 8 PM Mashed potatoes but crashed out soon after. Slept well and awake at 7 AM. Hot water and another crashed put on the bed around 10 |AM have helped me feel more normal I worked on the Word for tonight and Raj brought in egg and chips prepared for me by Ratna Kumari and Valli pronounced villie. I had a smile from Samuel **Tonight's meeting at 7 30 PM**

Slept on bed again India is winning me to indolence. However I am recovering my strength Praise Him. Raja bought juice which is in the fridge.

There is no sign of workmen to put up the Pandal It should be interesting to see how it goes up.I am thanking the Lord for good health, no pain no blood nostent no tablets All Glory to God

Have my word for tonight. Trying to remember words to

Let it be dear Lord let it be
I am weak but thou art strong
Jesus keep me from all wrong
I'll be happy just as long
As I walk, dear Lord, close to thee
Through this world of pain and woes

Keep me Jesus from all foes Safely as I go Close to thee dear lord close to Thee Any way I tried...4 PM Just had hot towels and fruit juice The tent is up, Ratna came with coffee.

Wednesday 18th March 2015

Last evening. Raja came at 6 40 said 35 pastors had turned up. Be ready at 7 Pm I was, and the Lord helped me I saw BabuRao and Pastor David always with a smiling face. There were many women so I will ask today For the women to sit at the back and no children in the meeting. I slept well last night and feel fined this morning Praise God. Last night about 20 25 more pastors turned up to sleep over but were locked out because their train was late

Sorry Lord.

I went to get a spoon this morning and found a great team in the kitchen Sunitha Ratna Valli all the girls preparing vegetables. What a lot of work. The Lord will surely bless them.

The sun is shining the door is open and I am cooling down after a hot bath. Wonderful Thank you Lord for health and strength No Pain No Blood No Stent no tablets Hallelujah indeed.

Just after 7 AM Lord bless these pastors Pour out your Spirit and energies motivate inspire them to Go for India. All Glory to God Later

I was shocked and blessed as I walked to the platform 200 pastors later to the 250 pastors Amazing. I was thrilled that I had Johnson to translate he is so good. The teaching was tough with many words of rebuke but the Spirit of the Lord was powerful and the word went forth with Power and love

I thanked Raj Sunither Valli Ratna and the team for all their work and I was asked to distribute three booklet for a photo shoot. How do you shake 200 men by the hand 250 men there were delighted absolutely thrilled with my message.

Amazingly Pastor Ernest had come from Boboneswar also I so Enoch from years ago and Babu Rao. Also there were a lot of Salvation Army folks in uniform Pastor David had brought his family and I was asked to pray for them Wilson came with Johnson He said the message was the right one Just what they needed. He said that he felt it was full of the Holy Ghost and he had **learnt a lot about the fear of the Lord and about sacrifice.** That they felt the heart tugs is they are away from home for two days so he appreciated the sacrifice I had made in coming to India.Raja asked me to give him a gift and I did doubling the R500 to R1,000. I prayed with them' I soon crashed out after eating mashed potato and peas prepared by Gospel and Ratna. I sort of woke at 4 PM and realised that Raja had also crashed out its now 4 45 and still no coffee. He must be tired,.

I realised that I had been preaching on the same spot where almost 15 years ago I had dedicated the Land to the Lord . How amazing. Now I must email Karen and tell all meeting now finished Praise God.

Later

Up to roof to walk in the cool Pastor Ernest wants to talk. He came up to the roof. Apparently this pastor came to offer his daughter Grace a place in the Bible College She is a mother's girl and although filled with the spirit recently is not happy to go and also at so short a notice. Its April May so he is shocked at the sudden turn. We prayed and I advised him not to make any decision let the Lord close or open the door

I joined with the children for them to pray. I related how the woman with an issue of blood pushed through to touch him how virtue went out of him. So that I was empty and needed their prayers. Later they individually prayed D for me and then later the all prayed together with a prayer in English for Sujan Raja is taking him to the station tonight at the moment.Gospel and Ratna who is now always smiling came to de louse the room and sweep. Raja is hunting for cakes and kit kat.

So Lord the main mission is completed and a blessing. Tomorrow some pastors are coming to shake hands and talk. Muniah coming with his wife for a photo session

Do still have work to do in Hyderabad with Joseph and Mary Not sure what situation I will find ?

Wed are going to have a party on Friday with cakes and ice creams for all.

I managed to send an email to Karen and Sheila. They seem a world away.

Now 7 50 AM Maybe later, maybe tomorrow ?

Last days at Bapatla, **Thursday 19th March 2015**

Slept fitfully, dozing awake but always tired Got up about 6 AM . Opened door Raja came at 7AM

I went up on roof but the Hindu music was blasting out so I returned to take my bath. I had cornflakes and coffee. Up on roof again. I went down as Sunitha was on the steps but as soon as I sat down she was off and Raja came with Pastor Ernest.

We talked and Ernest shared about his eyes should he have lazar treatment? He talked about the first time he realised that the interference of the cell phone in meetings and the presences of God how they used to walk in and out and the disturbance to those who were listening.

So my teaching has had some effect. PTL

So now I need to prepare my reports and use the time to good effect. Muniah came and has asked his wife to come for a photo opportunity later

Raja said also some pastors may come to talk. Mmmm? ? Anyway its cooler Clouded over which keeps most of the heat away

Mission Poland Journal

28th June –16th July 2002

28th June 3.15AM.

I was up at 3 AM to prepare. Sheila trimmed my beard yesterday. All prepared for Peter Barrie to come and pick me up. Bless him he was shocked when I told him it was to be an early start. Not many folks would be willing. He said " I would not do it for anyone else"... "Lord wake him up on time as I have to be at the airport at 5 AM". Last night we had a blessed time with Gary Karen and Joseph , his train set is growing and growing.

5.10 AM Heathrow airport.

Peter arrived at 3.30AM. I said goodbye to Sheila. The journey was easy no traffic and no problems. I arrived in the ground floor and took the lift to the departure lounge. British airways start at 5.30 and I was second in the queue so got checked in and released from my case, I obtained a window seat, wonderful! Now sitting eating my sandwiches.

5.37 AM Departure lounge all is well!

12 50 AM Warsaw

We have landed safely after a smooth flight. It was cold. My case came to baggage almost the first and I walked through to be greeted by Marek. He has put on weight and has cropped his hair and sports a goatee beard.. We went downstairs to the lounge for coffee while we waited for Ursula. They had come to Warsaw the night before and stayed with friends. Ursula was in the city so we talked.

When Ursula arrived we loaded the van and left Centrum to head out of the city. The engine temperature gauge was running hot so Marek stopped at a garage to check it. We checked the oil and looked around but could find nothing obvious. The thermostat I think. While we there Marek saw some nursery and stopped to buy some shrubs. Marek told me he has arranged a meeting for meat Prarvah tomorrow night at 6.30 PM. He asked me to back him up as the Catholics are suspicious of evangelists, apparently he will be more acceptable to the locals than I?

Praise the lord for renewal of fellowship. Marek and Ursula both are in need of prayers as they are so concerned for their daughters, Janetta and Renarta. They asked me to pray for Christian husbands. I was told that Marek Junior sometimes answered back to his dad also that young David had heart pain after physical exertion. So Lord I am in Poland all is in your hands to lead and guide, guard and protect

2.55PM. I am in the car, it has started to rain. I think I dozed a little.

4.55PM

I am in the prophet's room downstairs in Marek's home. It is raining. I arrived to help plant the shrubs but I came across some hard rocks, which I suspect are the foundations of the house. I left Marek to hit them with a hammer.. Dinner was Turkey chunks Potatoes and mushroom with horrible gravy. Oh dear. There is no meeting in Whenshna as they are on holiday so I go to the prayer meeting to share and encourage. Over dinner I talked with Renarta and Janetta. Renarta is going to Croatia to meet a prospective husband. I think she is balking at the prospect of losing her freedom. I tried my radio but could not get a signal..

10PM . Amazing at wonderful.

The prayer meeting commenced at 6 PM and around twenty folks came. I shared the Mission to India and the Philippines and testified. There was much prayer

and later I showed them photos. They asked lots of questions and the meeting was a great blessing. Hallelujah. We returned home to a supper of cheese and egg. I showed the photos again to Marek and family. Now to bed. Thank you Lord.

Saturday 29th June 2002

I slept well and woke at 5 AM . My head was thick as there was not enough air so I clambered up to force open the window. The Word is coming for tomorrow. I am disappointed that there is no prison meeting arranged, Marek had promised.. No open air, no prison, no Whenshna??? How sad.. Again I find the home full of needs and lifestyle is a problem.

Saturday 3 PM

We joined the Alpha course in the church room. Some were disappointed that I was not going to preach but the Lord helped Michael to lead the worship and then Marek to speak on "What is the church".

Sat 10PM- Parczen Crusade

I have returned safely from the Crusade at Parczen. We stopped on the way to meet the local pastor and his wife. Unfortunately their daughter (four and a half years old) had been rushed into hospital and so she had to visit that night. Her husband the Pastor joined with us in the car..

On our arrival I was surprised to see a tent set up on the town green. Many Christians maybe around thirty had come to support but sadly there were only a few adults and 15 children attending. Later however and during my message I noticed that there were some folks standing outside and obviously many who could hear afar off.

One angry Catholic woman came to almost drag her child from the meeting. Michael, his wife Margaret and the music group came to lead the singing and there was a testimony. Then Pastor Marek gave a Word. It was good but I felt he was teaching rather than preaching. The Lord helped me to proclaim words of life. I sang why did he care but the amplification was not very good. Three folk came forward to request prayer. One mother brought her Downs Syndrome daughter for prayer. It was very difficult and only the Lord could deal with such a case. The man who had been instrumental in organising the crusade came to hug me and ask forgiveness ads he had insisted that Pastor Marek preach. He had objected to any American or English evangelist taking part. Now he was hugging me and thanking me for the Word. I remember him from my meeting in Lublin two years ago when he came forward for prayer but broke down into uncontrollable sobbing at the front.

Sunday 30th June 02 Lublin

I awoke at 5 AM then dozed until 6 15 AM, then got up to prepare my heart for the Word . Off to church after a breakfast of scrambled eggs and rolls. Lovely.

The Lord greatly helped me to give out the Word and the I sang "God please help me I'm falling" It was good to hear Sheila singing. The lord touched many hearts and many came seeking the Lord for healing, alcoholism abuse, disease, fear, for the Lords blessing upon their ministry. I prayed with a mother whose daughter had mental problems.

Journal 2004

Sheila had the operation for her lip it went well and she is not in pain. Matthew's operation was successful We prayed much and I took them to Brighton for 7.30 AM. Returning to Polegate in the evening to pick up Karen as she desperately need a nights sleep. I picked up Karen the next day and we picked up Gary and Matthew and brought them home. Matthew seems fine.

Saturday. 9th April

We had a relaxing day. I spent time preparing my message.

Easter Sunday. 10th April

We set off for Ashingdon at 7 30 AM an easy drive. Stopped to buy chocolates at Tesco's but found they were shut arrived at Malcolm's at 9 10 and Gyslaine came to the door in her dressing gown. At church I met Bob Petley who I have missed so often He is an airline pilot. I gave my Easter message on the New Man. Resurrected, glorified, perfect man. In the evening the portrayal of John on Patmos was wonderful My camera failed again. Battery problem. The proceeds of a free will offering was made and Malcolm gave me a cheque for £450. Amazing and wonderful ! We returned to Sussex at 12 15Am driving on empty roads. Wonderful !

Tuesday 12th

I spoke to Gary yesterday over lunch and asked him if he was a brave man. He prevaricated guessed I was up to something Anyway I challenged him to watch the film the passion with me. He agreed we go DV at 1 30 PM today.

Had a lovely day with the family Matthew is making good progress now 11lb and gaining He is much more relaxed after his operation. We played with Joseph in the garden. Andrea did not show up.

Tuesday 12th April

Later

Took Gary to see the film the passion of Christ It was quite violent but very well done considering the subject. The Lord enabled us to gave a conversation on the return journey. Gary was asking questions and was listening to the answers. Told him he was under attack because of the spiritual battle. The conflict around my family. A personal relationship. The promises of God. Repentance and the relationship with Jesus. Sin as a barrier and confession as a re establishing of it On arriving at Hailsham we talked in the car. I praise God for this day. I told Gary about our concern for bringing up Joseph as a Christian He was open and warm. The Lord was at work. Hallelujah..

Wednesday 14th April.

We bought Gary a Bible and also the CD for the soundtrack After swimming with Joseph we visited Gary was very pleased Told us he had spoken to the Christian man in the post office He had looked at Bibles and Had looked at the CD. He was appreciative and we saw him reading his new Bible. Sheila had made up two book marks of photos. Wonderful Praise the Lord. Email fro Jidigu with children's names and D. O. B. Also photo of Bank book opened in Daily Bread Missions. He has received the copy of the money transfer but it still has not yet arrived. Lord please soon!!!

Thursday Went to Bexhill Complained at PC World re virus subscription but they were not interested. I dropped off the stuff at Rural Evangelism shop met and shared with Gordon Brown. On to Judith and Michaels. Shared and testified Prayed. On to home to visit Betty Wallis. She was her old self Prayed with her. Pick-nick on Galley Hill lovely. Browsed in Staples shop. Home at 4 PM.

Sunday 18th April Up at 4 AM Wrote my letters and printed envelopes. Went to church felt groggy. Pastor signed 6 cheques £643.00 for May's giving. James said Raja from Uckfield has invited me to speak

Visited Rob Gatland, Arranged to take him to see June on Friday DV. Sent email to Nathaniel re his address. Pastor Jidigu has received the money in

India, The Daily Bread Missions went over $\pounds 10.000$ for the first time. Praise the Lord.

Tuesday 20th April

I took Joseph to playschool. Karen and Gary came yesterday first time with both boys Gary had copied the music from the film The Passion Of Christ. Matthew is a good baby. A miracle baby. He has gone to his first prayer meeting. Had an email from Nathaniel He has received card and gift of £10 from Mary Heilbron. She will be pleased. I paid in £500.00 to the deposit account yesterday.

Wednesday. 21st April

A rainy day How quiet it is without Joseph. Sheila is doing her cupboards I am preparing a word for the Indians. Sent a letter to Zbigniew and Yola in Bialystok re Poland visit? Lord thy will be done.

For Praise Prayer and Thanksgiving. Acts 8.v 29/30

Hyderabad slum area. A small room crammed with around 40 folks, plus many children and more folks crowding around the door and in the street, curious about the white man that had come. The Lord enabled me to preach the Gospel and blessed with 30 or more responding to the message. After the meeting we walked through the dirt and derelict district to the refuse tip. Families lived in groups of 20/30, makeshift hovels, actually in the middle of the tip. It is hard to describe the filth, sewage and stagnant water in ditches mixed with the rubbish, no water, no electricity, cooking on open fires with small sacks of rice stored in branches of the one tree, out of reach of the rats..

The following day we congregated in the derelict home of a Christian with around 30/40 folk gathered to praise the Lord. Praise God for some 30 or more responding positively to the appeal. Later after some rest we boarded the night train at 7 PM due to arrive in Rajahmundry at 5 AM.

Rajahmundry I was taken to Pastor Joseph's home and met Sunitha his wife. Please pray for her as she is three months pregnant but has a problem with low blood count. The orphanage has 30 children, 17 old folks all living eating and sleeping in one room. I found my hands badly bitten by mosquito in the night and my head spinning with tiredness. Rock breakers.. I was amazed when we drove into the middle of their work place and they left their work to gather around me. Maybe 70 or more folk. They listened intently to the Word and many, maybe 60 or more responded to the message. Praise God. I shook hands with them all and prayed for their children, who also come to help with the labour. Free medicines. Later after rest I prayed with the children before leaving for the evening meeting in a slum area. The folk were attentive and around twenty responded to the appeal. I then prayed as the doctor gave out free medicine to the thronging people..

Visaghapatnam. At 6PM we drove along the coast road to Tagarapuualsa town and I gave out the Word in a Baptist church. Several pastors from other churches came. Prayed for many folk including a woman with cancer a man with skin disease and a young teenager with sever sight problem.

Village meeting. Travelled on the main Calcutta highway narrowly avoiding three head on crashes to a village. The meeting commenced with me being bedecked with a garland of flowers and huge quantities of petals thrown over me. Around 15 adults and twenty five children gathered to hear the Word. Twenty folk responded to the Word. Then nearly all came for prayer, I had to tell some of them (before I could pray for them) to remove and destroy their occult fetishes, obtained from the witch doctors.

Visaghapatnam Anther evening meeting in the Baptist Church in Tagarapuualsa when around 30 came forward for prayer. Returned to Hotel at 11.15 PM.

Rahajmundruy tribal region The next day I returned to Rajahmundry by train and in the early evening went out 60 klm to the tribal region. We stopped at the first village where I preached and prayed for around 30 folks. Some hearing the Gospel and responding for the first time. Doctor Prakesh gave out medicines.

Moving on to another village where I preached at 9 PM, again more prayers, more converts and more free medicines and then onto another village where I preached at 11PM. We returned to the van very tired but could not rest on the return journey as the van was lurching over very rough tracks. Several times we were waved down by groups of men in the middle of the road (robbers) but our experienced driver swerved and did not stop. I tumbled into bed at 2 AM grateful to God for an amazing day.

Nethervole Church. "How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation". Pastor John Babu told me later a young man who had been absent from the church for a year had been present in the meeting and the Word had touched him. I prayed again for around 30 folk.

Leper Colony. In the afternoon we proceeded to the leper colony situated in a rubbish tip the land being donated free by the Indian government. Nearby a Hindu temple. The lepers mostly without fingers or toes, around 40 of them sat crossed legged and praised the Lord. I was appalled at the scene. Pastor John Babu was trying to swot the hundreds of flies from my feet and from my water bottle. The worship time was impressive and powerful.

I gave my message and prayed and left a gift for a sack of rice...It was very moving and unforgettable experience...Please pray for them..

Pastors conference. Around 150 pastors gathered on the roof of the orphanage to hear the Word. We had two main meetings Pastor Joseph was thrilled as 100 of the pastors were from "Word in Action Outreach", but another 50 were from other denominations in the City The word went forth with power and liberty. Many were touched by God...Invitations to return were plentiful.

Tribal region. Tuesday 14th Jan . We set off at 9 am in the medical van with the Dr Prakesh and Pastor John and Joseph Babu. It was a long gruelling journey of 100 klm over rough jungle tracks. We stopped at the river town to negotiate the hire of a boat. R600 . We chugged along as the boatman bailed out the water leaking in the front while I was reminded that there are crocodiles, bears and tigers in this region. One tiger had got so hungry he would swim out to passing boats and try to board them, once he was successful and attacked the passengers. It was eventually shot. Kachubusa. It was beautiful journey after an hour and ten minutes we arrived at the first village, climbing up the bank 60 ft to follow the trail. The people quickly assembled and I gave my Gospel message to around 30 folk.

Crondura. I gave the word in a village's squalid hut and was told later that five souls were saved. Two naked boys were covered in green I was told they had chicken pox. Pathetic scenes as the doctor gave medicines. I walked out to overlook the river and pray. We returned tired to the boat to go to the next village but this was cancelled as the Pastor said it was too dangerous. I was told Hindus in this area still have a human sacrifice once a year and when night comes hit the bottle and have cock fighting gambling and drunken orgies... So we returned down the river in the moon light stopping only at the police boat to report our safe return. Apparently the pastor had informed the local police of out medical trip..

Orphans Home. 15th Jan. I was greeted on my birthday with the orphan children sing a happy birthday. I opened my birthday card from my case. I had been to town on the back of Pastor Joseph's motorcycle to send emails at the internet café and buy t shirt for Joseph our grandson, stock up with biscuits, grapes and some oranges. Pastor Joseph bought me a Indian suit and I wore it for the children's meeting. The Lord helped me to give the word, 2 Chron 9 v 1-7"Happy are these thy servants" and Mephibosheth invited to the kings table....The Lord blessed the Word and Sunitha, Pastor Joseph's wife wept...train at 5PM

Babaptla. I arrived in the early hours to be met by Pastor Rajaptnam and the elders of his church. They garlanded me with flowers and had carried a banner of welcome...A car took us to Bhvanana Residency . I visited the orphanage where 17 children live in one room. The orphanage is 5 months behind in its rent and the pastor and his wife Sunitha struggle to feed them one meal a day. There is no where for the children to play and the building is backed by a ditch filled with refuse and stagnant water.

Chondole village. An open air village meeting where the folk sat on mats. They listened with rapt attention to the Word. Many responded to a sinner's prayer. Many came seeking healing I prayed for another 30 folk in great need.

Babpatla. The harbour and Church.. The conditions were primitive and squalid. Around 80 or more folk gathered around listening to the Word Another amazing meeting with a wonderful anointing on "Toiled all night and caught nothing," all 80 responded in praying a sinners prayer...Some women were sobbing. Leaving the fishermen we drove into the town in total darkness there was a power cut and went to the local village. The Lord enabled me to proclaim his word, then prayed with 30 or 40 more folk..

Orphans Home. I take my last meeting in Bapatla speaking to the children and say goodbye. The car arrives the steering is very bad and the driver has to pump the brakes to make them work. A long dangerous. journey but we arrive safely in **Vijahawadda** to sit for two hours on the platform waiting for the night train to Bangalore. We set off at 4.40 PM for the 14 hour journey. I am offered a bottom bunk and retire at 8 PM to lurch through the night arriving tired at 10 AM. There is no one to meet me!

Bangalore . Ist Church Around 80 folks singing with loud amplification and drums. I preached at 8 PM The power failed half way through and we were plunged into darkness after a while I continued with the help of candles. I was unable to pray for the folk as I was nearly exhausted.

2nd Church Arrived at 7 15 PM in a small church The Lord helped me give the message. "Our God is a consuming fire" Many were touched by God.

3rd Church I shared testimony and some lessons. Many were touched.. After the word many came for prayer. One woman with some mental complaint fell to the floor as I prayed for her. An American man named Al prayed and prophesied over me.. My return to England was traumatic! Only God kept me safe.

I thank the Lord for your faithful prayers, for keeping Sheila safe. I cannot quantify what God has done but I know "He has done great and mighty things" Jer 33 v 3..

Please pray as I prepare for Mission Philippines leaving on the 22nd February March 13th . $\ensuremath{\mathsf{DV}}$

Visaghapatnam India

I was resting on my bed when the drums started and children begin to worship the Lord. My meeting is at 11 AM in Visak city church. Lord thy will

As Moses lifted up the serpent

I told the story of Loui the chain maker;

Then quickly on quiet roads into the city. The meeting had already begun with the pastor singing . I noticed a man answering his cell phone.

The pastor seemed intent on working himself up into a fervor. When his session ended I was introduced and preached on my people shall be willing Psalm 110 v 3

Then on prayer faith obedience sacrifice. It was a warning message.

Nathaniel prayed while weeping. He said later many could not look us as they were weeping.

Home to a dinner of potatoes beans carrots peas oinions.

.Thank you Lord.

I was siting outside teaching the girls five stones and charades when the Widows arrived. They came to say hello and to than me for the blanket I shook their hands and gave a gospel message. One or two had a Bible and they were very responsive Buelah told me some of the women come 10 kilometers and pay 6 Rupees in an auto Rickshaw.

Later I went up onto the roof and dozed in came down to watch more energetic.

Nathaniel went to buy more throat pastils-I had pancakes

and then we viewed the creation film. stopped half way for supper.

After supper viewed part two the fishes and birds

The children were animated. I am sure the DVV will be well used. It is a great testimony to how marvelously God created all things. Now Lord bless the days ministry. Remember all the family at home especially Sheila.

Tomorrow we go to two sub jails. DV

Monday 1st February

Another good nights sleep.DV Going to the two sub jails today. Starting at 9AM. The cockerel is crowing his early morning song

Up on the roof I have done my washing. While praying Nathaniel tells me the big prison may be off. I plan to clean the home and garden today. I asked Beulah to cook and mash potatoes. I plan to fry them. with fried tomatoes. Lord thy will be done.

Later When the children accompany nathanie. to the prison the travel inan auto Rickshaw

Nathaniel is planning to go into hospital ministry also has started to into the tribal regions.

.U The car arrived on time

The road had a good suface but the jouney too far Certainly not for the children in an auto rickshaw Buelah to me it took nearly four hours to return and cost R350.

We arrived at Anankapalla prison at 9. 50 and were allowed in without any searching. The staff had high regard for Pastor Nathaniel, there were 9 prisoners wha'o all listened intently to the message and responded freely.

We had taken the kingdom of Light Darkness and it was a blessing.

After another short journey we arrived at sub jail no 2 and once more the Lord blessed us when another 10 responded to the gospel message. The journey home was tiring but soon I was supervising the cooking with Beulah demoted to assistance.

I enjoyed the resultant fry up

and went to talk things over with Nathaniel. He is seeing the prison supervisor at 3 PM in Visag re us going in tomorrow. Lord its in your hands,,,

I am arranging thee teams to begin polishing the floors this afternoon. If they do a good job some rewards tonight are promised

Nathaniel went off to Visak While I rested. Later I organised the children into teams to sweep mop and polish the floor.

Then one team cleaned the patio and my team of boys picked up rubbish in the field. They worked willingly but needed supervision. We gave biscuits out !

Nathaniel has just returned. The superintendent of the prison P Sprinivasa Rao wanted a bribe. So the big prison is off.

I have suggested some local meetings perhaps in school or tomorrow evening inviting the neighbors.

The children are watching the creation DVD for the third time. So Lord thy will be done I sent an email to Karen for Sheila.

India Journal. 58

September – October 2005

September Wed 7th September

Tomorrow I go to London. I bought my rail ticket today. £38.95,

The train leaves at 5 52am arrives 7.30 am at Victoria Lord lead and guide. Thy will be done.

8th Sept 05

5,40am I was awake at 4,45 AM Now on platform at Polegate awaiting the 5,52 to London Bridge change at East Croydon Lord please lead and guide.

6,05 They have just announced that the train as been delayed by 40 min because of engineering works at Warrior Square. Lord.

6.30AM I am on the train It is a beautiful train so quiet; Hallelujah.

A low grey mist hangs over the fields

8 20AM

Arrived safely. The queue is terrible Lord

8,35 AM, Just arrived I am in a state of shock I am number 90 Phew9.25 Application processed another half an hour Lord you are helping me

10.AM. Praise the Lord obtained visa

10,10 I am on station

Amazing thank you Lord

Temptation comes to me.

Its very strong I can hardly resist. What is ? Using the mobile to tell Sheila that I am on the train 10,35, It leaves at 10.47DV

Lord I thank you. It did not rain. PTL*

10. 25 AM The driver has announced a delay . Apparently we in a queue for Gatwick railway station, Ah well Lord you can clear the track

At least I am on my way home.

Home before 12,30 PM

After a restful afternoon Sheila encouraged me to do the labels. I could not find them as they were on a zip disc. So I had to edit them all again but we did it Friday booked my flight £693,00 4th Oct to 26th.

Printed DBM prayer letters and used up all my ink.

I sent email copies of my rough plans .Telephoned Mathew Copper who will come at 3pm tomorrow , Lord please help him sort it out.

We were up at the deep end with Joseph. We all swam the length together. Wonderful.

Computer man Mathew coming at three PM :

I spent nearly three hours uploading files, only then I found. I was working in creating re page just uploading into create page Lord what to do .Did it work Sadly the answer is no

When I returned from dropping Matthew off I had chips and then as Sheila went to bed exhausted I spent four hours and more transferring files . At first I could not get through the password username was rejected. Then I noticed. It was email address so I typed in Tonyatdalybread.freeserve.co.uk and it logged on. So Lord what to do?

Today. Monday 11th I found some rupees from last trip over 8,000. Praise the Lord over £100 So It encouraged me.

Tues 27th

We are in the New forest..-Arrived yesterday to swim

I went internet to check my web page. Hallelujah It is up.

Glory to God.

After lunch we both dozed on settee, then we walked out We came to place with a wonderful view. Good Friday rock. We met Pam who was looking for God.

Talked about the work Sheila said we had a relationship. I said the thief on the cross could not be religious. I gave Pam details of our www site.

Sheila has a bad head gone buy tablets. She wants to go home 28th Wed.

We swam at 9 AM

Sheila is feeling the cold . The showers are cold. We visited the town walked up one side down the other.

Returned home to sleep. I went to Good Friday Hill to take photographs.

We are going home tomorrow.

Friday 30th .A bad day suffering from very sore thigh muscle A very painful walk to the bank Withdrew £1200 for my journey I prepared sponsorship gifts and sent emails update for India and update web page, Sheila told me Joseph was ill sick and has nits as do most of the school. Tonight I put some links on my other web pages. PTL they worked. I had hot water bottles all day no improvement.

I rubbed in embrocation. I started to read Agatha Christie book.

I am to be the main speaker in Mangalor DV. Emails to Jidigu as ht is very difficult to get from Mangalor or to Bapatla .Lord you lead and guide. Thy will be done

Sat. PTL Joseph is better. Slept well Worked on word, We are going swimming.

My journey begins

3rd Oct 05

I have just arrived in the departure lounge It has been a wonderful amazing check in Amazing I was up at 5 AM had prayer and coffee before 15 minutes under the sun lamp for a painful thigh muscle. I had prayed that Peter would arrive earlier at least 5 min and he did we avoided the Lewes road traffic and arrived 6 55 AM. I walked straight to Emirates checked in there was no queue then through security. Wonderful. So praise God. Thank you Lord.

Now for sandwiches.

The coffee was cold and cost $\pounds 1.99$ but never mind. I went to ask the information who told me that would be gate 47.

I sat amazed and watched a man pay £60 pounds to win a car. Now I am in departure lounge gate 47 and we board at just after 9 am.

I have eaten my bananas s they go off quickly. So Lord. Thy will be done I had Elijah at the brook Cherith. The widow woman at the brook and the raven s bringing the meat and the bread, Also walk-in the Spirit and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. So Lord I am in your hands.. Lead and guide in every way for Jesus sake

Bad News we were told that we were going to be delayed one hour because of traffic control, We started off at 10 45 and taxied to runway lift off 10 05 AM 6 hours 13 min to Dubai. Arrival estimated 8 PM. So Lord we are off.

5.55. PM..UK Time I am in the departure lounge at Dubai. I gave my Pakistani friends my web address. He has made two visits to the UK re his uncles business. I had a freshen up and am ready for the next stage .. I reckon it is five hours. We will see. Lord.

Praise the Lord my leg is so much better I walked with hardly a limp. Glory to God

10 35 AM

Just coming into land at Hyderabad

6.35 AM I am aboard flight EK 254, Thank you Lord

My flight is 3 hours 20 mins. it has gone 7pm and we are still loading. Lord thy will be done.

The plane is very full so I am in India already.//

4,30,AM⁴ Its amazing Got through customs and immigration and a taxi R200. am UK time. So that makes

17 and a half hours.

Arrived at the Bessara hotel to find confusion over my booking The have booked me into the presidential suite for 75 dollars R5000 I said no But there were no other rooms, I showed my email confirmation and asked how much in rupees.

The gave me a discount but it came to 3,100 I asked if I could sit until 6AM and book for one night The manager was called I explained everything rationally without anger and he agreed So I am the president.

Coffee was 68 as I bought mineral water. I need the water I need the bottle.. Now I wonder what time breakfast is..

So I am sitting here waiting The coffee was nice I have completed my journal updated my India expenses and I have no Idea what the time is.

Lord what am I doing! Amazingly I am not tired. That good night's sleep I enjoyed before coming away did me more good than I had realized. Had a hot shower feeling good;.

Praise God.

7,30AM I enjoyed cornflakes. eggs on toast for break fast.

Now

10.11 AM 5th Octob1r Secunderbad..

I dozed a little The Phone rang Brother Ravi called I asked him to come over at 12 AM Journal

On my return to hotel had omelet and chips ice cream Coffee. Up to room where Sister Sharon came with her mother. I gave 3500 for children's clothing ten children five girls five boys to be presented on Sunday also to give a meal to 70 children the Sunday school... We shared testified and arranged a small itinerate for the 21st October to Mon 24th. When I return to Secunderbad. DV.

Took photo I think I must be more careful as they are blurred..

Gave my photo with van to Sharon and Testified.. Sharon prayed for me. Ravi said he would meet me at 6.30 tomorrow AM And join with me in the case to the airport. I plan to book out at 6.45 AM and head for the airport at 7.AM.

When they left I went down to buy some mineral water and cake..

I must remember that I must give a cheque when led.. Now 5 20 PM

Lord thy will be done..

Thursday 6th October Secunderbad 5.30 AM

Slept fitfully awake every two hours I guess it i jet lag and my sleeping pattern out of synch. All set for Mangalore Lord I commit this day to you Thy will be done. paid bill coffee refunded. r50. off to airport 6,40am-. Praise God I am in departure lounge 7,05 boarding at 8,05am I stay on the same plane. Hallelujah. So I did not see Ravi as he said 6,30AM and did not arrive in time. So lord I am in your hands. I had the man of God this AM-.. 7,30 waiting now in boarding lounge. The security ad a field day with my case. It went through three times. However it passed ok. Now Lou please guide!: 8,30am on board at last-I noticed a plane air Deccan that was I thought antiquated it had propellers. Amazing. I opened the window to find my plane gas propeller's My oh my 10,15 safely down to Bangalore. Thank you Lord. The bland land meal was terrible heavy cumulus. The cleaning team are so busy. Again we are off at 10,45AM: PTL Lord lead and guide. Keep us safe Praise God Mangalor

Hallelujah 11.55AM_

1. 45AM Hallelujah I am in Udupi The church.

I was shocked when I found my case lock was missing and it looked like security had checked it out, I was concerned but found myself walking out to the crowds and hot sunshine. I took it slowly but there was no sign saying a hearty welcome to brother Tony. What to do several taxi drivers and others came but no sign of Pastor Sunil.. I took out my Palm but could not read in the sunlight and struggled to open my hold all as it was strapped hard with security straps. I managed to get out my green folder but then a young man approached to say Mr Tony Daly . Yes Praise the Lord it was Pastor John and then Pastor Sunil with his family bearing roses. I was led to the small van and found it without air-con but we set off after a short prayer. The countryside was beautiful the roads rough and broken up in many places and we passed over many lovely rivers.]

I meg Sunil's wife Elisabeth, Johns sister and family their children His daughter is Ruth. Elisabeth Sunil's wife cooked me chips and potatoes Cheese and butter with white bread.

I met the worship leaders and went to see the meeting ground and platform and what they call the orphanage.. It is a new building some sections like a jail with what Sunil calls dangerous men and Mad. I greeted many of them but despite some who said Hallelujah. Jesus is Lord Pastor told me none were saved..

I went to his fathers home to find more of the family and met his father who had lost the use of his legs. He was sitting on the floor and told me he had drunk to much. I said we reap what we sow. I encouraged him to take a promise from Gods Word believe it and have faith that God would do as He had promised to do. I left and we drove to Uduti city 70,000 pop. where I bought food and sent an email home. We booked into my hotel room and I praised God for His provision for Pastor Sunil had kindly paid for my groceries and had already arranged the hotel room. Amazing I had left my jacked back at the home and when Sunil telephoned his wife was already on the bus bringing it over.. I booked my air ticket to Chennai for next Wednesday

Leaves Managalore

12 PM arrives Chennai 4 30 PM so it looks like a night in Chennai.

So I have food in plenty. A lovely room I thank the Lord for the peace and quiet. Hallelujah. Pastor is coming at 2 PM tomorrow. Meeting is at three.

The water is hot. Hallelujah. I really enjoyed my bath No towels no toilet rolls .I went down to ask for a towel Asked for meals and asked about security I put my passport and money into the safe Two keys it cost nothing

Hallelujah.

When I returned I found a clean towel on the bed. I ordered some milk at 8 PM and had porridge.

Sorted out my case again and prepared the Word.

Friday 7th October Udupi City Crusade.

Slept spasmodically until 8 30 AM A dull day Lord I commit it all into your hands. Thy will be done. Had a hot shower again with lashings of hot water in a plastic tub poured out with a jug exhilarating..

So Lord Udupi Save souls today

I have ordered American breakfast 45 Rupees.

Later.

I had a comedy episode with room service I asked for the bill and had to ask for change for a 100 R note He came back I gave him R20 without looking at the money and he gave me the bill which I signed and marked paid However he crossed it out and went off. m I thought I had paid until I counted the money 80 r. Anyway we have now sorted it out

I think I will walk in the town to see what's about?

I walked to the centre . Found a shop for Tee shirts for Matthew and Joseph Bought a hat for Matthew with India on it I looked at an Elephant but it was heavy and only R400.. A bit big but lovely. I got lost but recovered I realized did not know the hotel name.. Oh dear.

However I returned sweat pouring off of me to find the power was off No lift no air con Praise God it soon returned.

Now to rest and prepare for this afternoon. Lord do a work Be glorified. The room cleaners have come to sort out my mess...

Its amazing They are remnants of an old class system...Cast perhaps. Poor people that Jesus loves.

Rinsed out a shirt and later vest and pants laid out on window to dry. The home laundry service excellent.

At 12 Midday there was a knock at the door four pastors had come to book a room for Pastor Puaulose . I was introduced and we prayed well I prayed with them.. So now 12 30 Midday I am ready. Lord your will be done...

They came at 12.50 PM and we set of in the heat. We stopped several time once for petrol once for a huge block of ice and once more to drop off a pastor who needed a bath. At the church I shared with three pastors who then shared my testimony with others. I was led to the platform at 2 15 Pm or so and sat on my own watching empty seats. Strangely I said in England I don't care if its 200. Anyway the worship started and went on and on Far to long They ought to have had the word. Sad. And this habit of saying Hallelujah.

Anyway when the others arrived maybe 5 15 I preach1d on If I be lifted up I will draw all men unto me. The Lord helped me. The other brother Moses Paulose who followed me preached with almost the same scriptures and it was powerful and good

I had made an appeal and he also made a longer appeal where several maybe 15 20 came forward to pray. Then the third brother preached on acts 3 v 6 Silver and gold have i none. Which culminated in a demon possessed man being carried struggling with maybe six men struggling with him.

Another body had been carried in a blanket and laid in front of the platform.

Strangely nothing was done s no one seemed to noticed. Now it was nearly 8 PM and the mosquitoes were active. I returned to the camp and sat in Pastors room in the dark . Then returned to Hotel in the 4×4 sharing with Moses and the others on the way, as it would take too long to cook chips. I ordered milk as soon as I got in and had porridge and cheese rolls with tomatoes.

So now Lord they come tomorrow at 8 30 AM Show me thy will for the Word tomorrow.

Vision of India Vision of Pit of snakes.. luke14 v25 26 Mathew 10 v 37

Sat 8th October 05

Slept well awoke at 3 AM then dozed.

A lovely breakfast. I have the Word Praise God Moses Paulose little book is very similar to what the Lord has done in my life.

So Lord thy will be done I have been warned not to pray at the orphanage.

Later 8,50 I am still waiting Indian time,

They came soon after

I talked with Brother Moses.

e

They noticed some wound on my head

They were concerned and brought medicine

Then i was anointed with oil the pastors prayed for me

The Lord greatly helped me and I was enabled with Gods power

Glory to God

Now brother Moses is teaching on the cost of discipleship.

It must be very difficult to follow me but the Lord helps him.. Many were coming for an anointing dedicating themselves a fresh unto the Lord.

ACTS 20 v 7

Later we share again while waiting for the food. Pastor Sunil is testifying how his father beat his mother

We shared together.

A telephone call from Sister Sheila who I did not recognize. It turned out to be Edna. Wilson Amazing how they can call from England?

They have kindly cooked chips and boiled eggs. Well crisps. So I feel well cared for..

Brother Moses gave me tape Brother Sunil gave me a DVD. Brother Thomas want to have my address.

We arrive at the hotel our next meeting is tomorrow at 8 30 AM Indian time Later.

4 pm. A knock, at the door .The other preacher are you ready I said I would pray Later 8 PM

Pastor John came with another Pastor to tell me that Brother Ashok was killed on the road tonight on the way to the meeting. His companion is in hospital; I prayed with them and after prayer sent an email home for urgent prayer. The internet cafe was about to close but let me send as it was urgent. They are praying for him to come alive. The meetings may be different tomorrow.

Lord wisdom...

Pastor Moses knocked After we talked a while. He asked me if I wanted to see a DVD, So in ten minutes I go. .he showed me a DVD of the work in an Island in Tamil Nadu. Terrible occult satanic practice and wonderful salvation in Jesus,. The Lord is blessing the Work.

Sunday 9th October 05

I slept well had breakfast and Pastor Stephan came at 8 AM with another pastor. We set off and arrived at the church where the body of Ashok was laid out in a coffin. e had apparently gone to get some ice and foolishly tried to bring it back strapped to his front wheel. It moved of course and he tried to control it with his leg. I stead of stopping he was occupied with this looking down and came to the road junction where he hit a lorry on the side breaking his neck.

I prayed with pastors re the meeting. Once again we had two speakers. The Lord gave me a word so I determined I must give it.. The worship time was almost a dirge with so many people weeping including the pastor who was leading it,. Then three of four folk more folks came to speak. I gave my word and was followed by Pastor Paulose Moses.

We then had an hour while people came to view the body. It was chaos really no one knew what was happening. They delayed the funeral so others could come At one stage I decided to move because of the smell. At last we set off at *1 10 PM* and made a convoy using the speakers to broadcast the message. Stopping at key places where Ashok was known. They invited people to come and view the body and then gave out the gospel. I was very effective and only the Lord could have arranged it. Man put out the chairs which were left empty but God arranged a evangelistic meeting where hundreds heard the Gospel with power. A dead body attracts a crowd even if they are morbidly curious.

The Lords ways are strange indeed. We proceeded down a rough track bumping all over the place and the track became really rough until we came to the graveyard. A small clearing in the trees.

At the graveside again it was chaos the mother and brothers weeping and touching the body. Weeping is infectious.

At last the broke the mothers hand free and covered the bodies face and he was lowered into the grave. Pastor Paulose prayed and gave a short message we all three earth in and then started to make our way back.

I was invited to return in the 4 x 4 which was pleasant ',After a return to the church to Pray and pick up my bag we set off again stopping to refuel with petrol. Then PTL the driver switched on the Air con. I was soaked to the skin wet through trousers to underclothes and must have been smelling. So as soon as I entered my room I stripped off and washed. So Brother Paulose and his son in law are returning to Mangalor after their meal. Pastor Sunil said he would visit me in the hotel I need water and I need to send emails if at all possible.

Lord lead and guide So I believe I will preach tomorrow again. DV I have How shall we escape if we neglect so great Salvation and Our God is a consuming fire.. Lord you choose.

So the arrangements have been difficult as I believe pastor Sunil had invited one too many a preacher which is not fair to anyone. However with grace and patience we have the victory. Glory to God Souls have be1n saved..

Now Lord some food ???

Yes all things are possible Plain omelet and two portions of finger chips. Thank you Lord

While eating Pastor Paulose arrived and gave me Clive Cooks phone number in Essex.

Pastor Paulose asked for prayer and while I was praying for him his driver came for prayer and the room service arrived with my change. My chips were getting cold,

So now I am watching the news from Pakistan where there has been another earthquake with estimated 19,000 dead also Mexico in flash floods.

Now it is 4 30 PM.

There was a knock on the door and whole crowd of folk came in. Pastor Donald wanted me to record a testimony on his small video. The two subjects were what is praise What is worship What about healing. On the spot without any thought or prayer I did my best.

When I had prayed for them all I ordered poor pastor Sunil to go home to sleep He was dead on his feet. Pastor Stephan stayed with a brother from Mysore. We walked to the internet cafe and I sent a reply to Karen's email also to Jidigu and Nathaniel .

I took the opportunity to check my web page It was there but took a while to load. But Praise God its there. Donald went out to buy water for me. So now for some supper some milk DV.

So now its 7 PM The meeting tomorrow is from 10 AM to 3.PM

Well that's what they tell me but in the real world anything can happen.

Monday 10th October

Mangalor. Slept well. Awake 6 30 am Had breakfast The news is thousands dead in Pakistan Many trapped alive.

Satan has millions trapped alive in sin and degradation.

Have word Last days. A happy man Naaman. Dynamite. Lord thy will today. let your Word go forth with Power and love Lord a harvest of souls. in Jesus name. Later

I sent some washing to be done A lovely Christian came Praise God, Now 9 AM will they be on time

'Later.

1010 AM no sign of anyone. Lord

Later.

10.20They arrive a second man is dead The man who was brought violently struggling to the meeting ad prayed for casting out demons

Lord what is this,,

So now they have been recalled to the hotel over room numbers or LORD III Wisdom and discernment are needed

1045AM I am in the government hospital.

12 midday- Pastor had to pick up the body so I came on to the church. I took opportunity to sing :

I am so hot . wet through. Pastor Stephen has gone to the funeral : So I wait. Lord. 12.45 PM:

I had to come away as the pastor is working them up into a frenzy.

So the platform and chairs are put away. And another body laid in the grave.

I came into the side room and managed to switch on the fan Ah wonderful...

7 PM I washed and changed

ready to go out tonight to purchase a safari Indian suit for the AGM:

Enjoyed chips and omelet

Stephan came at 8 10 PM with four others. We went to the shop which was quiet near. It was good I choose a dark colour and got measured up The price was shocking R2,900 plus stitching.

So I was measured up with laughter I was fun. I paid R1000. for a deposit and must return tomorrow for a fitting then pick it up at 9 PM or so.

So thank you Lord .

Now 9 40 PM. They are coming at 10 30 AM 11 AM.

I think they are just getting to know me.

Tuesday 10th October

I slept until 3 30 AM then dozed fitfully until 6 540 Am Up 40 bath in hot water then a class of milk and finished my cornflakes. Another sunny day News from Pakistan 30,000 now dead. British teams are finding people alive. My room is a mess Tomorrow I go to Chennai and Bapatla.

Later 1130 I have spent a quiet morning here searching the Word. I went to the internet cafe but it was a disaster twice I attempted to log on and in the third attempt the power failed.

I returned to find my beds being changed. and still no sign of Stephan. I wonder if they are at the mortuary.:

Later.12,15 today it is an aids patient suddenly admitted to hospital

Lord what is this-

4.55PM.

Just returned from the church. Amazing scenes as the Lord blessed. Our God is a consuming fire. .Seven fires

I did not know that Brother Robinson was listening in and agreed with my message.. Later over lunch he asked me if I was visiting Chennai.

After I had given the message I was thanked and then said goodbye to all the pastors shaking their hands and then the sisters There was a wonderful warm response so I was encouraged. This was appreciated and we took some photographs.

Pastor Sunil took me to the tailors who gave me a fitting The suit is wonderful Thank you Lord. I testified to the tailor and Pastor Sunil shared the trajic circumstances of Ashoks death.

Sunil picked up some photographs of Askok a fine strong man. What a waste.

It has started to rain and this has cool down. Jidigu telephoned re arrangements for Chennai. We go on a cancel list for the train at 10 pm if this is not available we go at 5 AM on an air con car seat to Baptala and arrive estimated 12 noon.

I went down to recover my Money and passport. I enquired how much a taxi to Mangalor airport R650. I do hope they remember to use English time tomorrow, My new suit is due to be delivered at 9 PM tonight. It is beautiful Thank you Lord. *Wednesday 12th October.* Lord lead guard and guide me to Bapatla.

It was 8.4 hen the knock on the door came Yes Pastor Sunil and English time. We prayed together and set off to see the brother in Hospital who was suffering from aids. I prayed for him and then with the mother outside as she was distressed. They had not told him that Ashok had died... Pastor was dropped off and we proceeded to Mangalor I tried go take a video of the traffic and may have succeeded. Arrived

at the airport 10 40 Went through security and checked my case...Now to wait until 11.5p AM for boarding

thank you Lord.. Praise the Lord...

It is another propeller plane as I am told the runway i a short one. I guess the plane can take off in such a small space

I asked stewardess for bland food she gave me bananas and biscuits-Ah well certainly I could not eat what was standard fare.

On coming in to land the plane dropped suddenly in an air pocket

Someone screamed it was quite a jolt only the Lord kept us safe

3,30PM On board PTL: I was first away amazingly, but f course the plane was already half full. So Lord another stage. Hallelujah later

.Later..11.10.AM .

I am in departure lounge I was stopped again by securing for my case and also my hand luggage but the staff were very friendly

Must change my shirt. 130pm safely in Bangalore. As I came out I remembered my last arrival when there no one to meet me. Only a crooked taxi driver and how the Lord led me to Pastor Jackson's meeting

.So the next leg ;is Chennai DV:

Later

.2,pm .I am through security again. It is 2,05M: The noise has been unbelievable and no air con in the departure lounge. I looked at some Elephants but none were decorated with enough sparkle.

Lord lead and guide

Pastor Sunil Elisabeth Miracle. and Rachel

4,50PM

We are in the bus its raining hard

The rain is teaming down I am sitting in the air con waiting room. upstairs at Chennai railway station.. it is pandemonium. The city is flooded awash with water ad crazy traffic.

Amazingly I asked. if we were near the L.E.F. headquarters? Yes, we had got lost then stopped to ask and found that we were within 50 yards distance of the building. I met John Raju and spoke with Grenalah on the phone. Bro Joe wass not due for two hours so I decided it best we go to the station. It is now 6,20PM I have three hours to go.

7pm. Jidigu brought me a coffee the went off to confirm the tickets I sat and waited suddenly the people were moving jumping up and collecting their things . They had been sitting on their cloths but the place a was slowly flooding

I had to abandon my seat ad escape .The whole floor is under water and most people are paddling

Jidigu retuned and I took off my shoes and socks to paddle out and down the stairs to the rest room which we have rented for two hours. Jidigu has gone for coffee and a bun

It is so quiet here and dry I have bed and I can rest. Hallelujah Glory to God.

8.45PM I dozed fir a while but it is amazing how inconsiderate people are with their musical cell phone.

So my train is the night sleeper arriving at Bapatla at 5 AM: DV

At least Jidigu will know where we are? .

He tells me that he has booked the new buildings n the Tsunami beach Suryalanka.

Wonderfu. 1 Thank you Lord.

9,45 PM:

The last stage abut to begin The train to Bapata leaves at 10,40 DV ???

Guess what its 10,10pm I am waiting for Jidigu where is he

This is terrible

Shall I find the platform?

Lord not again?

10,25 There is still no sign of him. Lord

10,35 no sign Where is Jidigu. They seek him here they seek him there

A strange thing has happened. About a dozen men came in to one cubicle A doctor some soldiers.

I suspect a man has died .. It is unbelievable!!!

11,45PM_I am so cross. The train has not arrived. Why? oh why could he not just come and tell me;

It really is disgraceful;

So here we are at 11,15 PM, waiting with countless hundreds. This is complete madness and chaos 12,20 AM:

On the platform its drizzle and there is no train Lord?

..12,40,I am on the train

Lord thy will be done.

Thursday 13th October 05 Jidigu says he will call me at 6AM:

.4,AM The buzzer went it was 4 AM The guard had said 4AM for arrival The conductor had said 4,30 5 .AM

So Lord .Guide.

met a guard who said Bapatla 5 AM

What to believe, Who to believe? ? ?

..The Lord sent the guard He said delay on line another two hours Take my rest. Thank you Lord

the train did not move until 6,10,Now it s 7,10AM

7,40 Bitragunta station

A name at last

Two hours to go

Jidigu came as they have opened the connecting shutters

had a coffee and rewarded the lazy incompetent guard. I tried to freshen up. A partial success.

Had a long talk with Jidigu

Ashok will go to a government college next year in June.

We are waiting at Olgoe station. When we move I am told it will it will take an hour and a half

Yes it was true As we sat talking suddenly it was Cherala station and then Bapatla.

I had completely forgotten any form of welcome so I was surprised to see all the children and several pastors waiting for me Pastor Wilson, Pastor Johnson, the vice president and all. I was garlanded with flowers and a 4 x 4 was waiting for me.. We went directly to the home through heavy floods

I was amazed at the new home as it was so big. I was given the grand tour and then I gave a short Word to the children touching on Christ within and receiving a gift and reading the book before resting. .

Then a beautiful dinner of four small omelet's with chips. Wonderful, So then after a walk on the roof I sent my emails to Karen and Nathaniel. . Then across the road to the hairdresser where he did a magnificent job on hair and beard.

It was pouring with rain as we drove to Suryalanka beach where my beautiful Shalet was waiting for me. Of course they all trooped around as a faithful cortege should... Brother Jidigu had bought some shopping so I rejoice in God's goodness.

My head is swimming so I am going to try out the hot water and bed. Milk arrives at 8 PM. No meeting with the Tsunami villagers. The electricity had cut out but came back on partially that is the air con and water heater but no lights.

Later.,,5PM.. I must have dozed.. There was no hot water so I fell into bed. *...Later 8 PM*

Jidigu came with Joseph bringing hot milk and fruit.

I talked over the money with him. and we settled that I would write a quarterly cheque for 700 plus the 150 for pastor Raj Joseph and that the 200 over from h 300 tsunami money would pay the sponsors gift at 50 a quarter..

This is to allow for any sponsor being called home to the Lord and also uses up the 200.

The power was restored so I enjoyed a hot shower well a bucket. and fell into bed

So Lord lead and guide in Bapatala. Friday 14 th October. Slept well Last night

I walked out this AM it is a sticky heat I saw the one boat and took a photo Later I saw Jesus Christ is Lord is Lord of all written on it I feel much better today refreshed. My haircut and beard trim was with a cut throat

razor and very professionally done. Praise the Lord

Now today I am going to a prison at 9 AM to arrive at 10 AM then a visit to Pastor Joseph Raj village then a rest and dinner then another prison after 4 PM. All DV. Jidigu came with boiled eggs hot milk at 8 AM and coffee/. It was dry for a while so walked . Saw the boat with Jesus is Lord of all. I had a precious time in prayer , Then we set off for the prison. On the bridge over the river I saw Andrea boat and took photos,, Then although it was wet I scrambled on to it and they kindly took me around so that Jidigu could take a photo from the bridge.. I prayed for the fishermen which was such a blessing then we motored on to Pussram Prison. We waited outside while they gathered the prisoners together. I was welcomed by the inspector and his guards. who saluted and led me to the meeting room. the prisoners listened intently as I preached. I did know that the Inspector was a Hindu. He gave me a great introduction and I praise God that he heard the message too All his staff came to stand and listen. which was wonderful. I believe that many responded positively so all glory to God .

We returned in the rain and now I wait for my dinner soup of the day followed by egg and chips. Praise God. This afternoon we go to the village and meet pastor Joseph Raju and then at 4 PM to the Bapatla prison again.

Lord save souls in Jesus name ...

1.15..Enjoyed my dinner two eggs fried tomatoes cabbage and onions

Talked over with Jidigu some thoughts for preparations for the trustees meeting The vice president to report on welfare of children Education health.

The treasurer report.

Brother Johnson of their spiritual welfare...Suggest that they keep minutes and once a years send a copy. Suggestions of DVD

Then suggestions for the children's party Pass the parcel The donkeys tail. Blind mans buff.

Spiritual meeting for the children and scripture reading Sujan to take photos.

I asked for hot water and refreshed then a clean shirt-

We set off on time and drove through yet more flooded streets to Pastor Josephs church.

Another great blessing. The Lord

greatly helped me in Pastor Joseph Raja church. He staggered not at Gods promise but was fully persuaded. there was a attentive congregation- Glory to God. After the service I walked through the village He showed me the college where 2000 students study for 4 years. He has had contacts with some

His rent R750 a month he needs electric power in his church 3000 plus monthly use. He needs transport a motorbike.

I discussed the purchase of a sewing machine for the girls 3000 and the possibly of second hand computer for training the boys R20000

So now we are outside the prison waiting

Lord grant me thy precious Word

3,50 PM

Later

Amazing and wonderful The went forth with power and anointing We had to wait a fair time but the prisoners were sitting expectantly. The Lord greatly helped me . All glory to God Thee sermons,.

Wonderful So Lord prepare my heart for tomorrow May it be a and especially bless the children happy day.

We stopped in Bapatla to buy cake and coffee. Then a quick drive back to camp. The superintendent of the tourist centre came with me to check all was well. He got the TV changed the floor washed and the trash can emptied. As soon as they had gone I had a hot shower and put on clean clothes and watched BBC news. I feel great. Praise the Lord.

Saturday 15th October 05

I was a little disturbed in the night with a bilious attack through stuffing my supper. There was lightning often in the night but I awoke to a dry morning Praise God. Lord please let it be dry for my travel to Visakhapatnam tomorrow and please let the train be on time. Yes it will need a miracle.. and it can only be done with your help.

I commit this day to you and ask for such a happy day with the children Guide in the trustees meeting.

12.40 PM Jidigu was late only 5 minutes The milk was cold. I finished my breakfast and we set off in the dry.. Arriving 8. 45 AM to parcel up the presents for the party games. Then I went to the trustees meeting.

It was very false and almost things had to be dragged out of them However I did get a summary from the treasurer and vice president. I soak a word from Exodus35 v5 35 v24 36 v5/6 and I Chronicles 29 v9-14 The people gave willingly.

After prayer we concluded. Pastor Johnson wants money for a sewing machine a computer both my ideas. Yet they seem unwilling to contribute anything themselves.. Like a small donation to start a fund.

Lord what will change them..

I went to speak to the children sharing two stories the Boys boat I made you and now I have bought you and Philip Kellor's dog Bad owner new owner sees potential then the children did there scripture readings.

We started the party with the Donkey and it was great fun even the pastors being blind folded. Hilarious. Then pass the parcel.. and the statues. We gfinished on time with cake and ice cream.

3,PM..

Just arrived at the resort. I had said goodbye to the children and prayed especially for Sunitha eyesight. She is wearing glasses and is concerned for her sight.

The clothes were washed and I brought them. As I could make no sense of the travel arrangements, they had said the train was booked for 5 AM but I was 16th in line.. Then when I thought of getting up at 4 AM and then waiting on the platform for hours I decided to ask if the driver would drive me to Visakhapnam. He agreed and we worked out the petrol R4000 and R1000 for the drivers wages..

I paid R4000 and R90- for my accommodation as Pastor Jidigu wanted to use his tithe so I saved a bit there. The manager of this resort said he could accommodate me in Visakhapatnam at a similar resort so I agreed ,. It will be cheaper.

So Lord all things work together for good to those who love God and are called according......

Now to explore the beach..

Lord thy will be done....

7,20.PM I paddled in the Bay of Bengal it was too rough to swim but good to be on the beach. I will have my supper and sleep early I have set the alarm for 3 AM Lord guide me safely to Visak tomorrow, Thank you for souls saved in the prisons and a wonderful happy time with the children,

Sunday 16th October. 05

.325AM Amazingly Jidigu.arrived early 25 AM I had slept well I was all ready Praise God I am on my way. Lord keep us safe in Jesus name." 3;55AM or first so at the railway junction.. We are leaving Bapatlal

415am stopped for coffee a man tapped on window jail I recognized him He introduced me to his wife. As I drank my coffee many curious people gazed at me. 4.45AM just joined duel carriage way Headlights on main beam. stray dogs, lorries coming head on ruts in the road. But we are on our way ,.Hallelujah

The duel carriage combined with the early start is greatly helping us . Thank you Lord I guess we might make Visak in 6 hours we will see Just came to a toll booth the road is good Later *5 AM Viggawadda. Praise the Lord*

5 45AM Accident they hit a man OH LORD**

We o our way to hospital A broken leg I think *..they loaded the poor man on and he is moaning .We have driven to the nearest town to ask directions off again Turned for Urlugu town. for the hospital610AM We are in Uralu still looking for the hospital 645AM Still parked outside the hospital waiting for the doctor.

!ord please send help

At last a doctor came. We now have to wait one hour at least

Lord thy will

Setting off to the hospital.

7Pm

I waited while they carried the poor man in for an x ray then amazingly carried him out back to the first place. It is nearly 8.pm I think it will be another hour or two before we resume our journey

Later

8,35AM I resume my journey Jidigu phoned the children are praying

Cbodhmalla

940AM

ANOTHER RACCIDENT

He just ran into the back of a motor bike sending two men sprawling and the motorbike over the drop into a village

They were badly scrapped an terribly shaken

I had seen it coming and had should a warning. He seemed to be in a daze Lord thank you for keeping me safe

Lord in Jesus name- please get me to Visaj safely

I will give you the glory

TENUKU

Rajamundry

1040 AM We are trundling along but safe praise God On the road rice drying. An old man having a strip wash A heard goats, stray cows, lorries coming the wrong way in fast lane, wandering people, flocks of ducklings Lord keep me safe I .ray 1.40 PM getting nearer At last VISAK..

It was a long drive through but eventually I made it Dear Nathaniel was waiting with

Richard and Ravi..Trustees. Nathaniel had brought food eggs chips and mashed potatoes with carrots and cauliflower but as they had been waiting since ten AM it was all cold..

The more I think of today's events the more amazing is my preservation..

Only God kept me safe ...

I am going to email..

I sent to Sheila Pastor Keith. Bob Petley and Peter Barrie.

A small problem with the rapacious greedy waiter.

Later. I went bed early Monday 17th October 05

Slept well awake 6 15 AM

I showered and got sorted out

So thankful to God that I am alive Praise you Lord.

A lovely breakfast cornflakes and eggs on toast followed by pinnacle.

805AM A disturbing picture of Visak airport under water. Lord please clear it away and any smog in Jesus name

A beautiful car 4x4 air con is waiting I asked if the driver is a Christian yes . I told him of the trauma of yesterday and he agreed to drive care fully

We setoff in heavy city traffic to the new motorway. Amazing beautiful road yet still they will not drive on the left, A wonderful welcome awaits me at Peduyim. The children were waiting in a guard of honour. It was very special.

I gave the gifts book and sponsors photos they gave Scripture readings . I took photos of each child and Pastor Nathaniel

Then we drove to the prison along the beautiful duel carriageway-Rajamundry 230jim

MONEY_OK PTL AIRPORT IS IT OPEN—No HOTEL SUITABE--- Yes RAIL TICKET IS IT NEEDED.-Yes

ELEPHANT WATER CAKE ICE CREAM CHEQUES PASTORS FUND We are in the railway reservations The airport is out of action What to do Lord

We left Ravi at the railway station as it was closed for lunch so we went change money 300___R22950 nly 100 denominations So I a transferring to the RAJ HOTEL tomorrow..

DV .Must buy some water-.batteries-cake-

Yes praise God

there is a train 21st a night train Lord please. Why they did not book it I do not know so now we wait while they queue

I witnessed to the taxi driver a kind man .

After an interminable wait Nathaniel came to say that there were no air con seats up to 26th Oct there was one non air con the 21st . a sleeper s I said yes go . Sadly they lost there pace n the queue. However after another half an hour they obtained it. Praise the Lord.

Then I returned to Dolphin to send emails to Ken Hebbon Karen Malcolm Gyslain. I heard Matthew is not well and June is dying.. Sheila is hostess to the family

I returned to my room to rest and prepare for tomorrow.

worked out my cost 35000 aprox

Lord.

Had cornflakes and apple for supper.

Nathaniel comes at 10 AM tomorrow. DV Suseela's party will check out at 10 AM then after return check into the Raj it has a pool

So we will see how the Lord will work this out Lord thy will be done.

Tuesday 18th Oct 05

I slept fitfully up at 7 AM. Had breakfast eggs on toast cornflakes

There is another photo in the paper of firemen pumping out water at the airport. There is a bus strike in Hyderabad,

So Lord I commit this day to you

Rested and prayed for an hour came down to check out at 10AM:

Now Lord thy will be done.

Nathaniel came at 10.05 and we set off to the orphanage The children were lined up to say Praise the Lord The birthday cake was ready on the table and Sueeela's was dressed up with school uniform. We have had a very enjoyable time with Suseela's party I told the children three stories the Boy with the boat . I made you now I have bought you. the black cat and Phillip Kellors dog. The children sang and I tried to teach them Jesus love Suseela

I cut the cake and the children enjoyed cakes sweets and biscuits. Brother Ravi bought me the batteries for h keyboard and I praise God that it works ok.

They made a DVD of Suneelas birthday so I suggested that they take a short clip of Nathaniel on his bike.

Beulah is definitely different. She is happy she told me she has resigned her job and she is fully occupied with twenty children but the results are beautiful and the children are a credit to her.

After the inevitable egg and chips Amazingly of I was presented with a Winnie the Poo mini flask with coffee and I returned alone with the driver to check into room 411.

It was a joy to change all those R100 noted into 500 but back in my room I had a panic where was the money? It turned up in the red Palm top holder.

I went down to swim and found I was out of shape. Lord..

Now 3 PM I am thinking of emails. The chef called to say he was willing to cook for me. I said I was full up so he advised when I go to the restaurant to say no spice.. So there may be a possibility of a real English meal..

Think roast potatoes. Mmnn

.Later

I went down to swim I realised I was out of shape but managed a few lengths. Beautiful water cool refreshing. After resting in the sun I noticed a rat Urrgg,..I thought I would check with reception my complimentary breakfast email facility. The receptionist said no I had a standard room and was not entitled to breakfast. I told her at the Dolphin you automatically get a free breakfast. I asked how much the email she said 150 plus tax I told her the Dolphin was R50. I told her while swimming I saw a rat I asked do you also charge for rats..

I was really cross when I went to send an email I found that the computer was set up for me to scan for viruses. So I told them at the desk I was disappointed.

I thought to walk on the beach. It was dreadful. The drains were smelling bad as I got near it was terrible filth and sewage No prospect of fresh sea breezes. Dirty, filthy India, I felt sick

So on my return the duty manager came the lady who encouraged me to book in ,. She told me that I did have a complementary breakfast. I was upset told her how filthy India was and that I could not recommend my friends to stay where there Are rats.

Later I went back and spoke with the Manager He was a kind man and unaware and shocked at the rats. He promised me he would sort things out. assured me it would not happen again and we shook hands... I rested on the bed until 4 45 PM when I saw the car arriving.

I went down and we set off in heavy traffic and light rain to th1 to the leprosy hospital church.. The Lord greatly helped me as I preached on Naaman the leper and the four lepers outside Dothan. Many responded to the Word praying a sinners prayer later we distributed bananas to all. I asked to leave immediately

I had a talk and sorted out the money. I asked if I could pay the car hire fee out of Daily Bread Missions as my cash was running low. Yes So I will make it out to 850. We discussed possibilities of rain tomorrow for the Beach Party. The other meeting was not possible so we are to meet at 10 AM if it is a fine day and 3 PM for afternoon or if it rains all day I will take a day of rest,.

I asked Nathaniel to find out if it is possible to find out about the airport situation To reclaim the money on Thursday if it is not open and also to try have a word with the guard and see if there is any possibility of A/C if any vacancies occur. Lord only you can do this... So Lord now for hot milk.

Later The milk came compliments of the manager PTL I was disturbed by the situation I am in How do I get out of Visak There was news of a bus strike in Hyderabad. Also I seem to be running out of money. Lord..

Wednesday 19th October..05

I slept well but awake early. A hot enjoyable shower. I was encouraged as I looked out the hotel bill for Bessara in Secunderbad charges were R2000 a night not three as I had thought. So with care I could just make it. My main concern is my return to Secunderbad on train or plane. Lord your help is needed. Even a miracle.

So now I go for my complementary breakfast.

Later

Yes lovely fried eggs on toast Apple juice and rolls with butter..

I walked on the veranda rather dirty. There are still rats on the lawn. My room has been cleaned and I have asked for another blanket. Nathaniel called the children are coming at 10 AM..

News of storms in Bay of Bengal. soon. Lord please get me to Hyderabad. In Jesus name Amen

Laxworth. Nathaniel came at 11 AM and brought fruit and coffee. We talked about Peduyim the possibilities of hiring a bigger place of an option to buy at a fixed price..

I spoke 40 him of obtain contracts from suppliers who would be willing to give a discount for the orphans home. in return for regular order

We set off for the Peduyim beach party and I found all the childr1n waiting. Apparently they all came in the one car Phew..

The park was hot and sticky and soon I was wet with seat. However the children enjoyed themselves a lot Lots of happy faces They had a boat ride R200 and I took photos of all Swings and the picnic. I returned very happy the Lord blessed the little ones..

So now I see the swimming pool and wonder shall I.. Yes I think I shall.

It came to me this AM that I should consider leaving Secunderbad early a few days if at all possible The Lord will guide. Nathananiel telephone the airport not possible today???

The hotel brought chocolates and more fruit,.. I will give it to the home.. I sent an email home saying that I may get an early flight if at possible.

6 PM

I am getting hungry so ordered hot milk I did consider going to the restaurant but as it does not open until 7 30 PM I decided against

Thursday 20th October Visakhapatnam

Lord lead and guide.

Hot shower -breakfast anther disaster . eggs first bacon forgotten terrible..

I ordered my roast dinner for 7.30 tonight so I am only eating a few chips.

I enquired for airport and was told it may be operational tomotrrow 21st Lord thank you I will go if it is confirmed. Thy will Lord we prayed thank you Lord.

After prayers I went down at 9AM to meet only Ravi He told me he is recentl married and his wife is expecting a Baby in January.

He is very shy and nice .Nathaniel told me he is very helpful in the home.

10,45 On our way to see land. the cheapest £434 per cent minimum 10 cents 15 cent, Minimum construction f7000/f10000

.We have visited the sites the second one was ideal 100 x60 15 cents;

The three sights at 1070 per cent were too expensive. so that leaves number two as the only possible one.

I asked Madan if we could proceed in stages as at Bapatla

Paying the deposit. As the foundations are laid and then the second walls and then roof and final stages.. He agreed

Pastor Nathaniel needs to consult a solicitor to set up Peduyim Trust in Visag The room sizes are to be redrawn and resized 12×15 for boys and girls rooms and the drawings altered to accommodate. Also it is possible to build upwards. later on if needs demand.

Brother Madan is recalculating the cost and I am encouraged. So Lord its al in your hands..

Had a few chips for lunch keeping empty for tonight..

12,35PM Returning to city I said goodbye to Richard and Ravi and Madan he will give the figures by email. Pastor Nathaniel is going to find out if there is any possibility of a flight tomorrow,. If there is he is to telephone and leave a message come at 10 AM I am told it takes a hour to get to the airport so 11. 30 we would arrive for a 2 30 PM flight. If not we get the train at 4 30 PM Lord willing. So Lord all is your hands,

I went swimming did 15 lengths very Good rested at th poolside.

My meal is at 7 30PM tonight I trust it will be good.

Later 4 25 PM

Praise God my keyboard is working I think it is great as It will save me a lot of typing when I return to the UK

It is one of the best things I have bought in the technology line Just the job for my journal. Lord there is no word from Pastor Nathaniel. re the opening of the airport. Lord please help me in Jesus name

I will give you all the glory.

Later So Lord there is a little hiccup in this keyboard Please let it work as I need it so much Praise God after a few hiccups I managed to restore it :I think it may have been the battery's.

7PM I came to have my roast dinner. I wonder if I am wise We will find out.

I had a phone message from Nathaniel saying no airport in operation tomorrow so that just leaves the train DV:

Lord please get e out of Visakhapatnam I am beginning to feel like a prisoner. I wonder where I will be " tomorrow."

The chef Mr Tool came to speak to me he understood plain food I think he came to talk however

The meat was terrible had pork cutlets tiny roast potatoes hard carrots.

the ice cream was great Ah well you live and don't learn'

Friday 21 st Visakhapatnam.

This was to be the day of my flight but there is no airport in operation so it looks like it will be the train. DV I di hope and pray so. The city seems to be a prison as you cannot leave it. I slept fitfully and have showered. I will order a breakfast in my room and hope to hear from Pastor Nathaniel later this morning. I plan to check out at 2 PM if that is possible Lord you lead and guide. If at all possible in Secunderbad I plan to contact Emirates and see if there is any chance of an earlier flight home. I feel really sick and tired of India.

Lord thy will be done you know how I have endured this dirt filthy sin cursed place. Lots has been done precious souls have been saved but really I feel its time to retire Starcha enough. So Lord I leave it in your hands. I am willing if you call me but would rather no. Perhaps I attempted too much this trip Lord you know..

Later 7 AM I went down to breakfast and enjoyed two buttered rolls with some tomatoes cheese and some cucumber.

Very Good. Now Lord I commit this day to you I have no other..

Spent the morning both resting and typing out a prayer report for home. It will need to be edited but it has the bones of the happenings and what the Lord has done.. Later......140M

I am in the lounge having checked out Lord I am trusting you to get me on my way to Secunderbad.

The Journey

I checked out at 1.30 received R128 change

PM and waited for Nathaniel We set off for the station at ..2PM Arrived at 2 20 so I thank you Lord for the first step

.Nathaniel brought Presents for all the family We arrived at the station so early sat in the car with the air-con on

Nathaniel had bought rolls and butter and more water plus presents so I packed them in my case

I set off for tomatoes and after an age he returned and I made up my rolls and ate two.

I stayed in the car with the air con talking to Nathaniel. He asked me for my sermons so I gave him my notes.

We went to the platform at 3,50 PM where crowds of folk were waiting the nice was unbelievable. There was no indication as to the platform so we waited I suggested that as the train waiting was not going until 5PM t might b better to move up in the stairs ;it waa much cooler there praise the Lord.

4,45PM I AM ON THE TRAIN HALLELUJAH

Thank you Lord

5PM, Praise God we are moving

At last. Glory to God.

The background murmur of Indian conversation is very conducive to sleep,, However we are on the move I had my supper quite a feat considering the prevailing space I was aware of so many watchful eyes with this strange Englishman sitting in the midst,,

Now 615pm and I notice many beginning to yawn

Lord I am so happy I a on my way . The stewards have distributed the blankets all around.

I reckon around 8PM or certainly 9.PM we will see some preparations for sleep. Its rather like a game of chicken .I had a talk with my companions they are always curious as to and why . The orphanage seems to satisfy them.

They have offered to let me have the lower bunk as they are going at 9. 30 PM .We will see.

They were very kind and I got bedded down at 830PM

Catastrophe

I have slept well nearly 16 hours us a long time Awake and got up freshen up at 5AM : While in the toilet I lost my camera Oh Lord I was shocked and upset. The Lord giveth and the Lord taketh away;

I am so grateful to be alive and leaving India.

So the miracle, has happened an air con coach and train to Secuderbad Praise the Lord

So after the terrible events in India on this mission I believe that my life has been under attack and the Lord has kept me safe. So the loss f the camera is a small thing; Also I was under intense pressure in Visakhapatnam with the Airport closed and the trains fully booked it is truly of the Lord that I am on my way home. So Lord please help me with Emirates and let this be the deciding factor in my ministry in Secunderbad.

I do feel well and praise the Lord despite my loss

Later

8,15AM Praise God I have arrived safely

Thank you Lord

Amazing and wonderful I am in the departure lounge ;Pastor Ravi met me at the station and took me directly to the airport' I enquired about flights and they put me on the next flight leaving at 10 40AM: I had to open my case to get some clean clothes out which meant my bag was a mess

The Lord sent an angel to help me it was Isaiah whose father is a pastor.

He has invited me to his home;

Anyway I have never been through check in and immigration so fast. So it is an answer to my prayers. I had to open my case to get some clean clothes as I smelt awful having slept in my clothes

This left my bag a mess. We are now airborne and on the way to Dubai

So Lord you have answered prayers.

Thank you for getting me on this flight

Dubie12. midday12, 45

Its cool and quiet here . There is no sign of life at gate 22, I managed to change my trousers and put on shoes and socks to repack my bag which was a shambles;. The

security made us take off our bets but I fooled them by wearing sandals. I believe they enjoy humiliating the westerners.
