George Whitfield; 1714 Preacher

Influenced by John Wesley Holy Club Oxford

In 1740, Whitefield travelled to America, where he preached a series of revivals that came to be known as the "Great Awakening". Whitefield was probably the most famous religious figure of the 18th century. He exercised influence over thousands in Great Britain and America by his oratory. He preached at least 18,000 times to perhaps 10 million listeners.[2]

Publishing

To Whitefield "the gospel message was so critically important that he felt compelled to use all earthly means to get the word out. Thanks to widespread dissemination of print media, perhaps half of all colonists eventually heard about, read about, or read something written by Whitefield. He employed print systematically, sending advance men to put up broadsides and distribute handbills announcing his sermons. He also arranged to have his sermons published.

Henry Martyn; 1781-1812 . Influenced by Charles Simon

Martyn arrived in India in April 1806, and for some months he was stationed at Aldeen, near Serampur. In October 1806, he proceeded to Dinapur, where he was soon able to conduct worship among the locals in the vernacular, and established schools. In April 1809, he was transferred to Cawnpore, where he preached to British and Indians in his own compound, in spite of interruptions and threats from local non-Christians

He translated the whole of the New Testament into Urdu, Persian and Judaeo-Persic. He also translated the Psalms into Persian and the Book of Common Prayer into Urdu. From India, he set out for Bushire, Shiraz, Isfahan, and Tabriz. Martyn was seized with fever, and, though the plague was raging at Tokat, he was forced to stop there, unable to continue. On 16 October 1812 he died. He was remembered for his courage, selflessness and his religious devotion.

William Carey; 1761; Missionary

Influenced by John Warr Baptist Dissenter

William Carey was a British missionary, a Particular Baptist minister, a translator and an activist. He also opened the first University in Serampore offering degrees. He is known as the "father of modern missions."

Once settled in Serampore, the mission bought a house large enough to accommodate all of their families and a school, which was to be their principal means of support. Ward set up a print shop with a second-hand press Carey had acquired and began the task of printing the Bible in Bengali; He translated the Bible the New Testament into Hindi, Bengali, Oriya, Sanskrit, Marathi, Assamies.

1485 Hugh Latimer

Martyred in England in 1555

Both Ridley and Latimer were burned at the stake in Oxford on this day, October 16, 1555. As he was being tied to the stake, Ridley prayed, "Oh, heavenly Father, I give unto thee most hearty thanks that thou hast called me to be a professor of thee, even unto death. I beseech thee, Lord God, have mercy on this realm of England, and deliver it from all her enemies. "Ridley's brother had brought some gunpowder for the men to place around their necks so death could come more quickly, but Ridley still suffered greatly. With a loud voice Ridley cried, "Into thy hands, O Lord, I commend my spirit...", but the wood was green and burned only Ridley's lower parts without touching his upper body. He was heard to repeatedly call out, "Lord have mercy upon me! I cannot burn.. Let the fire come unto me, I cannot burn." One of the bystanders finally brought the flames to the top of the pyre to hasten Ridley's death.

Johnathan Edwards; 1703-1758 Revival

Influenced by George Whitefield

A revivalist preacher, philosopher, and Congregationalist Protestant Edwards is widely regarded as "one of America's most important and original philosophical theologians". Edwards oversaw some of the first revivals in 1733–35 at his church in Northampton, Massachusetts; Edwards preached his most famous sermon "Sinners in the Hands of an Angry God", in Connecticut in 1741. Though this sermon as an example of "fire and brimstone" preaching in the colonial revivals, this is not in keeping with Edward's actual preaching style. Edwards did not shout or speak loudly, but talked in a quiet, emotive voice. He moved his audience slowly from point to point, towards an inexorable conclusion: they were lost without the grace of God.

While most 21st-century readers notice the damnation looming in such a sermon text, historian George Marsden reminds us that Edwards' was not preaching anything new or surprising: "Edwards could take for granted... that a New England audience knew well the Gospel remedy. The problem was getting them to seek it."

William Booth 1865

Influenced by Methodism

In 1865 Booth was in the East End of London, preaching to crowds of people in the streets. Outside The Blind Beggar public house some missionary heard him speaking and were so impressed by his preaching that they invited him to lead a series of meetings they were holding in a large tent. The first of these meetings was held on 2 July 1865. To the poor and destitute of London's East End, Booth brought the good news of Jesus Christ and his love for all.. On 21 August 1909 a surgeon at Guy's Hospital removed his right eye. Despite this setback, in 1910 Booth campaigned in the Netherlands, Denmark, Germany, Switzerland and Italy. On his return to England he embarked on his seventh and last motor tour. Booth soon realised he had found his destiny, and later in 1865 he and his wife Catherine opened 'The Christian Revival Society' in the East End of London, where they held meetings every evening and on Sundays, to share the repentance that salvation can bring through accepting Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour to the poorest and most needy, including alcoholics, criminals and prostitutes.

I felt that God's spirit was there. Although I could not understand a word that was being said, I felt my heart strangely warmed.... Never did I hear an organ play so sweetly, never did human voices sound so lovely to me, never did people look so beautiful as on that occasion. I went away weeping for joy.

In that instant, it was said later, "he became a missionary for ever, so full was the flood of holy passion in his soul." Soon he received a preacher's license from the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, and began his ministry in the Corpus Christi area. In 1871, he took the first step into annual conference membership, received deacon's ordination from Bishop Enoch Marvin, and was appointed to work among Mexicans along the Rio Grande. Following his death, Bishop John Keener said: "He was ready for any enterprise in the Master's service? To go alone, and on an hour's notice, if need be, to the ends of the earth."

Kanichi Miyama; (1847-1936

A Japanese Convert to Methodism he Evangelized Japan 1847-1936

Miyama imbibed the classic Shinto tradition before studying Western science and philosophy, military strategy, and English

Arriving in San Francisco in 1875, Miyama heard Otis Gibson, superintendent of the city's Chinese Christian Mission, tell a story about George Washington, whose father had directed his attention to the will of God behind the order of the world. Miyama experienced Gibson's sermon as a challenge to his egotism, an admonition to confess his sins, and an invitation to accept Christ.

Gibson, however, demanded more: "Do you want to lead others to Christ?" Miyama said he did. "Will you give your whole life to Christ?" Miyama felt cornered by God, an imperious ruler, while Gibson, God's courtier, patiently studied his face. At last, gathering his courage, he replied, "Yes, I will give my whole life to him." Gibson baptized him early in1877.

Soon Miyama became a leader of the Japanese Gospel Society, which offered Bible studies and English lessons, along with providing lodging for new immigrants from Japan and helping them find jobs. In 1881 he worked with Gibson at the Chinese Mission, then he helped Merriman Harris establish a Japanese Methodist Church.

Cornish Revival. England 1850

"When I reached the place, I found it impossible to get in, for all was full and a crowd hung about the door. I finally climbed in through the window and stood on a table." The heat of the room and the noise of the people was such that Haslam could not preach. He went among the people, and as each found peace and began praising God, they were asked to leave and make room for others. In this way the meeting went on until ten o'clock, when Haslam left. It continued uninterrupted all night and all the next day, and so on for eight days! Haslam went daily to see how they were getting on, noticing many strangers who had not been there before, but had been drawn by the Spirit of God. Yet all alike were too absorbed in God to heed Haslam's presence.

The rise of Adolf Hitler and the outbreak of World War II also marked a period of strong activity in Howells' ministry of intercession. The Bible College of Wales, is a religious training centre in Rugby, Warwickshire. Originally based in Swansea, Wales, the Bible College was founded in 1924 by Rees Howells. He was involved in intercession for many years, before seeing revival across Southern Africa from 1915-1920. Howells became well known as an intercessor, Returning to Britain, he felt called by the Holy Spirit to start a Bible College; his inspiration being the 900 student capacity Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, Illinois

Thomas Coke; 1747-1814

English clergyman and with Francis Asbury, first Bishop of the Methodist Episcopal church in America.

Though remembered primarily as the "Father of Methodist Missions," he was a key figure in the development of Methodism on both sides of the Atlantic in the years before and after Wesley's death. An Oxford trained lawyer turned priest, he openly allied himself with the Methodists in England. As Wesley's right hand man he became President of the Methodist Church in Ireland in 1782, and two years later was appointed "Bishop" for America. As Asbury's uneasily yoked colleague, Coke visited America nine times, the last time in 1803.

Always deeply interested in missionary work at home and abroad, he travelled widely to establish Methodism in the West Indies. Hoping to open Methodist missions in the East Indies, in 1814 he set sail for Ceylon, but died on the way.

In addition to being a popular preacher, he was an author of some considerable importance. His writings included a multi-volume commentary on the Bible and a history of the West Indies.

Zionism is the national movement of the Jewish people that supports the reestablishment of a Jewish homeland in the territory defined as the historic

Land of Israel. Zionism emerged in the late 19th century in Central and Eastern Europe as a national revival movement, in reaction to anti-Semitic and

exclusionary nationalist movements in Europe. Theodor Herzl is considered the founder of the Zionist movement. He published a book called Der Judenstaat in

1896 that envisioned the founding of a future independent Jewish state during

the 20th century. After almost two millennia of the Jewish Diaspora residing in various countries without a national state, the Zionist movement was founded in the late 19th century by secular Jews, largely as a response by Ashkenazi Jews to rising anti-Semitism in Europe. The political movement was formally established by the Austro-Hungarian journalist Theodor Herzl. In its early stages, Zionism expanded rapidly and supporters considered setting up a Jewish state in the historic territory of Palestine.
