**Jeraboam** come to Rehoboam and asked for leniency better conditions this was refused v 10 after he listened to bad advice and Jeroboam went off and was made King of Israel with ten tribes.

Rehoboam came to Jerusalem and assembled all the house of Judah and the tribe of Benjamingathering an army to fight Israel but the Lord sent Shemiah the Man of God to stop them.
