Discipleship:

Are you born again ??? If you want to go to Heaven you must be! Many people are religious . They like to do religious things. The worlds is full of religions. It is very confusing Hinduism says come this way. Buddhist say this way, Mormons say this way, Islam says this way, 7th Day Adventist this way, there are hundreds of religions and denominations in England. They make men feel better, unfortunately and tragically, many religions deceive.

Religion and its dangers . Religion tries to change the man from the outside. It makes rules. Do not smoke, do not drink, do not take drugs . Go to church, give your money. Sadly, tragically, it is possible to do these things without being "Born Again"!!

So religion is "rules". Usually men's rules. Jesus said "Come unto me" Not to a denomination or a doctrine of man. Jesus did not invite you to the Pentecostal, Baptist or Catholic Church nor to any charismatic group, however likeable or well meaning.

We either have religion or a relationship with Jesus Christ. Christ in our hearts by Faith.

Consider the thief on the cross

He could not be religious. He could not light a candle. He could not go to mass, he could not go to Mecca, he could not be baptised, he could not read a bible, he could not go on a pilgrimage. He was crucified, hanging on a cross and he was dying. He was guilty. He deserved to die How could he be saved?

1/ He looked, a dying man looked,

What did he se? Her saw Jesus, He saw the Lamb of God which takes away the sin of the World. He actually saw the Blood. The precious blood of Jesus as he suffered on the cross as a sacrifice a substitute lamb, an innocent lamb slain for sinners.

2/ He believed. For he called Jesus Lord. " No man can call Jesus Lord but by the Holy Spirit"

3/ He prayed, It was a desperate prayer. He cried out to God. "Lord when thou comest into thy kingdom remember me" It was a selfish prayer, but it was a dying man, A man without any hope.

Jesus answered the thief's hearts cry immediately. "Today thou shalt be with me in paradise". This was a promise There were no rules, no conditions. A sinner cried out to God in repentance, looking to Jesus calling Him Lord and having Faith.

Read: Hebrews 11

Sin. God Hates sin But God loves sinners

Read: Jeremiah 17 v 9-10 Truly the heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked

Sin is not always what we do? Sin is what we are. God is Holy . We are sinners.

What is sin? Some comfort themselves saying "I have not committed murder, I am not a thief, or I have not committed

adultery" But Jesus says the heart is full of sin. That is your heart, my heart.

Mark 7 v 21 . For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: all these evil things come from within and defile the man."

A warning is given in the Bible. "But the fearful, and unbelieving and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death". Revelation 21 v 8

"Whatsoever is not of faith is sin. Romans 14 v 23 Actually the only barrier between you and a Holy God is your un confessed sin!!

All sin can be forgiven by God!!! If we truly.... Repent.

In the Old Testament Tabernacle a curtain separated the priests from the Holy of Holy's . The High Priest could only enter once a year after blood sacrifice. Yet when Jesus died on the cross of Calvary for sinners the curtain in the temple at Jerusalem was torn in two. And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst. Luke 23 v 45

God thus indicating that access was now made for all sinners to approach God through the shed blood of Jesus . All sin can be forgiven by God !!!

Except blasphemy against the Holy Ghost: Matthew 12 v 31 Therefore I say unto you, all manner of sin and blasphemy shall be

forgiven unto men, but the blasphemy against the Holy Spirit shall not be forgiven unto men.

That is not believing what the Holy Spirit (God) says in His word. The Holy Spirit, "Inspired" men to write the bible. The Holy Spirit wrote the Book.., Read 2 Timothy 3 v 16

So, not believing the Gospel, is sin, and is calling the Holy Spirit a liar!!! Revelation 21 v 8

No Liar shall enter heaven. One more warning about Sin.

If we sin wilfully there is no forgiveness..

This refers to apostasy. For if we sin wilfully after having received the knowledge of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful expectation of judgment and fiery indignation,

Hebrews 10

v 26-27

There are sins of Omission and sins of Commission

That is thin gs we should have done but have not done = Omission.

Then sins that we have done that we should not have done = Commission.

Sinning wilfully is resisting the Holy Ghost. This is deliberately turning you back on God and though once you believed you deliberately reject God and His Christ.

Read about the Impossible.... Hebrews 6 v 4-6 "It is impossible to those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost and have tasted of the good Word of God, and of the Powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to open shame".... This is known as apostasy.

2/ When we are saved it is a first step

The seed of the Holy Spirit has quickened our Spirit and we become alive to the things of God. The parable of the sower sets out the 4 types of soil or four types of heart

1/ Way side= Hard ground = Hard heart The devil come immediately to snatch away the seed sown. Result No fruit

2/ The stony ground= Word is received but when the sun gets hot= Persecution, the seedling dies= Result no fruit

3/ Thorns and Thistles= This word is received with great Joy. But the cares of this life the deceitfulness of riches comes in and the word is choked and dies.

Result no Fruit

4/ Good ground. Heart open to receive all from God = Good soil/

Brings forth Fruit: 30 fold 60 Fold 100 Fold . Jesus said : Ye will know them by their fruits

Matthew 7 v 16 Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thorns, or figs from thistles?

Without fruit The branch (a Christian) although it resembles a Christian is cut off and burnt in the fire. Read John 15 v 1-8

Note. The only way to bear fruit is to, "Abide in Jesus"....

Also: read Psalm 1 v 1-3 When we meditate in God's Word blessings follow

Learn the lessons of the Geed

Any farmer will tell you. All seed needs to be planted in good soil and nurtured. If the seed planted is neglected it will soon wither and die.

When a person accepts Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord, repenting of their sins they then have two natures. The old Adamic (Adam's Nature) ruled by Satan and the New Spiritual nature ruled by the Spirit of God in Christ Jesus.

These two natures are at war....

The person is now receiving two signals .

One from the old nature and one from the new nature.

Jeremiah 24 v 5-7 Parable of the figs

Good fruit. Is Blessed of God . Evil Fruit Is cursed of God Read all of Romans 6..... Then 2 Corinthians 2 v 14-16 . Then Romans 8 v 35 to 39

Jesus expected fruit from the nation of Israel. When there was no fruit, He cursed it. Matthew 21 v 19 And when He saw a fig tree by the wayside, (The Fig Tree representing the nation of Israel)

He came to it and found nothing thereon, but leaves only. And He said unto it, "Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever." And immediately the fig tree withered away.

v 20 And when the disciples saw it, they marvelled, saying, "How soon has the fig tree withered away!"

Lastly there is a gulf which separates and identifies those who are saved Born again and those who are Lost

A new Christian must understand the condition of all flesh.

When a baby is born it is still being fed from its mother. So it is in the Spirit. When a spiritual birth takes place all connection with ⁸

the old life must be cut. The umbilical chord with the world must be cut

Ephesians 2 v 1-2 And you hath He quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins wherein in times past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now works in the children of disobedience.

Therefore they said unto him, "How were thine eyes opened?" He answered and said, "A man who is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, 'Go to the pool of Siloam and wash.' And I went and washed, and I received sight." v 25 He is of age; ask him. He shall speak for himself."

22 These words spoke his parents, because they feared the Jews; for the Jews had agreed already that if any man confessed that He was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue. Therefore said his parents, "He is of age; ask him." Then they again called the man who was blind and said unto him, "Give God the praise! We know that this man is a sinner." He answered and said, "Whether he be a sinner or not, I know not. One thing I know, that whereas I was blind, now I see."

5/We are saved to serve.

God has a plan for our lives : Service.

God rescued his chosen people Israel from slavery in Egypt that they might serve him Exodus 10 v 7 And Pharaoh's servants said unto him, "How long shall this man be a snare unto us? Let the men go, that they may serve the LORD their God. 10 Jesus said, John 12 v 26 If any man serve Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there shall also My servant be. If any man serve Me, him will My Father honour.

We are not saved to continue in sin!

Romans 6 v 6 knowing this: that our old man is crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

A reward for serving Christ.

Colossians 3 V 24 knowing that from the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance, for ye serve the Lord Christ.

Hebrews 12 v 28 Therefore, we receiving a Kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace whereby we may serve God acceptably, with reverence and godly fear.

In Glory . In Heaven

Revelation 22 v 3 And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him.

2/ Totally surrendering all decisions and plans into His hands.

Example

God did not spare His only Son "Jesus Christ" from sacrifice on the cross.

Hebrews 10 v 12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down at the right hand of God All through the Old Testament: The sacrificial Lamb points to the " Lamb of God" of the New Testament. Jesus did not flinch in the garden of Gethsemane as He faced the cruel cross. He prayed: "Nevertheless not my will be done but thine"

Ephesians 5 v 2 and walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given Himself for us as an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savor.

Abraham did not flinch when God asked his to sacrifice his son. God was testing Abraham but Abraham had faith to believe that God would raise up his son even if he were to sacrifice him. Genesis 22 v 12

Isaac was willing to obey his father and lay on the altar. Ready and willing to die. Trusting His father, He did not fight or resist when his father Abarahm tied him to the altar and raised the knife. Genesis 22 v 7-9

Genesis 22 v 1 And it came to pass after these things, that God tested Abraham and said unto him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Behold, here I am." And He said, "Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah, and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of."

Romans 4 v 3 For what saith the Scripture? "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted unto him for righteousness." And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about a hundred years old, nor yet the deadness of Sarah's womb. He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strong in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully persuaded that what He had promised, He was able also to perform. And therefore "it was imputed to him for righteousness."

All faith must be tested to see what sort it is? Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you but rejoice inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings, that, when His glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy. 1 Peter 4 v 12

Jesus commended the Roman soldier for his Faith

Matthew 8 v 10 When Jesus heard it, He marvelled and said to those who followed, "Verily I say unto you, I have not found such great faith, no, not in Israel.

The disciples who had travelled with Jesus and had witnessed His power and the miracles He did, were rebuked when a storm arose and they feared for their lives. Matthew 8 v 26 And He said unto them, "Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?" Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm.

Without faith it is impossible to please God. Hebrews 11 v 6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him. For he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Peter walked on the water but started to sink when he took his eyes off of Jesus Matthew 14 v 31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth His hand and caught him and said unto him, "O thou of little faith, why didst thou doubt?"

All that is not of faith is sin!!! Romans 14 v 23

Jesus illustrates the "Power of Faith"

Matthew 17 v 20 And Jesus said unto them, "Because of your unbelief; for verily I say unto you, if ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, 'Remove hence to yonder place,' and it shall remove. And nothing shall be impossible unto you.

The woman who touched Jesus

Mark 5 v 34 And He said unto her, "Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole. Go in peace, and be whole of thy plague."

Do not be afraid of him.

For the Word of God is: Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4 v 7

Perfect love cast out fear

1 John 4 v 18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear, because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

Put on put on that new man,
