November 14th 28th 2007

#### Secunderbad

Arab Emirates are good to fly with.

A smiling Joseph met us at 4 AM To his home to rest. Went to pray for David-stroke victim aged 40. Saw some very sad sights en –route. Joseph and Mary rise at 4 AM to run off water for the days needs, yet still heated buckets for us to bathe.

Overnight train to Visak. Slept quite well. Arrived at 10 30 AM Nathaniel there to greet us. Park Hotel luxury Swam. Shopping for family gifts. Swam early then to the old Peduyim Home. Wonderful greeting. Had meeting. Children, prayed, read and recited the Word sang. Served them lunch. Visited the new home. Still some work to be done. Walked in the village. Got back tired but swam again. Lalitha greeted me "Hello Mummy" AH...

Very noisy night Swam early Pick up at 10 30 AM for dedication. Beulah and older girls worked until 1 AM cleaning. Prayed in each room# Wore a sari. Discovered many things about the building delays!!

Another noisy night Leaving our hotel as our train again overnight. Made friends here when I was seen in Sari YMCA one night very basic So noisy!!! Walk on beach but smell of sewage too bad.

Took cake etc to street children project at YMCA

Visited Pastors homes . Some live with rats as company. Their dedication is remarkable. Farewells were very sad.

#### Bapatala

3 AM to train. Arrived in Vijawadda at 7AM met by pastors Jidugu –Johnson- Joseph . A 2 hour drive to another flower strewn welcome. Our room on beach A/C but no refrigerator. Beach dirty but walked it each morning. Trustees meeting for Tony I met with 4 wives of pastors- A happy time. Visited old home What a contrast Three boys are now preaching in villages with Pastors. Three on engineering courses. One girl on pre nursing courses.

Many encouragements but their spiritual lives are vibrant- anyone can feed them- here they are fed on the bread. Spend two days and one night at Sheila's Home. So good to get to know the family. Had games fun Dedicated the new home of Josephs family Prayed for a wife for him. His father very sick.

More homes visited. Having a shower by candlelight, my towel put it out-complete darkness. Went around village and was captured by Anita, a young girls with good English. Met her family. Visited fishing village, saw huts we built after Tsunami. Our boats were out hunting fish. My legs are covered in bites. Not mosquitoes.

We visited two prisons were there was a good response. One superintendent requested our visit and wore his uniform on my honour.

We celebrated 4 birthdays in Sheila's Home. Time to return to Secunderbad and Josephs and Mary's home. Meeting in the slums, Sunday school read, sand, recited danced. Next day inspecting sewing project. Two learning on a course then teaching others. Making things to sell. Distributed rice and bananas in rubbish tip- but had to make quick exit as outsiders heard of the food.

So soon home I have not told half Please pray for the workers. We send gifts and live in luxury. Their labours are truly sacrificial and on-going. Their reward will be great. For me a life changing experience.
