And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution arises for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

Among Thorns and Thistles

And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word, And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.

2 Samuel 12 v 7

And Nathan said to David, **Thou art the man.** Thus say's the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul; And I gave thee thy master's house, and thy master's wives into thy bosom, and gave thee the house of Israel and of Judah; and if that had been too little, I would moreover have given unto thee such and such things.

Wherefore hast thou despised the commandment of the LORD, to do evil in his sight? thou hast killed Uriah the Hittite with the sword, and hast

taken his wife to be thy wife, and hast slain him with the sword of the children of Ammon

2 Samuel 12 v 7

**So there would be consequences;**

The sword would never depart, God would raise up evil against thee out of thine own house. His wives would be taken, but God showed his love and mercy; Thou shall not die.

2 Samuel 12 v 10 15

**Joshua that great man of God was deceived by the story of the old clouts ;**

Joshua 9 v 4/9

And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai, They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up; And old shoes and clouted upon their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provision was dry and mouldy. And they went to Joshua unto the camp at Gilgal, and said unto him, and to the men of Israel, **We be come from a far country: now therefore make ye a league with us.**

The Gibeon'ites were "Cursed" They them spent their lives in slavery

### **The Old Prophet Lied.;**

**How long, LORD?** wilt thou be angry for ever? shall thy jealousy burn like fire? Psalm 79 v 5

LORD God of hosts, how long wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people? Psalm 80 v 4

Wilt thou be angry with us for ever? wilt thou draw out thine anger to all generations? Psalm 85 v 5

### **A way of escape;**

Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah. 2 Chronicles 32 v 26

In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
