## Some examples

Prayer warriors are like that , dozens and hundreds of them all taking a bite. The dam in under strain. Finally one more beaver arrives and his bite does the trick. The Dam burst.

In 1943 in the Second World War the RAF sent 617 Squadron to bomb the Mohne, Eder, and Sorpe dams in Germany. Barnes Wallis had invented a bouncing bomb to destroy these dams.

The dams were heavily reinforced and needed special methods to destroy When Joshua encircled the city of Jericho the Lord gave specific instruction which, when followed in detail, brought down those walls. Joshua 6 v 20 Similarly our specific prayers can be used by God to destroy opposition strongholds.
