Praying Hyde. His heart burst

It was to the Punjab that the son of an Illinois Presbyterian minister, John Nelson Hyde, felt led to begin his lifetime of missionary endeavor. At the time of his posting, he was one of only five missionaries in a territory holding nearly one million non-Christians. Progress was slow, but measured. In a letter to his seminary after his first year in India, Hyde wrote:

Yesterday eight low-caste persons were baptized at one of the villages. It seems a work of God in which man, even as an instrument, was used in a very small degree. Pray for us. I learn to speak the language very, very slowly: can only talk a little in public or in conversation."

Have felt led to pray for others this winter as never before. I never before knew what it was to work all day and then pray all night before God for another... In college or at parties at home, I used to keep such hours for myself, or pleasure, and can I not do as much for God and souls?"

In 1908, John Hyde dared to pray what was to many at the convention an impossible request: that during the coming year in India one soul would be saved every day. Three hundred sixty five people converted, baptized, and publicly confessing Jesus as their Saviour. Impossible -- yet it happened. Before the next convention John Hyde had prayed more than 400 people into God's kingdom, and when the prayer union gathered again, he doubled his goal to two souls a day. Eight hundred conversions were recorded that year, and still Hyde showed an unquenchable passion for lost souls.

At the 1910 convention, those around Hyde marvelled at his faith, as they witnessed his near violent supplications, "Give me souls, oh God, or I die!" Before the meeting ended, John Hyde revealed that he was again doubling his goal for the coming year. Four souls a day, and nothing less

During the next twelve months John Hyde's ministry took him throughout India. By now he was known as "Praying Hyde," and his intercession was sought at revivals in Calcutta, Bombay, and other large cities.

If on any day four people were not converted, Hyde said at night there would be such a weight on his heart he could not eat or sleep until he had prayed through to victory. The number of new converts continually grew.

It was in Calcutta that friends persuaded Hyde to see a doctor about his rapidly deteriorating health. The years of travail had obviously taken a toll. Yet no one expected the medical examiner's incredible diagnosis. John Hyde's heart had shifted out of its natural position on the left side of his chest to a place over on the right. It was unlike anything the doctor had seen before, and he warned Hyde that unless he got complete rest he would be dead in six months.

In fact, Praying Hyde lived for nearly two more years, long enough to see a wave of revival sweep through the Punjab and the rest of India -- and long enough to have his own personal vision enlarged. Before he died, he shared what God had shown him:

We must exercise the greatest care to be utterly obedient to Him who sees all the battlefield all the time.

It is only He who can put each man in the place where his life can count for the most.

Testimony of Pastor Lywood

Mrs Lazarus

The present writer met Pastor Lywood having been invited to share ministry of Daily Bread, A ministry of Love in Song in meetings in Cousley Wood on the borders of Kent and East Sussex in UK.

Pastor Lywood he learn had been a rich man; A director of a large brewery owning land, and race horses. Following his conversion the Lord called him to serve him and he sold his home gave up his business and gave the money away. His wife and family dis-owned him and the byways and villages of the Lord led him to preach the Gospel in rural Kent. He especially was burdened to minister to the gypsies and travellers who wandered around the area and the Lord saved many souls as he preached around the campfire.

The gypsies came to love him and trusted him and they would call him when in any crises, sickness of in and trouble.. Sometimes he would represent them and plead their case when accused of a crime, but more often to pray to for them when sick

On one occasion he was told that an elderly woman was in hospital after being run over and crushed by a heavy lorry.

Before any such visit Pastor Lywood would pray and ask the Lord should he pray for healing.... The Lord said Yes He would heal the woman. so on arrival in the Hospital he told the staff he had come to pray for the woman. The staff replied that the woman was very ill that actually she was dying.

Pastor Lywood was not perturbed as he knew the Lord heal her.

The doctor tried to convince him that the patient was actually , they e showed him x rays of the woman's broken pelvis all crushed and said she was dying. Pastor Lywood went to the ward to pray. This is what happened

He said when I saw the woman I perceived that she had faith.. He asked the woman, “Do you have faith to believe the Lord Jesus will heal you? “ She replied, “Yes”.

Pastor Lywood prayed for her healing and left the ward, he said nothing happened immediately, but testified that later that night the night nurse sitting in the ward at her desk, saw the woman getting out of bed.... She gasped as she knew this was impossible, yet it was true. The woman was walking. Praise the Lord. She had been healed.

Pastor Lywood said I have called the woman the Lord healed as “Mrs Lazarus” he then said, “I would like Mrs Lazarus to stand up”.

It was now the turn of the present writer to be shocked as an elderly frail woman sitting in the pew before him, struggled to her feet in front of him.

It was in the early years of my walk with the Lord and his testimony strengthened my faith in the Lord.

Amazingly 80 folks gathered together in the church every morning and prayed. Some, weeks-months went by, and they continued to pray.

Then one day the door opened and a man came in and said “What must I do to be saved”.

Praise God

Then there were ten,

Then fifty,

Then a hundred .

Then Hundred’s. **Glory to God**
